

# MINUTES OF STATE EXPERT APPRAISAL COMMITTEE

142<sup>nd</sup> MEETING 11<sup>th</sup> September 2013

1. **Case No. - 671/2012** - Shri Shankarlal Vishwakarma S/o Shri Purnalal Vishwakarma, Jalpadevi Ward, Gautam Mohalla – Katni, Di stt. – Katni (M.P.) *Enhancement in mining capacity of Tikariya Bauxite, Laterite and Fire Clay Mine of Lease Area - 27.02 Ha., at Khasra no. 423, 424, 425/1, 425/2, 426, 454/1, 454/2, 457, 458, 459, 422, 455, 460, 467, 468, 469, 498, 500, 509, Village - Tikariya, Tehsil – Murwara, Distt. – Katni (M.P.) Capacity – 1.25 lac MTPA to 7. 0 lac MTPA. Lease Area - 27.02 Ha., Prior EC issued vide letter no. 122/EPCO SEIAA/ 10 dated 26/05/10. EIA Presentation. Env. Consultant : Creative Enviro Services, Bhopal (M.P.) TOR issued vide letter no 276 dt. 06/06/13.*

This is a case of mining submitted for prior EC in view of enhancement of production capacity. The TOR was issued for the proposed project vide letter dated 06/06/13. The project is operating after EC obtained from MPSEIAA vide letter dated 26/05/2010. EIA report was submitted by the PP to SEIAA and the same was forwarded to SEAC for appraisal and necessary recommendations. The case was presented before committee by the PP and his consultant. Many people in the Public Hearing have raised various issues. It was observed that certified compliance report from MoEF is also yet to be submitted by the PP. Other submissions to be made by the PP are:

- Copy of approved Mining Plan supporting the proposed production rate.
- NOC from Gram Sabha.
- NOC from Forest Department stating the distances of forest boundaries and Notified area under Wild Life Protection Act. Etc.

Committee has decided to visit the site during to clarify the facts of PH and to see the over all compliaices with respect to environmental issues. The case shall be taken up for presentation after the visit by sub-committee.

2. **Case No. – 1721/2013** M/s Agrawal Builders & Colonizers Co. through Partner Shri Sudhir Kumar Agrawal, E-4/231, Arera Colony, Bhopal, (M.P.) – 462016 Residential Project Proposed by M/s Agrawal Builders & Colonizers Co. through Mrs. Archana Agrawal W/o Sh. Sudhir Kumar Agrawal at Khasra No. – 14/1/3, 182/14/3, 14/1/2/5, Patwari Halka No.- 20, Village – Hathaikheda, Tehsil – Huzur, Distt. – Bhopal (M.P.) **Total Plot Area – 32480 sq. mt., Total Built up Area – 39631.25 Sq.Mt. for Multi Unit ( HIG Flats -172, MIG Flats- 128, LIG Flats-84, EWS-32), Duplexes (63), Community Hall & Convenient shops. For – Building Construction.**

It was reported by the PP that construction has already been commenced at site and about 25% of total proposed built-up area has been completed till date, however now construction has been stopped. It was also informed by the PP that they have approached MPPCB diclosing the facts so that cerdible action in this regard may be taken up. A leeter written to MPPCB was also shown by the PP. Committee deferred the case till the evidence regading credible action as per the MoEF O.M. no J-110131/41/2006 ó IA- II (I) dated 12/12/2012 and dated 27/06/2013.

3. **Case No. – 1722/2013** Smt. Sashi Sondhiya W/o Shri Prakash Sondhiya R/o Sondhiya Gali, Nai Basti, Katni, Distt.- Katni (M.P.) – 483501 Dhaura Laterite and Fire Clay Mine at Khasra No.- 444/1, Village- Dhaura, Tehsil- Bijeraghogharh, Distt. – Katni (M.P.) Capacity- 20000TPA, Lease Area - 4.20 Ha., **ToR.**

Neither the Project Proponent nor his representative was present to explain the query which might be raised or to make any commitment which may be desired by the committee during the deliberation. Request from PP has been received from the PP for considering the case in next meeting. Hence Committee decided to call the proponent of the project in coming meetings as per turn.

