


- (2). It was noted that MOEF, GoI has issued Office Memorandum vide No. J-11013/41/2006-IA.II(I) dtd. 22<sup>nd</sup> March, 2010 regarding **Time limit for validity of Terms of Reference (TORs)** prescribed under EIA Notification, 2006 for undertaking detailed EIA studies for developmental projects requiring environmental clearance. The relevant part of the OM is given hereunder:-

*"It has been decided that from 01.04.2010, the prescribed TORs would be **valid for a period of two years** for submission of the EIA/EMP Reports, after public consultation where so required. This period will be extendable to the 3<sup>rd</sup> year, based on proper justification and approval of the EAC/SEAC, as the case may be. Thus, an **outer limit of three years** has been prescribed for the validity of TORs with effect from 01.04.2010.*

*In case of the proposals, which had been granted TORs **prior to the issue of this O.M.** the EIA/EMP reports should be submitted, after public consultation where so required, **no later than four years from the date of the grant of the TORs, with primary data not older than three years**".*

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
- (3) It has been informed by the SEIAA office that following **seven (07)** cases were registered wherein as per above OM the time limit of 4 years has expired after issuing ToR, but PPs have not submitted final EIA Report in SEIAA Office as yet. As per EIA Notification 2006 PP should submit EIA Report to SEIAA Office and subsequently would be sent to SEAC Office for appraisal. Presently this procedure is in practice too.

The SEIAA Office has also examined and found that PPs have not applied to extend time limit for validity of TOR and as such the prescribed time limit is over. **Hence, it has been decided that all these seven (07) cases are summarily rejected.** The list of these cases along with details is given below:

  - (ii) Regarding **case no. 426/2009** it was found that PP has not submitted the information within the time limit as per MoEF, Gol Office Memorandum vide No. J-11013/5/2009-IA-II(Part) dtd. 30<sup>th</sup> October, 2012 regarding delisting of pending projects. 
(1). *In response to above query, reply submitted by PP (vide letter dtd 13.02.13, 15.02.13 & 18.03.13 received in SEIAA office on 13.02.13, 19.02.13 & 21.03.13 respectively) was examined in depth and it is noted that :-*

(i). *PP (vide letter dtd 13.02.2013) has submitted the details of Khasra Nos. & Khasra Panchsala for 2011-2012. 

Cement Division, Satna is from SECL / KR & SECL / KRB (minutes of 258<sup>th</sup> meeting dtd 20.03.2008 of Standing Linkage Committee (short term) for cement plants) for the first quarter 2008-2009. It is noted that the coal linkage document submitted by PP are for their existing cement plant. **It is decided that PP should be asked whether Ministry has given permission for using that coal in the proposed thermal power plant located at village Bela. PP should submit a copy of the permission issued by the Coal Ministry for using the said coal in the proposed 35 MW thermal power plant.**

(2). PP should submit the above information latest by 20.08.2013."

- (2) In response to above queries, reply submitted by PP (vide letter dtd 08.07.13 received in SEIAA office on 08.07.13) was examined in depth and it is noted that :-
- (i). PP has submitted that the coal linkage documents shown in (Annex-2) final EIA/EMP report are for the existing Cement plant and 27 MW captive power plant. The coal from SECL/KRB will be used for the Cement plant and 27 MW captive power plant after washing in coal washery. The reject coal of coal washery will be used in proposed 35 MW captive power plant.
  - (ii). PP has submitted that the coal reject and slime from settling tank from the existing coal wahsery plant will be used in the proposed 35 MW thermal plant for power generation. PP has also submitted the proposed thermal power plant will be specially designed to use the washery rejects, which in fact, have got very poor calorific value and cannot be utilized in the normal conventional boilers. Hence, there is no need for getting additional linkage or permission from the coal ministry for the proposed 35 MW power plant.
- (3) It is noted that the clearance certificate / NOC from Central Electricity Authority has not been submitted by PP. **It is decided that PP should obtain clearance / NOC from Central Electricity Board before starting the project.**
- (4) It is noted that no national park/sanctuary is located within 10 km (107<sup>th</sup> SEAC dtd. 11.10.12). The site is located in Raghurajnagar Tehsil of District Satna which is away from interstate boundary. Thus the general conditions are not attracted.

  
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
- (5) The total fresh water requirement is 360 KLD (process nil, cooling 190 KLD + DM water 150 KLD + drinking 10 + others 10 ). The source of water supply is quarry reservoir of captive mine **and is satisfactory.**

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

Thus it is a clear case of violation of EIA Notification. Committee decided to return the case to SEIAA.   - (ii). PP has assured that permission for water supply from local authorities has already been obtained and there will no extraction of ground water.
  - (iii). PP has assured that there will be no disposal of treated water outside the campus and entire volume of treated water will be used for flushing, HVAC and cooling towers.
  - (iv). PP has assured that the width of internal main road will be 30 m and shall comply with MPBVR 2012.
  - (v). PP has assured that the guideline of NBC for firefighting system shall be complied with.
  - (vi). PP has assured that parking shall be provided as per permission of T & CP and MPBVR 2012.
  - (vii). PP has assured that MSW shall be disposed of in appropriate and efficient manner and shall be integrated with Municipal Corporation, Indore.
- (3) It was decided to accept the recommendations of 126<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting dtd 10.04.2013 with 08 special conditions and accord prior Environmental Clearance to Proposed Indian Institute of Technology at village – Simrol, Tehsil Mhow, Distt.- Indore(M.P.) , Total Land Area – 501.42 Acres (202.918 ha), Total Built Up Area – 12,65,179.45 sq. mt. by Director,IIT, Indore, Ministry of Human Resource Deptt., Govt. of India through Col. Raja Sekhar. Registrar, IIT, Indore, Institute of Engg. & Technology,DAVV Campus, Khandwa Road, Indore- 452017.

