

## Minutes of the 98<sup>th</sup> Meeting of SEIAA dated 05.07.2012

The 98<sup>th</sup> meeting of the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority was convened on 05.07.12 at 10.30 AM at the Authority's Office in M. P. Pollution Control Board Building, Paryavaran Parisar, Bhopal. The meeting was chaired by Shri Amar Singh, Chairman, SEIAA. The following members attended the meeting:-

1. Following case has been considered and the details of the receipt of the additional information from PP is as follows :

2. **Case No. 23/2008** Prior Environmental Clearance for lime stone and dolomite mine in an area of 17.07 ha for production capacity 3.00 lakhs TPA at village Bistara, Tehsil Vijayraghgarh, District Katni by M/s N M Dubash Stone and Lime Co. Pvt. Ltd., Raghogarh Distt. Katni. M.P.

The case was discussed in 88<sup>th</sup> SEIAA meeting dtd. 03.04.12 and it has been recorded that " ..... the Authority decided that PP should submit the following documents within one month :-

- i. Latest Khasra Panchsala of the Khasra involved for mining activities and also notarized copy of the mining lease area.
  - ii. A letter from Divisonal Forest Officer, Katni indicating distance of the mining lease area from the Protected Areas (viz. National Park and Sancturies).
  - iii. A certificate owning of the content of the data and its originality."
- i. It was found that the distance of the proposed mine area is 43.75 km from the National Park / Sanctuary as per letter (no. Manchitrakar/3647 Katni dtd 07.06.12) issued by DFO, (General) Katni. Thus the general condition is not attracted.
  - ii. The Khasra Panchsala was examined and found satisfactory.
  - iii. It was decided to accord Prior Environmental Clearance for lime stone and dolomite mine in an area of 17.07 ha for production capacity 3.00 lakhs TPA at village Bistara, Tehsil Vijayraghgarh, District Katni by M/s N M Dubash Stone and Lime Co. Pvt. Ltd., Raghogarh Distt. Katni. M.P.

on the basis of the recommendation of the 32<sup>nd</sup> SEAC meeting dtd 24.07.09.

3. **Case No. 153/2008**, Prior Environmental Clearance for laterite, yellow ochride, manganese, red oxide, red ochride & fire clay mining in 48.562 ha at Village Jhinna Teh- Dhimmerkhera, Distt- Katni M.P. by M/s Sukhdeo Prasad Goenka C/o Goenka Bhawan, Station Road, Katni M.P.

The case was discussed in 73<sup>th</sup> SEIAA meeting dtd. 30.11.11 and it has been recorded that " .....PP should submit a joint report and map showing revenue land and forest land of the total area included in the mining lease. Both these should be signed by the Collector and DFO, Katni. PP should also submit a letter from the DFO, Katni indicating the distances of the Reserve and Protected Forests, if any, from the boundary of the area included in the mining lease. It was also decided to write to DFO and Collector, Katni to provide the above-mentioned information to the Proponent within one month."

- i. With reference to compliance of the above decision letter was sent to PP on 03.01.12 and endorsement to Collector and DFO (T) Katni for providing the information. Another letter was sent to Collector & DFO with endorsement to PP on the same day for providing required information to PP. DO letters were also written to DFO (T), Katni and Collector, Katni on 16.02.12. Subsequently DFO (T), Katni (vide letter no. 1456 dtd 29.02.12) informed the SEIAA that they have not received letter dtd 03.01.12. The entire information was sent to DFO, Katni on 18.04.12. However, no response was received by Collector & DFO (T), Katni. Subsequently PP submitted notarized copy of the Khasra Panchsala of 7 numbers out of the total 11 numbers involved in the case (vide their letter no. nil dtd 09.05.12). A letter was sent to PP on 23.05.12 to submit the remaining 4 Khasra Panchsala. The same was submitted by PP on 15.06.12.
- ii. The issue was discussed in depth and it was decided that DO, letters should be sent to Commissioner, Jabalpur Division, Jabalpur and also Chief Conservator, Forests, Jabalpur Circle, Jabalpur to direct the concerned Authorities to submit a joint report and map showing revenue land and forest land of the total area included in the mining lease duly signed by Collector & DFO, Katni as per decision taken in 73rd SEIAA meeting dtd 30.11.11. The endorsement letter should also be sent to Collector & DFO, Katni as well as PP.
4. **Case No. 156/2008**, Prior Environmental Clearance for Manganese ore mine in an area of 5.492 ha, production capacity 10,000 MT / year at Village Jagantola, Tehsil Baihar, District Balaghat, M.P. by M/S Smt. Leela Bhalavi
- The case was discussed in 84<sup>th</sup> SEIAA meeting dtd. 17.02.12 it has been recorded that " ..... the Authority decided that PP should be asked to submit following information within one month:-
- a. A letter from the Collector indicating distance of the interstate boundary from the proposed site.
- b. A letter from DFO indicating the distance of Protected Areas (National Park / Sanctuary etc. as per the Forest Act) from the proposed site.

