    - (2). The response to above query, reply submitted by PP (vide letter dtd 14.06.13 received in SEIAA office on 20.06.2013) pertaining to above points was discussed in depth and it is noted that:-
      - (i). PP has submitted copy of application (dtd. 22.06.12) to Executive Engineer, PHED, Musakhedi, Indore & Commissioner Nagar Nigam, Indore (dtd. 01.06.12) for supply of 252 KLD water. It is decided that a letter should be sent to Commissioner Municipal Corporation, Indore to appraise the decision of water supply to the project.
      - (ii). PP has submitted NOC from Nagar Nigam Indore for joining drainage connection of the project near the I.D. A. line of the drainage. PP has deposited Rs. 1.13.604 (One lakh thirteen thousand & six hundred four) vide receipt no. 151/34 for drainage connection. It is noted that in the said NOC / letter of Nagar Nigam submitted by PP neither dispatch no. nor date is mentioned. It is decided that a letter should sent to Commissioner Municipal Corporation, Indore asking him to submit whether the said letter submitted by PP has been issued by Zonal Officer, Zone No. 8, Vijay Nagar, Indore ? and as mentioned in the letter whether fees has been deposited ? If yes a certified copy of the letter be made available to the SEIAA office.

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- PP has submitted notarized & certified copy of letter issued by Zonal Officer Zone no. 8, Nagar Nigam, Indore for joining drainage connection of the project near the IDA line of the drainage along with receipt (dtd. 14.06.12) for Rs. 1,13,604 fees deposited for drainage connection. It is decided that PP should ensure the disposal of extra treated waste water into the Municipal sewer line and should obtain clear NOC from Nagar Nigam, Indore before starting any construction activity.
- PP has submitted notarized copy of letter (no.1102 dtd. 03.08.13) issued from Nagar Nigam, Indore regarding MSW disposal. In the letter it is mentioned that Mayor in Council decision no. 771 dtd 04.03.13 has decided fee of Rs. 1,000 per tonne of MSW (Rs. 600 transportation and Rs. 400/- processing fee) for disposal of MSW. PP has been directed to give the details of number of houses / flats so that after fixing of fee that Municipal Solid waste would be collected from the site. It is decided that PP should deposit the requisite fee and obtain clear NOC from Nagar Nigam, Indore for disposal of MSW before starting any construction activity.
- (iii). - b. It is noted that the total water requirement is 269 KLD and fresh water requirement is 161 KLD. The source of water is municipal supply. SEAC in its 119<sup>th</sup> meeting dtd 02.02.13 has recommended that fresh water demand shall not exceed from 161 KLD (Municipal Water Supply 96 KLD and Ground water 65 KLD). PP has submitted NOC from Nagar Palika Nigam, Gwalior (vide letter no. 232 dtd 25.03.13) for supply of 161 KLD water and is satisfactory. It is decided that the entire demand of fresh water should be met through the Municipal Water supply and there should be no extraction of ground water.
- c. The total waste water generation is 185.4 KLD. PP has provided sewage treatment plant of 186 KLD capacity. The total treated waste water 168 KLD. Out of this 107 KLD is proposed to be recycled (flushing 72.86 KLD and horticulture 35.12 KLD while extra treated water will be 60 KLD). PP has applied (vide letter dtd. 02.04.13) to Nagar Nigam, Gwalior for discharge of extra treated water in Municipal Corporation sewer line. It was decided that PP should ensure (60 KLD) the final disposal of treated waste water is integrated with the Municipal sewer system. PP should submit NOC from Municipal Corporation, Gwalior for discharge of treated waste water.

