- ❖ Details on hazardous wastes with respect to the quantity, characterization, storage, handling, transport and disposal has to be furnished.
- ❖ Agency for carrying out the Environmental monitoring has not been disclosed. Please note all monitoring has to be carried out by EPA / NABL approved laboratory. Certificate in this regard has to be furnished along with the EIA.
- ❖ The back-ground monitoring results needs better interpretation and projections using standard models.
