 - ii. In response to the above queries information submitted by PP vide their letter No. NIL dt. 28.12.2012 was examined and it is noted that the fresh water demand is of 411 KLD. It was decided that as submitted by PP the fresh water requirement should not exceed 411 KLD as against the condition of fresh water quantity (571 KLD) approved by SEAC (93th SEAC meeting dtd 10.04.12). In view of vicinity of the project area to the Bhopal township regarding the source of water it was decided that PP should be asked why Municipal Water is not being used for the project and PP should submit details of efforts made by him regarding Municipal Water Supply.
 - iii. It was noted that regarding fire fighting NOC, PP has submitted copy of application submitted to Bhopal Municipal Corporation. It is decided that PP should submit clear fire fighting NOC from the Bhopal Municipal Corporation or competent authority.

- (3). In response to the above query, reply submitted by PP (vide letter dtd 28.01.13 & 22.02.2013 and received in SEIAA office on 30.01.2013 & 26.02.13 respectively) was examined in depth and it is noted that:
 - (i) as per information submitted by PP (vide letter dtd 28.12.12) the total water requirement is 860 KLD and fresh water requirement is 411 KLD. PP has submitted that the project site falls in Gram-Panchayat area outside the Bhopal Municipal area located 15 k. m. away from the nearest Municipal Water supply line and 7 km. away from the ongoing Narmada pipe line. So at present it is impossible to connect project water supply line to Municipal/Narmada line particularly for this project. According to PP BMC has assured (verbally) that in future if any water supply network passes through the project area then water supply from BMC will be considered for the project.
- (4). It is decided that until the NOC for water supply from Municipal Corporation, Bhopal is not obtained and submitted by the PP, the project is summarily rejected and all concerned should be informed accordingly.
- Case no. 667/2012, Prior Environmental Clearance for Building Construction "Prabhatam Heights" Group Housing project at Village- Hatai Khera ,Raisen Road, Bhopal (M.P.) Plot Area- 86,682.94 m² Built - up Area- 1,26,942.49 m² by M/s Prabhatam Infrastructure Ltd. through Mr. Dinesh Gupta, M.D., Rastriya Tower, 38, Rani Jhansi Road, New Delhi- 55
 - (1) The case was discussed in 109th SEIAA meeting dtd 08.10.2012 and it is recorded that i. ii. The case was examined and it was noted that :
 - a. The land proposed by PP is 8.66 ha and Khasras are as mentioned in annex-I of Form-1. The Khasra Panchsala submitted for these Khasra is for the year 2005-2006. PP is directed to submit the notarized copy of latest Khasra Panchsala of the Khasras included in the project.
 - b. Further as per policy decision taken in 101st SEIAA meeting dtd 27.07.12 PP should submit notarized copy of registered agreement between PP and owners of the land, included in the project.
 - c. The PP has submitted permission from T & CP issued vide letter no. 324 dtd 26.02.11 for high rise building construction. PP is directed to submit the details of width of the internal road w.r.t height of the building, MOS, as per sub rule 2 of Rule 42 of Madhya Pradesh Bhumi Vikas Niyam 2012 as has been prescribed in the Table 4 or 5 applicable to the PP.  - e. The total water requirement is 1322 KLD (fresh water 791 KLD and recycled water 533 KLD). As per recommendation of 103rd SEAC meeting dtd 12.09.12 the fresh water requirement shall not exceed 1322 KLD for which BMC has given permission (vide letter no. 287/PM/JNNURM/WS/ 2012 dtd 17.03.12) under the condition that water supply shall be available after the project completion and PP will have to take legal bulk connection from the BMC overhead tank or its distribution pipe line. PP shall be responsible to lay the pipeline from this point at his cost and risk. PP is directed that total demand of water should be met through municipal supply and there should be no extraction of ground water.

- (2) In response to above query, reply submitted by PP (vide letter dtd 12.12.12, 01.03.13 & 16.05.13 received in SEIAA office on 17.12.12, 01.03.13 & 16.05.13 respectively) was examined in depth and it is noted that:
 - (i) PP has submitted notarized copy of Khasra Panchsala for year 2012-2013 and it is noted that as per the Khasra Panchsala (2012-13) the total nos. of Khasras are 28 having total area of 8.604 ha. It is observed that there is difference of 0.064 ha (640 sqmt.) which is negligible in view of total project area 86682.94 sqmt. As per Khasra Panchsala the ownership of the land in the name of M/s Prabhatam Infrastructure Ltd. Co. and is satisfactory.
 - (ii) As per the map approved by T & CP the width of main internal road is 12 m front MOS is 22.5 m and side & rear MOS is 10 m. It is decided that the width of main internal road within the campus should not be less than 18 m as per MOEF, Gol OM no. 21-270/2008-IA.III dtd. 07.02.2012 for building height between 15 – 30 m.
 - (iii) PP has proposed total parking for 1200 ECS (Open 204 ECS area 24900 sqmt. Stilt 996 ECS area 6120 sqmt.). It is decided that PP should provide total 1270 ECS (Res. @ 1 ECS/ 100 sqmt. a. PP has submitted notarized (vide letter dtd 27.11.12 received in SEIAA office on 30.11.12) copy of latest Khasra Panchsala for all the desired khasras. It is noted that the possession of land is in the name of Coral Infrastructure pvt. Ltd. through director Vijay S/o Shri Harish Mirchandani.

b. PP has submitted notarized copy of map approved by T & CP Indore and it

satisfactory.

