

Minutes of Second SEIAA Meeting held on 16th September'08

The second meeting of State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority was convened on 16th September'08 at 11.00 A M at SEIAA's in M.P. Pollution Control Board Building, Paryavaran Parisar, Bhopal, chaired by Shri Subroto Banerji,

The following members attended the meeting:-

The following cases recommended by SEAC for granting environmental clearance were discussed.

A. M/s Rio Tinto Exploration India Ltd, Bulk sample process plant, Beneficiation plant for bunder prospecting. at Bakswaha, Chhatarpur M.P. (Case No. 53/2008)

Project proponent made a presentation before the members. SEAC has recommended the proposal for granting prior environmental clearance, but no clear observations of SEAC have been recorded in the minutes.

After going through the case file and discussion with the project proponent the members observed that project proponent should submit clarification on following issues:-

- i. Nature of activities in the buffer zone of the plant which falls within the forest area.
- ii. Whether any radio active waste will be generated.
- iii. Acceptability of the method of disposal of the residue of the process.

It was decided that the case should be sent back to SEAC to examine and give opinion on above aspects in their next meeting.

B. Kanha Mall multiplex and Kanha Tower at Bag Mugalia Bhopal (Case No 18/2008)

Project proponent made a presentation before the member of the authority. It was decided in the meeting that project proponent should submit following information.

- i. As the area where the project is proposed, faces problem of water logging. Hence project proponent should submit detail calculations about the storm water and how it will be taken care of.
- ii. Project proponent has mentioned in form 1 about using ground water for construction while committed during presentation that they will buy water. The source/availability of water during construction be confirmed.

- iii. Details regarding safe disposal of sewage and solid waste and specify how the sludge coming out from STP will be disposed.

It was decided to send the proposal back to SEAC for consideration on the above issues in their next meeting.

Meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to the chair.
