The meeting was conducted specially for the project proponents who could not attend the meeting on earlier dates. Few fresh cases which were received recently were also lined up for hearing with due permission of the Chairman, subject to the availability of time.

**Site Visit:** It was decided to visit the sites in of following projects Gwalior Region -

**A. Case no. 665/2012 - Chief Executive Officer, N.C.R. Special Area Development Authority (Counter Magnet) 12, City Centre, Gwalior (M.P.) EIA For –Building Construction.** - *SADA Township of 805 ha. at Village - Sojna, Tighra, Kaitha, Kulaiith, Tehsil – Gwalior, Distt. – Gwalior (M.P.)* –The case was discussed in the 111<sup>th</sup> meeting dated 05/12/2012 it was observed by the committee that the proposed project is huge project consisting large no. of components including patches of reserve forest. After completion of first phase the project is likely to be extended. Hence committee decided to carry out a visit of the site. It was decided in this meeting to complete the proposed visit during 6<sup>th</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup> April before the next meeting.

**B. Mine cluster- Case No. – 1241/2013 M/s Yash Raju Bhansali, Gyan ganga, Nadi Gate, Jayindraganj, Lashkar, Gwalior (M.P.) 474009** *Yash Raju Bhansali Mining of B.T. Metal Agreegate– 4,00,000 M<sup>3</sup>/Year, at Survey No. 169, Village – Sumerpada, Tehsil – Morar, Distt. – Gwalior 9M.P.) Lease Area – 2.44 Ha., Lease period –10 Year.-* The proposed mining lease is a continuous patch of existing larger mining leases which also belongs to the PP. It was reported by the PP that the two larger operating mines have valid environmental clearance. In addition to the three mines as mentioned above it was reported that one more mine is proposed adjacent to the mine under subject, application for its EC has also been filed with SEIAA. Thus, in all there are four mines (two large and two small mines) in continuation. PP has informed that a common and comprehensive EMP has already been implemented considering the whole area as single unit. Thus committee in its 123rd meeting dated 12/03/2013 has decided to visit the site in view of mining cluster in the region. TOR for EIA or additional EMP shall be determined after the visit. It was decided in this meeting to complete the proposed visit during 6<sup>th</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup> April 2013 before the next meeting.

This is a case of mining of stone. The application was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal. The proposed site is located at *Khasra No. - 9/23, Village – Karondi, Tehsil & Distt. – Jabalpur (M.P.) in 3.0 Ha.* The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site. It was submitted by the PP that after the Project is completed the proposed land will be converted into pond which will be used for irrigation purpose.

PP has submitted copies of requisite information in the prescribed formats duly verified from DFO and the Tehsildar. The submissions made by the PP and the EMS submitted are found to be satisfactory and acceptable hence committee has decided to recommend the case for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions:

PP has informed that the depression thus formed after excavation of soil shall be used for water holding and paddy cultivation shall be practiced on the land. It was also submitted that land shall be curtailed through