- c. PP has submitted that as per Gazette notification dtd. 26.05.10 building permission cannot be issued before prior EC as per the policy decision of 111th SEIAA mtg. dtd. 23.10.12 the building permission is not necessary for appraising the case.
- d. PP (vide letter dtd 27.11.12) has submitted copy of letter (dtd 24.05.12) submitted to Commissioner Nagar Nigam Indore for grant of consent for water supply and solid waste disposal permission from Indore Municipal Corporation and along with copy of receipt Narmada CESS fee for Rs.1056308 submitted to Municipal Corporation Indore. It is noted that PP has not received reply from Nagar Nigam, Indore for water supply. h. As per T & CP approval dtd 03.07.2010 the parking area 9817.0 sqmt. Is provided. As per the presentation made before the SEAC and as recorded in 92nd SEAC meeting dtd. 09.04.12 PP has provided parking space for 1193 ECS which is in compliance of MPBVR 2012.

 - e. PP has proposed total parking area 11345 sqmt. (.ppt before SEAC dtd 13.06.12 & Form-1A point no. 5.3) for 355 cars (17 open, 182 stilt parking & 156 basement). However as per MPBVR 2012 the parking provisions should be for 500 ECS (as per Rule 84 (1) clause 1 (3) table)
 - f. PP has submitted (received in SEIAA office on 22.02.13) Nagar Nigam, Bhopal letter no. 64 dtd 22.02.13 regarding distance (7.73 km) from the nearest fire station – Govindpura, Bhopal and is satisfactory.
 - g. The total waste water generation is 279 KLD and PP has provided STP of 300 KLD. It was decided that the final disposal of treated waste water should be integrated with the Municipal sewer system.
 - h. Municipal solid waste generation is 1163 kg / day. It is decided that the final disposal of MSW should be linked with the Municipal Corporation, Bhopal.
 - i. PP has submitted that it is a partnership firm and no power of attorney has been given. PP has submitted latest Khasra Panchsala (2012-13) and copy of deed of retirement (dtd 05.08.03) in which it is mentioned that the partner Adarsh Malhotra has left the firm and all the land now belong to M/s Opal Developers through Mr. Kishore Mirchandani. It is decided that PP should submit notarized copy of registered partnership deed.
 - The PP should submit the above information by 15.05.2013."

Mirchandani, Sanjay H. Mirchandani (HUF), Sanjay H. Mirchandani, Kishore H. Mirchandani (HUF) & Mirchandani Project Pvt. Ltd. in the name of M/s Opal Developers and is satisfactory.
- (3) It was decided to accept the recommendations of 101st SEAC meeting dtd 22.08.2012 with 8 special conditions and accord prior Environmental Clearance to Residential project total land area 4.72 acres (19113.21 sqm), total built up area 50025.75 sqmt. (FAR) at Village Bawadia Kalan, Tehsil- Huzur, Bhopal (M.P.) by M/s Opal Developers through, Shri Sunil Mewani (CEO) Shalimar house, 6 Malviya Nagar, Rajbhawan Road-Bhopal-M.P.

 - In response to queries made in 114th SEIAA meeting dtd 06.12.12 information submitted by PP (vide letter dtd 21.12.12 received in SEIAA office on 27.12.12) was examined and it is noted that:
 - a. The land ownership, T & CP approval, building permission, parking, built up area, NOC for water supply, distance from fire station has been discussed in earlier meetings and found satisfactory. PP has submitted undertaking (dtd 21.12.12) that no ground water shall be extracted for the project and water shall be used as per provided by Nagar Palika Parishad, Kolar.

 The fire NOC (vide letter no. 3211 dtd 20.12.12) from Nagar Palika Parishad, Kolar was examined and found satisfactory.

- d. It has been recorded in the proceedings of 98th SEAC meeting dtd 25.07.12 that PP has accepted that preliminary works have been under taken at the site. As per 114th SEIAA meeting dtd 06.12.12 it is a case of violation and PP was asked to submit the details of the works already executed. In response to the query PP vide letter 21.12.12 has submitted that preliminary works executed includes part excavation of land and part making of substructure of basement. It is noted that the information is not signed. It is decided that PP should submit the full details of built up area and the area which has been constructed / developed and percentage of the work done the document should be duly signed by authorized signatory and no further construction be done till the case is decided.
- PP should submit the above information by 28.05.2013.
- (2) In response to above query, the reply submitted by PP (vide letter dtd 03.04.2013 received in SEIAA office on 08.05.2013) was examined in depth and it is noted that:
 - (i). PP has submitted duly signed undertaking stating that the proposed built up area is 83651 sqmt. PP has done excavation and part basement construction of 3162 sqmt. (3.78%). It is decided that PP should submit why the construction work has been done though the EIA Notification for prior Environmental Clearance has been notified in 2006.
- (3) It is decided that PP should submit the above information latest by 31.07.2013 and if these information are not received the case will summarily be rejected. Member Secretary should ensure the case is put up before the Authority in the first meeting in August 2013.