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4. **Case No. – 1197/2013** – Prior Environmental Clearance for Single Super Phosphate in an area of 6900 sq.m for Change in the Product form (physical) from 350 TPD Powder SSP to 350 TPD Granulated SSP at Plot No. – 6, 7, 8, 11, 12, 13, Sector I, Industrial Area, AB Road Near Tata Square, Tehsil & Distt. Dewas (M.P.) by Mr. Ashish Tiwari M/s Varun Fertilizer Pvt. Ltd. 203, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Indore Trade Centre, South Tukoganj, Indore, (M. P.).


(1) The case was discussed in 131<sup>st</sup> SEIAA meeting dtd 08.05.2013 & and it is recorded that ..... (1)... (4)

(4) The case was discussed in depth and it is noted that :-

- i. PP has applied for change in the product form from powder SSP to granulated SSP. The production capacity and the proposed site and area is same for which the earlier EC was issued by MPSEIAA (dtd 21.12.2012).
  - ii. Neither ToR has been issued by SEAC nor the EIA Report has been prepared and submitted for appraisal for the change in product form from Powder SSP to Granulated SSP. SEAC has given recommendation on the basis of information submitted and signed by PP in Form-1. No comparison has been done regarding the pollution load w.r.t air, water, noise for the production of powder SSP and Granulated SSP.
  - iii. As per Para 1 clause (ii) of MoEF Gol circular no. J-11013/41/2006-IA-II (I) dtd 14.12.2006- clarification regarding EIA clearance for change in product mix, Project involving increase in pollution load will have to obtain Prior Environmental Clearance under EIA Notification 2006. If no increase in pollution load takes place due to revised process then no EC is required. If EC is required then prescribed procedure under EIA Notification 2006 is to be followed. Such comparative figures of "Pollution Load" for the original and proposed revised process must be available in the record and it is not there. Hence, it is decided that PP should submit details of :-
    - a) The additional raw material and process requirements
    - b) Projected changes in emissions, effluents, solid waste etc.
    - c) A comparative statement of the pollution load w.r.t. air, water and noise for the powder SSP (350 TPD) and Granulated SSP (350 TPD).
    - d) The above information should be duly authenticated and signed by the Accredited Consultant, of the PP.
- (5) PP should submit above information by 30.06.2013 positively.


### Minutes of the 142<sup>nd</sup> Meeting of SEIAA dated 18.07.2013

- (2) The response to above query, reply submitted by PP (vide letter dtd 20.06.13 received in SEIAA office on 22.06.2013) was examined in depth and it is noted that :-
- (i). PP has submitted that no additional raw material is required for conversion of Powder SSP to Granular SSP as PSSP itself is the raw material for manufacturing of GSSP.
  - (ii). PP has submitted projected changes in emissions, effluents, solid waste along with a comparative assessment of pollution load w.r.t. air, water and noise for the powder SSP (350 TPD) to granulated SSP (350 TPD). It is noted that as per the information submitted by the PP duly certified by their NABET accredited (letter dtd 29.06.11) consultant M/s Global Enviro labs, Hyderabad (Shri T. Murali Krishna) there will be no change in the pollution load w.r.t. air emissions, effluents (zero discharge process), solid waste, hazardous waste, noise level for conversion of powder SSP to granular SSP. However, there will be increase of 5 KLD of water requirement during conversion of powder SSP (350 TPD) to granular SSP and total water requirement will be 93 KLD for which PP has already obtained consent from Welspun Projects Ltd., Dewas (vide letter dtd 18.10.12 for 100 KLD) at the time of obtaining prior EC for powder SSP 350 TPD.
- (3) It is noted that Prior EC has been issued by MP-SEIAA (vide letter no. 1779 dtd 21.12.2012 for case no. 662/2012) for Powder Single Super Phosphate (PSSP) production capacity 350 TPD at the same site to PP.
- (4) It was decided to accept the recommendation of 122<sup>nd</sup> SEAC meeting dated 11.03.2013 with 07 special conditions and accord prior Environmental Clearance for change in product form (physical) of Single Super Phosphate (SSP) from powder form to Granular form (GSSP) without change in production capacity i.e. 350 TPD at Plot No. – 6, 7, 8, 11, 12, 13, Sector I, Industrial Area, AB Road Near, Tata Square, Tehsil & Distt. Dewas (M.P.) by Mr. Ashish Tiwari M/s Varun Fertilizer Pvt. Ltd. 203, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Indore Trade Centre, South Tukoganj, Indore, (M. P.).