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- d. PP has provided rooftop rain water harvesting system with network of percolations wells for artificial recharge of ground water.
- e. The fire fighting system have been designed as per National Building Code 2005 and PP has provided facilities such as hose reel system & wet riser system connected with water tanks, sprinkler system, emergency fire alarm system, fire extinguisher, fire exit, fire control room, overhead two water tanks with 10,000 L capacity and underground tank with 75,000 L capacity etc. PP has submitted fire fighting NOC from Nagar Palika Nigam, Gwalior (vide no. 116/2012/4/11/Fire 276 Gwalior dtd 09.08.2012) which is satisfactory. The distance of fire station is 3.1 km as per letter no. 1/13/4/11 Fire dtd. 18.03.13 from Nagar Palika Nigam, Gwalior which is within the range for building having height between 30-45 m as per the MoEF, GoI office memorandum (vide no. 21-270/2008IA.III dtd 07.02.12) guidelines for high-rise buildings.
- f. The maximum height of the building is 33 m (stilt + 11). PP has provided ROW 33 m, Front MOS 16.50 and side / rear MOS 7.50 m. It was decided that the width of internal main road within the campus of the building should not be less than 18 m as per MoEF, Gol office memorandum (vide no. 21-270/2008/A.//II dtd 07.02.12) guidelines for high-rise buildings between 30 45 m.
- g. Approximately 0.633 tonnes per day of Municipal Solid waste shall be generated this shall be segregated at source and collected in different colored covered bins. PP has applied to Nagar Nigam, Gwalior (vide letter dtd 20.09.12) for disposal of Municipal Solid waste. It is decided that the final disposal of MSW should be linked with the Municipal Corporation, Gwalior. PP should submit the NOC from Municipal Corporation Gwalior for disposal of MSW.
- h. As per MPBVR required car parking is 264 ECS (26387.00/100 = 264 ECS) and PP (vide letter dtd 01.04.2013) has provided 374 ECS (1<sup>st</sup> basement 5050/35 = 144 cars, 2<sup>nd</sup> Basement 5072/35 = 144 cars, stilt parking area 2587/30 = 86 cars) which is sufficient.
- (2). In response to the above query, reply submitted by PP (vide letter dtd 27.08.13 received in SEIAA office on 29.08.13) was examined in depth and it is noted that:-
  - (i). The issue of road width was discussed in 127<sup>th</sup> SEIAA meeting dtd 22.07.2013 and it was decided that the width of internal main road within the campus of the building should not be less than 18 m as per MoEF, Gol office memorandum vide no. 21270/2008/IA Div. III dtd 07.02.2012 guidelines for high rise building between 32-45 m. The issue was revisited in view of MoEF, Gol office Memorandum F. No. 21-270/2008-IA.III dtd 06.06.2013 and it is decided that the road width and open spaces should be as per Rule no. 42 and other provisions as applicable of the MP Bhumi Vikas Rules, 2012 for building up to height 45 m.
  - (ii). PP has submitted notarized copy of partnership deed executed (dtd.29.02.12) between Shri Jitendra Singh S/o Angand Singh, Rajesh Singh S/o Shri Ram Gopal Singh, Shobhana Sharma D/o Raghuwardyal Barua, Smt. Sunita Sharma D/o J.D.Tyagi and Smt. Seema Bhadoria W/o D.V.S. Bhadoria, the owners of the proposed project land and is satisfactory.
  - (iii). PP vide letter dtd 27.08.13 has stated that the total treated waste water will be 168 from STP. After use of recycle water 60 KLD waste water will remain. The treated waste water will be within State Pollution Control

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Board stipulated Standards & submitted a copy of letter (dtd. 21.08.13) issued from Gwalior Municipal Corporation regarding disposal of extra treated water. In this letter it is mention that in Gwalior Town the sewerage system is proposed and once the sewer line is laid down and is in operation the NOC for sewer connection can be given after deposition of necessary fee by PP. It is decided that there is no sewer line in the Gwalior project area. PP should obtain NOC for operation of STP from MPPCB. The treated waste water should confirm to the standard norms prescribed by CPCB / MPPCB for disposal of treated waste water. PP should ensure that once the sewer line is laid down the disposal of treated waste water should be linked with the Municipal Sewer line.

