This is a case of revalidation of prior EC. Environmental Clearance requested for Revalidation / Change of EC for total of 66 product mix and flexibility in Production for a capacity of **2951 MTPA**. Existing Environmental Clearance (No. 307/EPCO-SEIAA/09, dated 11/02/09) has been granted by MPSEIAA for production of 17 product-mixes for a capacity of **2957.22 MTPA** of Bulk drug, API and its intermediates.

The case was presented in the 122nd SEAC Meeting dated 11th March 2013. PP was asked to submit and present query response for the following queries:

- Justification has to be furnished for selecting worst case product keeping in view the hydraulic, emission as well as pollution load expected to be generated from the process after modifications.
- Rationalization of the Solvent recovery system for the worst case scenario after proposed modifications.
- Comparative statement for waste-water quality and its treatment facility for following three cases to be prepared and furnished:
  - a) Worst case scenario while producing the existing 17 products.
  - b) Worst case scenario while producing the proposed 66 products.
  - c) Comparison of the two scenarios and accordingly the optimization / modification proposed / planned for the treatment facility so as to justify the adequacy of the same.

Following implementation schedule has been proposed for effluent treatment system:

- **I<sup>st</sup> Phase** – Production of 1150 MT/Annum – Worst Case total effluent quantity (out of the 66 Products) generated would be 250 KLD which can be treated in existing ETP.
- **II<sup>nd</sup> Phase** – Production of 2951 MT/Annum – Effluent Treatment System would be augmented from 250 KLD to 650 KLD

The EIA / EMP submitted by the PP for the project and the subsequent presentations made thereby are satisfactory and acceptable hence committee decided to recommend the case for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions:

1. Possibilities shall be explored for using the gases generated from ETP in power production instead of flaring the same.
2. ETP should be based on modular type.
3. Proposed product mix shall not be taken up **until** installation of proposed ETP scheme is **completed**.
4. All other conditions as laid in the earlier EC and the consents of MPPCB shall be applicable.
