The case was discussed in 721st SEIAA meeting dtd. 06.05.22 and recorded that:-

“The case was considered in 564th SEAC meeting dtd. 15.04.2022 and found that there are some discrepancies and data mismatch in the EIA report and in Form-II uploaded by PP. The committee after deliberations observed that it's not only an issue of cut & paste but also misrepresentation of data and thus committee recommends the PP shall recollect the monitoring data and revise the EIA report based on above discrepancies and submit the same for further consideration & appraisal of the project through SEIAA with logical reasons for above discrepancies and EIA consultant firm M/s Amaltas Enviro Industrial Consultants LLP, New Delhi shall also submit their clarification on above issues. In context of above, it is decided that PP should submit revised EIA report by incorporating all the issues as raised by SEAC. EIA consultant firm M/s Amaltas Enviro Industrial Consultants LLP, New Delhi is also instructed to not repeat this type of mistake in future. Further it was observed by the authority this type of issue could be resolved by SEAC only itself by raising ADS to avoid delayed for decision.”

In light of above, you are requested to kindly submit revised EIA report incorporating all issues raised by committee/authority.