- (iv). PP has submitted copy of consent letter issued from Gwalior Municipal Corporation (dtd. 07.08.13) regarding disposal of Municipal solid waste in the letter it is mention that door to door segregated waste collection, storage and covered transportation of MSW up to their trenching ground is to be done by PP as per the MSW Rules 2000 for handling and disposal of solid waste at their own cost also the consumer charges are to be paid to the Municipal Corporation, Gwalior. It is decided that PP should ensure the disposal of MSW in integration with the Municipal Corporation, Gwalior.
- (v). The issue of car parking was discussed earlier in 127<sup>th</sup> SEIAA meeting dtd 22.07.2013 and it was noted that PP has provided car parking space for 374 ECS and is sufficient. However, this issue is revisited in view of MoEF, Gol office Memorandum F. No. 21-270/2008-IA.III dtd 06.06.2013. Subsequently it was brought to the notice of Authority the calculation of total built up area as per sub rule 30 of rule no. 2 of MPBVR 2012 do not include the parking area, service area etc. PP has not submitted the details of area as per the MPBVR 2012 as above it is decided that PP should provide detailed break up of built up area as per sub rule no. 30 of rule 2 of MPBVR 2012 for car parking calculation latest by 31.10.2013.
- (vi). The Authority decided that in principle there is no difficulty in granting EC. However, the EC shall be granted after submission of the information pertaining to point no. (v) above by PP latest by 31.10.2013.
- 3. Case no. 1333/2013, Application for Prior Environmental Clearance for expansion of area development and township projects "Malwa County" (existing 26,500.24 m<sup>2</sup>,) plot area 4,42,890 m<sup>2</sup> and total built up area after expansion 1,48,895.85 m<sup>2</sup> at Khasra No. 112, 113/3, 113/4, 119/3/1, 119/3/2/1, 128, 129/4/1, 129/4/3, 130, 131, 132, 133/1/2 KH, 133/1/2/GH, 133/2, 133/3, 133/159, 134, 137, 138, 139, 140/1, 140/2/1, 140/2/2, 141, 142, 143/2, 144/2, 146/1, 146/2, 146/3, 146/4, 147, 148/1, 148/2, 150, 151, 152, 155/2/1, 155/2/2, 155/2/3, 155/2/4, 155/3, 156/1, 158/2 & 158/3 at village Rau Khedi, Tehsil Sanwer, District Indore by M/s Satya Infrastructures Ltd.

- The case was discussed in 138<sup>th</sup> SEIAA meeting dated 20.06.2013 and it is recorded that "
  - Application submitted by PP (vide letter no. nil dtd 04.03.13 received in SEIAA office 08.03.13).
  - (2) Case sent to SEAC for appraisal vide letter no. 3008 dtd 18.03.13.
  - (3) The case was discussed in 126<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting dtd 10.04.2013 and in the minutes it is recorded that ".....the construction activity has already been initiated at the site without obtaining prior EC. Thus it is a clear case of violation of EIA Notification. Committee decided to return the case to SEIAA. SEIAA may like to issue directions for appraisal of the case in light of MoEF, GoI, OM No. J-110131/41/2006-IA-II (I) dtd 12.12.2012".
  - (4) PP has submitted vide letter no. nil dtd 03.05.13 received in SEIAA office on 06.05.2013 a copy of resolution passed by Board of Directors in the meeting dtd 03.05.13.
  - (5) It is decided that as per MoEF, GoI, OM No. J-110131/41/2006-IA-II (I) dtd 12.12.2012 PP should submit the details as to why the construction activities have been undertaken? How much construction has already been done? Whether the construction activities are still continuing? If yes PP is directed to stop the construction activities with immediate effect and should not undertake any kind of construction until prior EC under EIA Notification 2006 is accorded.
  - (6) It is decided that PP should submit the above information latest by 31.08.2013 and if these information are not received the case will summarily be rejected.
- (2). In response to the above query, reply submitted by PP (vide letter dtd 2.08.13 received in SEIAA office on 19.08.13) was examined in depth and it is noted that:-
  - (a) PP vide letter dt 02.08.2013 has submitted that the company applied for consent to establish to the Member Secretary, MP Pollution Control Board on 1<sup>st</sup> Aug 2006.
  - (b) Accordingly, the permission to establish the township and area development project was accorded by the MPPCB Bhopal through letter no. 7367/MOCBP007 dtd. 18<sup>th</sup> Sep.2007.
  - (c) The development of the township was undertaken after procurement of CTE sanctioned by MPPCB, Bhopal vide letter dtd. 18.09.07.
  - (d) MPPCB, Bhopal vide letter no. 5145/Tech/SE 1/PCB/2012 dt. 12.07.12, issued a notice asking explanation for not having procured the EC, quoting reference of the EIA Notification 2006 & Minutes of meeting of 91<sup>st</sup> MP SEIAA meeting dt.11.05.12, through which the environment clearance was made mandatory for all projects with built up area more than 20,000 sq. m.
  - (e) PP submitted reply to MPPCB, Bhopal and RO MPPCB, Indore justifying that the case do not require EC as:-

