

Minutes of the 6th SEIAA Meeting held on 7th January, 2009

The sixth meeting of State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority was convened on 7th January.2009 at 11.30 A M at Authority's office in M.P. Pollution Control Building, Paryavaran Parisar, Bhopal chaired by Shri Subroto Banerji.

(I) Following cases recommended by SEAC for granting environmental clearance were discussed.

1. M/s Tewa API India Ltd, Plot No.2-6, 2-H, 2-1 Ecotech-II Udyog Vihar, Greater Noida-U.P., **Case No. 16/2008.**
2. M/s Assotech CP Infrastructure Pvt. Ltd. Noida. U.P., **Case No.14/2008**

The above cases were sent to SEAC for reconsideration on the grounds of hazardous waste disposal and NOC from CGWB for drawing ground water respectively. SEAC in their meeting held on 10th December 2008 has reconsidered on the points raised by SEIAA and has again recommended these cases for granting environmental clearance, after satisfactory clarification from project proponent.

SEIAA after taking note of SEAC's recommendations decided to accord environmental clearance to these projects.

3. BLA Power Pvt Ltd, Teh-Gadarwara, Thermal Power Project, 84, Mokar Chamber III, Vill-Nirwari, Teh-Gadarwara , Distt-Narsinghpur- M.P., **Case No.178/2008.**

The above case was recommended by SEAC for granting environmental clearance. After scrutinizing the details provided by the project proponent, it was decided in the meeting to reexamine the case in the next SEIAA meeting in the light of the mandatory provisions for fly ash disposal as well as the permission given by energy deptt. to the project.

4. M.P. Housing Board, Gwalior , **Case No.118/2008**

The above case was recommended by SEAC but it was deferred by the authority on the request of the project proponent. The project proponent submitted a clarification vide letter no. EE (R) Gwl/09-015 dt 06-01-09.

In this letter it is mentioned that the water requirement is 714 KLD for a settlement of 6000 persons as against the commitment to provide 800 KLD water by the Municipal Corporation, Gwalior. This point is acceptable for the limited purpose of construction.

As regard the building permission it is yet to be obtained. It was decided to get the exact status of the application of building permission from project proponent.

It was decided to hold 7th SEIAA meeting on 12th January 2009 at 11.30 A M to decided the cases mentioned at Sr.No. 3 & 4.
