The Chairman welcomed all the members of the Committee and thereafter agenda items were taken up for deliberations.

### Consideration of the Projects

1. Case No. 1140/2013 **Shri Rajendra Kumar Chamaria C/o Donypolo Udyog, P.O. – Shamgarh, Distt. – Mandsaur, (M.P.) – 458883 Stone Crushing, Lease Area – 1.834 Ha. at Survey No. – 138, Village – Makdawam, Tehsil – Samgarh, Distt. – Mandsaur (M.P.) Capacity – 2000 MT Per Month, Lease Period – 10 Years.**

The case was forwarded by SEIAA for appraisal in accordance to the guidelines set by the Authority for appraisal of mining cases in less than 5.0 hectare. The presentation and submission of the PP reveals that the project pertains to mining of stone. The mine is a captive mine linked to an Industry manufacturing Railway Sleepers. Stone Mining is being done by semi-mechanized method with the help of crushers , Vibrating screen , dust collector and explosive. the project is meant for making aggregates of 20 mm , 10 mm , 6 mm etc etc. to be used in manufacturing of concrete Sleepers for Railways . The sleepers being produced full fill the urgent demand of Railways for the purpose of Track Modernization.

No adverse comments were observed. PP has submitted the EMS with budgetary provisions for implementing the EMS. Fund reserved for post mining land reclamation is proposed to be Rs 1.0 lac and the recurring expenditure for Environment Management while operating the activities is Rs 40000-50000/ year

The presentation and submission of the PP reveals that the project pertains to mining of stone. The mining of stone is proposed in a *Lease Area of 0.710 Ha. at Khasra No. – 289, Village – Bargaon, Tehsil – Dindori, Distt. – Dindori (M.P.) The production capacity proposed is 10,000 Cubic Meter Per Year. PP has requested for a lease Period of 05 Year.* After deliberations it was observed that the PP has not submitted appropriate EMS and the proposed budget for its execution. PP was asked to submit the same.

The presentation and submission of the PP reveals that the project pertains to mining of flag-stone. The production capacity is reported to be *Flag-Stone – 3000 m<sup>3</sup>/Year* from an area of 2.53 ha. It was reported that the depression thus formed after excavation of stone shall be developed into a water body (Pond). It was also submitted that the land shall be curtained through green belt along the boundary. PP has submitted the information in the prescribed format-1 duly verified from DFO and Tehsildar. No adverse comments were observed. PP has submitted the EMS with budgetary provisions for implementing the same. Fund reserved for post mining land reclamation is proposed to be Rs 5.0 lac and the total cost for Environment Management while operating the activities is Rs 1.5 Lac.

Case No. 1145/2013 **Shri Rakesh Kumar Jain, Post – Shajapur, Tehsil – Patan, Distt. – Jabalpur (M.P.) 482001 Dolomite & Soapstone Mining Lease, Lease Area – 0.960 Ha.** at Khasra No. – 115, Village – Dulhankheda, Tehsil – Patan Distt. – Jabalpur (M.P.) Capacity – 5259 TPA, Lease Period – 20 Year. **Env. Consultant: J.M. Enfranet Pvt. Ltd. Jabalpur (M.P.) - TOR**

The case was forwarded by SEIAA for appraisal in accordance to the guidelines set by the Authority for appraisal of mining cases in less than 5.0 hectare. **This is a case of mining of Dolomite & Soapstone from MLA of 0.960 Hectare.** The project is covered under the provisions of EIA notification. Hence require prior EC. It was observed by the committee that the case pertains to category B-1 on the basis mineral proposed for mining. The case was presented by the PP and his consultant before the committee. The presentation reveals that the mined out dolomite and soapstone is being supplied to the local artisans which are involved in Stone-Idol making through handy-craft. PP has submitted a written commitment that the material excavated shall be supplied only to the local artisans. PP has requested to consider the case under B-2 category in view of its size (0.96 Ha) and a very low production capacity. After deliberations committee considered following points pertaining to this mining project:

- The mining project supports the local economy and the cottage industry which is lively-hood of the local public of the region.
- The activity does not involve long route transportation.
- Lease area & Production is very low.
- The mining technology is cleaner without blasting operations.
- The mineral is being utilized by the local artisans only.

Keeping in view the above facts committee decided to issue following TOR to the PP to carry out Rapid EIA and prepare EMP:

1. Public Hearing may be exempted.
2. Existing baseline data (not older than two years) can be used in the EIA and EMP.
3. Detailed plantation scheme and pollution control measures being adopted in the project have to be provided.
4. Mine closure plan with activity wise budgetary provisions have to be dealt as a separate chapter in the EIA report.
5. Management of OB with details of existing pits & OBs' in the MLA to be detailed out along with recent photographs of the site.
6. Photographs showing status of plantation and other efforts being done at site to control pollution.
7. Point-wise compliances of the conditions of the Consents issued by MPPCB shall be presented, a copy the same has to be submitted after due validation from MPPCB.
8. NOCs' from Forest department, Gram Sabha and other mandatory permissions to be submitted as applicable.
9. Other applicable standard TOR shall be followed.

The presentation and submission of the PP reveals that the project pertains to sand mining. The production capacity is reported to be 10000 m3/Year, from an area 1.470 ha. PP has requested to consider the case for a lease period of 02 years. It was also submitted that the no sieving shall be done at site. The transportation is proposed through trolleys. PP has submitted the information in the prescribed format-1 duly verified from DFO and Tehsildar. No adverse comments were observed.

The submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable hence committee decided to recommend the case for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions:

- The final EMS as proposed by the PP and the budgetary provisions for its implementation shall be approved by the Collector and shall be submitted to SEIAA.
- The fund reserved for post mining land reclamation shall be used strictly as per the terms & conditions set by the Collector while renewing / issuing the lease for the mine.
- PP shall be responsible for any discrepancy (if any) in the submissions made by the PP to SEAC & SEIAA.
- Only maintained vehicles shall be used for transportation.
- Appropriate facility shall be made for loading of material.
- Repair of vehicles shall not be carried out at site.
- Transportation of material shall be done in covered vehicles.