 That the Malwa County Project is covered in the of item 8 (b) category of EIA Notification 2006.

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- (ii) That the CTE was procured on 18<sup>th</sup> Sept 2007 and the legislation of Prior EC, implemented through minutes of mtg. of 91<sup>st</sup> SEIAA meeting dtd 11.05.2012.
- (f) MPPCB, Bhopal vide their notice no. 7404/Tech/SE-1/PCB/2012 dtd 09.10.2012 intimated that the CTE issued on 18<sup>th</sup> Sep 2007 stands cancelled on the ground of MPPCB, not being satisfied by the reply submitted by the PP & further instructed not to carry out / undertake any further construction work.
- (g) PP has submitted that till then the area to the tune of 23,539.18 sq mt had been constructed, thereafter the complete construction work of the township was stopped & since then "No construction work has taken place at all"
- (h) After that PP filed an appeal in the appellate authority MP Govt. Deptt. of housing & environment, pleading for reinstate of the CTE issued long back in the year 2007 & resumption of construction work as the legislation of enforcing the decision of making EC mandatory for all the projects whose built up area is greater than 20,000 sqmt. through 91<sup>st</sup> MP SEIAA meeting dtd 11.05.2012,was implemented much later.
- (i) Appellate authority returned the appeal and advised PP to apply for EC however, passed the comments , "अपीलार्थी द्वारा पर्यावरणीय स्वीकृति के लिए आवेदन करने पर बोर्ड दिनांक 09.10.2012 के अपने पत्र में दिये गये निर्देशों पर पुनः विचार कर सकता हैं"
- (j) Application for EC was submitted by PP in the office of MPSEIAA on 04.03.2013.
  - (i) Aafter examining the facts in depth the Authority is of the view that inspite of the notice dt 09.10.2012 issued by MPPCB, PP applied for prior EC on 04.03.2013 and has constructed 23,539.18 sq mt (more than 20000 sq. m) area out of the total built up area of the 1,48,895.85 m² and is serious violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 hence it is decided to reject the case outrightly for grant of prior EC as per Para 7 of the Memorandum No. J-11013/41/2006-IA.II (I) dtd 12.12.12 issued by the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Gol .
  - (ii) A letter should be sent to Secretary, GoMP, Housing and Environment giving the details of violation and office memorandum of MoEF, Gol J-11013/41/2006 IA II (I)dt. 12.12.2012 (Para 2) "to initiate credible action on the violation by invoking powers under section 19 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for taking necessary legal action under section 15 of the Act for the period for which the violation has taken place and evidence provided to MoEF of the credible action taken." The details of legal action taken by the Secretary H&EN GoMP taken should be made available to the Authority by 31.10. 2013.
  - (iii) The details of project proponent, a copy of commitment and Resolution (submitted by PP vide letter dt 03.05.2013 received in SEIAA office on 06.05.2013) passed in the meeting of the Board of Directors of M/s Satya Infrastructures Ltd. New Delhi held on 03.05.13 should be put on the website of MPSEIAA for information of all stake holders.