- c. *Notarized copy of the latest Khasra Panchshala and mining lease.*
- d. *The permission of the Central Ground Water Authority for extracting the ground water.*

*A letter should be sent to Collector, Balaghat for providing distance of the interstate boundary from the mining site to the PP, and copy should be endorsed to PP.*

*A letter should be sent to Chief Wildlife Warden, Deptt. of Forest, MP for providing distance of Protected Areas (National Park / Sanctuary etc. as per the Wildlife Protection Act, 1972) from the proposed site to the PP, and copy should be endorsed to PP. "*


- i. As per information received from Collector office, Balaghat, MP vide letter no. 1124/Kha.Li.-2/12 Balaghat dtd 02.06.12 the interstate boundary of Chhatisgarh is 109 km and Maharashtra state is 115 km from the proposed mining site. As per DFO, Balaghat letter no. 1791 dtd 05.06.12 the proposed site is at a distance of 30 km from Kanha National Park and 18 km from Kanha-Pench Corridor. Hence, the general conditions are not attracted and SEIAA has jurisdiction.
  - ii. Land ownership documents (notarized copy lease deed & Khasra Panchsala) submitted by PP vide letter dtd 14.03.12 were examined and found to be satisfactory.
  - iii. Regarding permission from Central Ground Water Authority PP has submitted that the proposed mine area comes under safe zone and the water requirement is less than 50 KLD. Hence, CGWA permission is not required.
  - iv. It was decided to accord Prior Environmental Clearance for Manganese ore mine in an area of 5.492 ha, production capacity 10,000 MT / year at Village Jagantola, Tehsil Baihar, District Balaghat, M.P. by M/S Smt. Leela Bhalavi on the basis of the recommendation of the 87<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting dtd 07.01.12.
5. **Case No. 485/2009**, Prior Environmental Clearance for expansion of limestone from 45,000 TPA to 2,00,000 TPA (limestone + dolomite) mine in mineable area of 9.86 ha from existing area of 5.17 ha at village Ametha, Tehsil Vijayraghvargh, District Katni by M/s S. N. Sunderson & Co., Jabalpur Road, Bargawan, P. O. & District-Katni.

The case was discussed in 93<sup>rd</sup> SEIAA meeting dtd. 24.05.12 and it has been recorded that "..... Therefore, the life of the mining was considered for 5 years only, Thus the period of EC will be valid only for 5 years from the issue of the prior EC (if any).

*It was decided that a letter should be sent to PP whether unit has received any notice under section 5 of EPA 1986 or relevant section of Air and Water Acts and their compliance (as per office memorandum no. J-11013/41/2006-IA, II (I) dtd 01-07-11) from the date of issue of prior EC letter on 23-03-09. This should be submitted directly to the SEIAA....."*

- i. The informatin submitted by PP (vide letter dtd 22.06.12 & 29.06.12) was scrutinized and it was found that the Proponent has not received any notice under section of 5 of EPA, 1986 or relevant sections Air & Water Acts from the date of issue of the Prior EC earlier.
- ii. It was decided to accord Prior Environmental Clearance for expansion of limestone from 45,000 TPA to 2,00,000 TPA (limestone + dolomite) in mineable area of 9.86 ha from existing area of 5.17 ha at Village

Ametha, Tehsil Vijayraghavgarh District Katni by M/s S. N. Sunderson & Co., Jabalpur Road, Bargawan, P. O. & District-Katni on the basis of recommendation of the 93<sup>rd</sup> SEAC meeting minutes dtd 10.04.12. However, the prior Environmental Clearance for enhanced production shall be only for a period of 5 years.

6. **Case No. 497/2010**, Prior Environmental Clearance for High-rise multi stories residential project at village-Bicholi Mardana, Indore-M.P. by Shri Ashish Modi, Director M/s Milan Realities 2006 Oasis Trade centre, 20/22, Yeshwant Niwas Road, Indore-M.P.


The case was discussed in 80<sup>th</sup> SEIAA meeting dtd 19.01.12 "..... that PP should submit the following information within one month:


- i. As CGWA has given NOC for 121 cum / day. Therefore, PP should submit quantity and source for remaining water supply. If some amount is to be obtained from Municipal Corporation, Indore then their clear commitment.
  - ii. A plan with full details for action to be taken for ground water recharge as indicated in condition no. 3 in relation to ground water recharge measures issued by CGWA (vide no. 21-4(72)/NCR/CGWA/2010 dtd. 14.05.10)
  - iii. A fire fighting plan as per the National Building Code because the proposed height is more than 15 meters and also a notarized copy of the NOC for fire fighting issued by Fire Office, Bhopal (vide their letter no. 110-D dtd. 31.12.09)."
- i. The notarized copy of Khasra Panchsala was examined and it was found that the 2 Khasra nos. belong to Smt. Payal and remaining 2 Khasra belongs to Smt. Pooja as per information submitted by PP vide their letter dtd 16.05.12. It was decided to write a letter to PP for providing the legal arrangement between PP and Smt. Payal / Smt. Pooja.
  - ii. Regarding firm commitment of water from the Municipal Commissioner, Indore, the PP has again submitted photocopy of the earlier letter issued by Nagar Nigam in 2010 (vide their letter dtd 16.04.12). Thus the query is not satisfied. A firm commitment regarding water from the Municipal Corporation, Indore is required in this regard.
  - iii. The PP has again not submitted a plan with adequate details for action to be taken for ground water recharge as indicated in condition no. 3 about ground water recharge measures issued by CGWA on 14.05.10.
  - iv. The project is located outside Indore Municipal Corporation limit. The reported height of the building is approx. 24 m. The decision contained in Office Memorandum (no. 21-270/2008-IA.III dtd 07.02.12) of Ministry of Environment & Forest, Govt are applicable to this case. The Proponent has to submit fire NOC from local fire station. Since it is located out side Indore Municipal Corporation, the distance of the project from the nearest local fire station should also be provided.
  - v. The above mentioned information should be submitted by PP by 15.09.12. Failing this the case will be summarily rejected. Registered letter should be sent to the PP.
