

Minutes of the 45th SEIAA Meeting held on 10th January, 2011

The 45th meeting of the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority was convened on 10th January, 2011 at 12.30 P.M. at the Authority's office in M.P. Pollution Control Building, Paryavaran Parisar, Bhopal chaired by Shri Amar Singh, Chairman SEIAA.

(A) Cases recommended for Prior Environmental Clearance

1. M/s Shri Rajat Sen Gupta, Project Leader, Bharat Petroleum Corpn. Ltd, LPG filling plant plot no 6 & 7 Kheda Industrial area sector, Pitampur, Distt- Dhar, Additional LPG mounded storage (1X600) MT at existing LPG plant at plot no 6 & 7 Kheda industrial area sector-4, Pithampur, Dhar-M.P. **Case no 500/2010.**

The above proposal was received from SEAC on 8th December 2010 with the recommendation to grant Prior Environmental Clearance. The Authority accepted the recommendation of SEAC and decided to accord Prior Environmental Clearance to the above project.

2. Smt. Sangeeta Sharma, C/o Shri Rakesh Sharma, Plot No. 6019, Byramji Town, Nagpur, M.H, Manganese ore mine 7.114 hact. at Vill-Palaspani, Teh: souncer, Distt-Chhindwara M.P. **Case no 151/2008**

The above project was received from SEAC on 8th December 2010 with the recommendation to grant Prior Environmental Clearance.

The Authority while scrutinizing the documents observed that the DFO's letter no. 3203 dt 11-12-2001 only states that the mining lease area is located out of forest area. It does not specify the distance of mining lease area from the Forest boundary.

Hence it was decided to write to the concerned DFO asking the distance of mining lease area from the forest boundary. The copy of the letter should be endorsed to the Conservator of Forest and the Project Proponent.

3. Smt Indiradevi Garg, Jeewajiganj , Morena M.P., Bankuri red ochre mine 12.0 Ha. at Village Bankuri Teh – Karahal, Sheopur- M.P. **Case no 98/2008**

The above project was received from SEAC on 8th December 2010 with the recommendation to grant Prior Environmental Clearance.

The Authority while scrutinizing the documents observed that the DFO's letter no. 4546 dt 18-10-2002 only states that the mining lease area is located out of forest area. It does not specify the distance of mining lease area from the Forest boundary.

Hence it was decided to write to the concerned DFO asking the distance of mining lease area from the forest boundary. The copy of the letter should be endorsed to the Conservator of Forest and the Project Proponent.

4. Raghuvir Ferro Alloy Pvt Ltd, Industrial Area Urla, Raipur C H, Manganese ore mine 8.11 hact.1000TPR at vill-Jagantola, Teh-Baihar, Distt.Balaghat- M.P **Case no 175/2008**

The above project was received from SEAC on 8th December 2010 with the recommendation to grant Prior Environmental Clearance.

The Authority while scrutinizing the documents observed that the DFO's letter no. 568 dt 03-02-2010 only states that the mining lease area is adjoining to the forest area. It does not specify the distance of mining lease area from the Forest boundary.

Hence it was decided to write to the concerned DFO asking the distance of mining lease area from the forest boundary. The copy of the letter should be endorsed to the Conservator of Forest and the Project Proponent.

5. Aruna Dolomite mines civil line, Tilak ward, Mandla M.P., Dolomite mine 6.60 ha. village Bhawartal Teh. Bichhiya, Distt. Mandla - M.P. **Case no 48/2008**

The above project was received from SEAC on 8th December 2010 with the recommendation to grant Prior Environmental Clearance.

The Authority while scrutinizing the documents observed that the DFO's letter no. 136 dt 08-01-2010 only states that the distance of mining lease area from Kanha National Park. It does not specify the distance of mining lease area from the Forest boundary.

Hence it was decided to write to the concerned DFO asking the distance of mining lease area from the forest boundary. The copy of the letter should be endorsed to the Conservator of Forest and the Project Proponent.

6. M/s Emerald stone Industries, Gwalior- M.P., Stone mining lease 9.00 Ha. at Chandpur, Distt-Gwalior M.P. **Case no 243/2008**

The above project was received from SEAC on 8th December 2010, with the recommendation to grant Prior Environmental Clearance.

The Authority while scrutinizing the document observed that the Environment Management Plan, Disaster Management Plan and Environment Monitoring Plan is very generalized. Secondly the SEAC has not expressed their opinion on any such issue. Since SEAC does not exist at present and hence after its reconstitution they should reconsider and send recommendation within 45 days from the date of reconstitution.
