- **Minutes of additional meeting dated 17th April 2013 (held in continuation to 126th meeting)** - Scrutiny and discussion on the responses could not be taken up due to shortage of time in the 126th SEAC meeting dated 10/04/2013. Hence it was decided by the committee unanimously that Shri A. P. Srivastava, Member SEAC and the Member Secretary may hold a meeting on convenient date to scrutinize, discuss and dispose the responses received against queries raised by the committee during appraisal of these cases. Accordingly, the sub-committee comprising of Shri R.K. Jain, Member Secretary SEAC and Shri A.P. Srivastava, Member SEAC met on 17th April 2013 in the office of MPPCB, Bhopal.

The Chairman welcomed all the members of the Committee and thereafter agenda items were taken up for deliberations.

Consideration of the Projects – Following projects were taken up for deliberations one by one:

1. Case No. – 1392/2013 **Shri Betal Singh S/o Shri Arjun Singh Gurjar, H.N.- 5, Bajrang Colony, Gol Pahadiya, A.B. Road, Lashkar, Gwalior (M.P.) – 474009 Lease Area – 4.00 Ha. Flag/ Stone (Farshi Pattar) Quarry, at Khasra No. – 72, Village – Rancholi, Tehsil- Morena, Distt. – Morena (M.P.) Capacity – 10,000 Cubic Meter/Year, Lease Period – 05 Year.**

This is a case of mining of *Flag/ Stone (Farshi Pattar)*. The application was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal. The proposed site is located at *Khasra No. – 72, Village – Rancholi, Tehsil- Morena, Distt. – Morena (M.P.)* in **4.0Ha**. The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site. It was submitted by the PP that after the Project is completed the proposed land will be converted into pond which will be used for irrigation purpose. It is also reported by the PP that no mining is either operating or proposed within 250 meters from the boundary of the proposed mining site.

PP has submitted copies of requisite information in the prescribed formats duly verified from DFO and the Tehsildar.