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- 4. Case no. 1562/2013, Application for Prior Environmental Clearance for proposed "Silver Estate Vertica" Group Housing Project total plot area 16,700 sqmt. & built up area 27033.48 sq m. at Survey Nos. 60, 61, 62, 63, 64/1, 66, village Katara, Tehsil Huzur, District Bhopal by M/s Macker Real Ventures through Mr. Neeraj Bhushan Macker owner 501, 5<sup>th</sup> Floor, Ashima Corporate Zone, Ashima Mall, Hoshangabad Road, Bhopal 462026, Ph. No. 405-3444, 6461989, Email info@mackerrealventures.com.
  - The case was discussed in 138<sup>th</sup> SEIAA meeting dated 20.06.2013 and it is recorded that"
    - (1). Application submitted by PP (vide letter no. nil dtd 08.03.13 received in SEIAA office 22.03.13).
    - (2). Cases sent to SEAC for appraisal vide letter no. 3265 dtd 26.03.13.
    - (3). The case was discussed in 126<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting dtd 10.04.2013. In the minutes it is recorded that "the construction activity has already been initiated at the site without obtaining prior EC. Thus it is a clear case of violation of EIA Notification. Committee decided to return the case to SEIAA. SEIAA may like to issue directions for appraisal of the case in light of MoEF, Gol, OM No. J-110131/41/2006-IA-II (I) dtd 12.12.2012".
    - (4). PP vide letter no. nil dtd 10.04.13 received in SEIAA office on 15.04.2013 has submitted that they have constructed portion of the project without obtaining environmental clearance. The reason given is lack of information and also share ignorance to the applicable laws and conditions w.r.t the project of such magnitude. The letter was forwarded to SEAC vide no. 500/SEIAA/2013 dtd 09.05.13.
    - (5). PP has submitted vide letter no. nil dtd 03.05.13 received in SEIAA office on 03.05.2013 a copy of resolution passed by Board of Directors.
    - (6). It is decided that as per MoEF, GoI, OM No. J-110131/41/2006-IA-II (I) dtd 12.12.2012 PP should submit the details as to why the construction activities have been undertaken? How much construction has already been done? Whether the construction activities are still continuing? if yes PP is directed to stop the construction activities with immediate effect and should not undertake any kind of construction until prior EC under EIA Notification 2006 is accorded.

It is decided that PP should submit the above information latest by 31.08.2013 and if these information are not received the case will summarily be rejected"

- (2). In response to above query, reply submitted by PP (vide letter dtd 12.08.13 received in SEIAA office on 12.08.13) was examined and it is noted that:-
  - (i). PP has submitted that the layout plan of the project was approved on 12.04.11 from the T & CP vide letter no. 652. The construction was started at project site after receiving Development permission on 29.10.11 from Gram Panchyat, Tehsil Huzur, Distt. Bhopal, which was due to lack of knowledge about EIA Notification, 2006.
  - (ii). Plot area is 16,700 m<sup>2</sup> and built-up area is 27,033.28 m<sup>2</sup> out of which 50% area was constructed till date and then construction was stopped.
  - (iii). Construction activities were immediately stopped at site after knowing the fact that the above case is required to get an Environmental Clearance before undertaking any kind of construction at site under EIA Notification 2006.

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- (iv). Accordingly PP applied to SEIAA on 22.03.13 for obtaining the environmental clearance.
- (v). PP has submitted vide letter no. nil dtd 03.05.13 received in SEIAA office on 03.05.2013 a copy of resolution passed by Board of Directors.
- (vi). PP has also submitted endorsement copy of letter (dt. 02.08.2013 received in SEIAA office on 12.08.2013) addressed to MS-MPPCB in which he has requested for initiating the legal action as per Memorandum No. J-11013/41/2006-IA.II (I) dtd 12.12.12 issued by the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Gol.
- (vii). After examining the facts in depth the Authority is of the view that, PP has constructed 50% of the total built up area which is serious violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 hence it is decided to reject the case outrightly for grant of prior EC as per Para 7 of the Memorandum No. J-11013/41/2006-IA.II (I) dtd 12.12.12 issued by the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Gol.
- (viii). A letter should be sent to Secretary, GoMP, Housing and Environment giving the details of violation and office memorandum of MoEF, Gol J-11013/41/2006 IA II (I)dt. 12.12.2012 (Para 2) "to initiate credible action on the violation by invoking powers under section 19 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for taking necessary legal action under section 15 of the Act for the period for which the violation has taken place and evidence provided to MoEF of the credible action taken." The details of legal action taken by the Secretary H&EN GoMP taken should be made available to the Authority by 31.10. 2013.
- (ix). The details of project proponent, a copy of commitment and Resolution (submitted by PP vide letter dt 03.05.2013 received in SEIAA office on 03.05.2013) passed in the meeting of the Board of Directors of M/s Macker Real Ventures builders and developers, Bhopal should be put on the website of MPSEIAA for information of all stake holders.

