The Chairman welcomed all the members of the Committee and thereafter agenda items were taken up for deliberations.

**Confirmation of the Minutes of 132<sup>nd</sup> and 133<sup>rd</sup> meetings of SEAC:** The minutes of the said meeting s were confirmed and finalized.

**Consideration of the Projects** – Following projects were taken up for deliberations one by one:

This is a case pertaining to building & construction comprising township development in an area of 9.47 Ha and total built-up area of 21177.76 m<sup>2</sup>. The project is covered under the EIA notification (Item 8(a)) hence requires prior EC before commencement of activity at site. The application along with related documents were forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal.

It was observed by the committee that the land is owned by one party and the project is proposed to be developed by M/s Arms Real Estate Developers Pvt. Ltd. The signed 'agreement' between the two parties as furnished before the committee does not address the responsibility environmental compliances. Hence PP was asked to submit either a 'Joint Venture' clearly mentioning the responsible person(s) for compliances of the terms & conditions of EC and other environmental issues or re-submit the revised application in name of the owner(s) of the land. The case was deferred till receipt of the above.

The proposed site is located at *Khasra No.- 37/1/5, Village - Jamnya, Tehsil – Nivali, Distt. – Badwani (M.P.)* in **1.0Ha**. The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site. It was submitted by the PP that after the Project is completed the proposed land will be converted into pond which will be used for irrigation purpose. It is also reported by the PP that no mining is either operating or proposed within 250 meters from the boundary of the proposed mining site.

PP has submitted copies of requisite information in the prescribed formats duly verified from DFO and the Tehsildar. The submissions made by the PP and the EMS submitted are found to be satisfactory and acceptable hence committee has decided to recommend the case for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions:

- The amount towards reclamation of the pit and land in MLA shall be carried out through the mining department the appropriate amount as estimated for the activity by mining department has to be deposited with the Collector to take up the activity after the mine is exhausted.
- The final EMS as proposed by the PP and the budgetary provisions for its implementation shall be approved by the Collector and shall be submitted to SEIAA.
- PP shall be responsible for any discrepancy (if any) in the submissions made by the PP to SEAC & SEIAA.
- Transportation of material shall be done in covered vehicles.
- Curtaining of site shall be done using appropriate media.
- Production of stone shall be *1000 m<sup>3</sup>/year and the average depth of the pits shall not exceed 7.00m at the end of 10 years.*
- Appropriate arrangement shall be made for storage of materials at site in terms of covered yard.
- Appropriate air pollution control measures shall be placed in compliance to the consent of MPPCB for the proposed crusher.
- The proposed plantation should be carried out along with the mining and PP should take care that these plants attain full growth.
- The validity of the prior EC & the lease shall be for a maximum period of ten years only.
- Transportation shall not be carried out through forest area.
- PP shall take CSR activities in the region through the 'Gram Panchayat'.
- The amount towards land reclamation shall be deposited with the Collector for further execution of the activities under EMP.

- Opencast manual method of mining has been carried out and same will continue.
- All operations of opencast working like face clearing, sorting, sizing and loading of mineral etc. will be done manually.
- Drilling has been carried out by tractor mounted compressor with Jack Hammer same will be continuing.
- Blasting is not required hence not proposed.

After deliberations committee approved the 'TORs' with inclusion of following points to carry out EIA study and prepare EMP:

- The mine site is observed to be on a hillock; hence plan has to be furnished for protection of nearby field, roads and other features from the materials which may fall from the hill while executing mining activity.