#### C. Other Cases

- 5. Case No. 517/2010, Prior Environmental Clearance for Silpatpura Granite quarry lease in an area of 6.75 ha for Production Capacity of 8000 cum per annum at village Silpatpura, Teh-Laundi, Distt-Chhatarpur-M.P. by Shri Manwendra Singh, Vill. & P O Ghuraiya, Tehsil Tehraoli, Distt-Jhansi (U.P). Regarding change the name of PP in the EC letter.
  - (1) It is noted that PP has requested vide no nil dtd. 14.08.2013 to make amendment in the Prior EC letter by changing the name of PP of the mining project namely "Shri Balaji Goodearth address 25/604, Oshiwara Andheri West Mumbai" in place of "Shri Manwendra Singh, Vill. & P O Ghuraiya, Tehsil – Tehraoli, Distt-Jhansi".

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- (2) It is noted that Prior EC letter was issued vide letter No. 1218 dated 22.07.2013 in the name of Shri Manwendra Singh, Vill. & P O Ghuraiya, Tehsil – Tehraoli, Distt-Jhansi
- (3) It is noted that Shri Manwendra Singh (Transferor) has submitted the application with a request to change the name and address in the EC letter namely; Shri Balaji Goodearth address 25/604, Oshiwara Andheri West Mumbai (Transferee). However, the transferee has not submitted any application in this regard.

Further it is noted that in support of his request the PP (Transferor) has submitted the following documents:-

- i. Notarized copy of transfer letter of lease vide order No. 15402–405 / खनिज / न.क्र.112 / उ.प. / हस्ता. / 2012 Dated 12.10.2012.
- ii. Notarized copy of transfer deed of the lease dated 24.01.2013.

In context of above the issue was considered as per Para-11 of EIA Notification 2006- Transferability of Environmental Clearance (EC). There is a provision of transferring the EC which is mentioned here under;

- Para-11: A prior environmental clearance granted for a specific project or activity to an applicant may be transferred during its validity to another legal person entitled to undertake the project or activity on application by the transferor, or by the transferee with a written "no objection" by the transferor, to, and by the regulatory authority concerned, on the same terms and conditions under which the prior environmental clearance was initially granted, and for the same validity period. No reference to the Expert Appraisal Committee or State Level Expert Appraisal Committee concerned is necessary in such cases.
- (4) It was found that the lease has been transferred in the name of Shri Balaji Goodearth address 25/604, Oshiwara Andheri West Mumbai (vide order No. 15402–405/खनিज/न.क्र.112/उ.प./हस्ता./2012 Dated 12.10.2012) and accordingly the transfer deed of the lease (dated 24-01-2013) was signed by both "Shri Manwendra Singh, Vill. & P O Ghuraiya, Tehsil Tehraoli, Distt-Jhansi (Transferor) "and "Shri Balaji Goodearth address 25/604, Oshiwara Andheri West Mumbai (Transferee)".
- (5) Hence, it was decided to amend the Prior E C letter by changing the name and address of PP, namely; Shri Balaji Goodearth, 25/604, Oshiwara Andheri West Mumbai on the same terms and conditions under which the prior environmental clearance was initially granted, and for the same validity period. as per EIA Notification Para-11 in place of "Shri Manwendra Singh, Vill. & P O Ghuraiya, Tehsil Tehraoli, Distt-Jhansi" and all concerned authorities should be informed accordingly.