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4. **Case No. – 1723/2013** M/s ACC Limited, Kaymore Cement Works, P.O.- Kymore, Distt.- Katni (M.P.) – 483880 *Badari Limestone Mine at Old Khasra No.- 415, 416/1k, 416/3k , New Khasra No. – 18P & 63, Village- Badari, Tehsil- Vijayraghavgarh, Distt. – Katni (M.P.) Capacity – 60000 MTPA, Lease Area - 1.093 Ha., ToR.*

This is a case of captive mining for a Cement industry. The mining lease area is 1.093 Ha and the production capacity proposed is 60000 MT/Year. The case falls under purview of EIA notification as per the guidelines of SEIAA. The application was forwarded by SEIAA for scoping so as to determine TOR to carry out EIA and prepare EMP for the project. The case was presented by the PP and his consultant. During deliberations PP has requested that the proposed mine is located in close vicinity of other bigger mines already operating with due EC and other relevant permissions hence Public Hearing may be exempted in this case. Also it was requested that the available environmental data may be allowed for use in the EIA.

After deliberations committee has approved the proposed TOR with inclusion of following points:

1. Composite EIA shall be carried out and cumulative impacts along with the cumulative EMP shall be submitted.
2. Available baseline data can be used in the EIA but data should not be older than 02 years. All data used has to be validated by approved Laboratory.
3. Committee has decided to visit the site through sub-committee and views regarding exemption of Public Hearing shall be provided only after the visit.
4. Compliances of terms and conditions of the consents have to be submitted after due validation from MPPCB.

Nagar, Bhopal – (M.P.) - 462018 *Fortune Signature" at Survey No. – 147/7/1ka, 147/7/1/kha, 147/5/3, 95/1/kha/2, 147/7/3, 147/7/4, 147/7/5, 147/9/kh, 147/9/kha, 147/9/jha, 147/9/1/1/1, 147/9/1/1/2, 147/9/1/1/8, 147/7/2, Village- Bawadia Kalan, Tehsil - Huzur, Distt. – Bhopal (M.P.) **Total Land Area – 30713.0 sq mt., Total Built Up Area – 45383.72 sq.mt. Building Construction.***

For- Building Construction.***

Ltd., at Khasra No. – 327, 342, 343, 344, Village – Ohadpur, Tehsil – Gwalior, Distt. – Gwalior (M.P.) **Plot Area – 12,550 M<sup>2</sup> , Built up Area – 45,125.85 M<sup>2</sup>. For – Building Construction.**

Neither the Project Proponent nor his representative was present to explain the query which might be raised or to make any commitment which may be desired by the committee during the deliberation. It is observed that the PP has not been responding despite of several reminders for presentation and submissions. This was the last opportunity provided to the PP to make his submissions. Hence committee decided to return the case to SEIAA for further necessary action in the matter assuming that PP is not interested in the project.

9. **Case No. - 1711/2013** Moh. Abbas, M/s Jabalpur Marbles, 903, – Badi Omti – Jabalpur, Distt . – Jabalpur (M.P.) – 482001 Ghutehi Marble Mines Lease Area – 4.57 ha.. Capacity – 25,000 m<sup>3</sup> at Khasra No. – 215,217, 218, 219 & 220 Village – Ghutehi, Tehsil – Sihora, Distt. - Katni ( M.P.) Env. Consultant :Apex Minetech Consultants, Udaipur (Raj.) **ToR.**

The above two cases are mining projects and reported to be located same region. It was reported that some more small mines are operating in the region. The cases have been submitted for prior EC in view of proposed enhancement in production. The applications were forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for scoping so as to determine TOR for the projects. Proponent and his consultant presented the case before the committee. After deliberations committee has approved the TOR with inclusion of following points:

- Copy of approved Mining Plan supporting the proposed production rate.
- NOC from Gram Sabha.
- NOC from Forest Department stating the distances of forest boundaries and Notified area under Wild Life Protection Act. etc.
- Composite EIA shall be carried out and cumulative impacts along with the cumulative EMP considering the other proposed / existing mines in the region shall be submitted.
- Available baseline data can be used in the EIA but data should not be older than 02 years. All data used has to be validated by approved Laboratory.
- Compliances of terms and conditions of the consents have to be submitted after due validation from MPPCB.
- De-watering Plan to be furnished.
- Plan for disposal of rejects to be detailed out.
- Efforts for energy conservation taken / planned to be detailed out.

10. **Case No. - 728/2012** Shri Tanwar Singh, 137, AB Road, Bhopal Chouraha-Dewas, Distt.- Dewas (M.P.) 455001 Expansion Rajoda Masonary Stone Mine at Khasra No.- 836, Village – Rajoda, Tehsil – Rajoda, Distt.- Dewas (M.P ) Lease Area- 10.926 Ha., Production

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Capacity – 5 Lacs M.T. Per Year. (Lease Period - dt.17.11.2010 to 16.11.2020). Env. Consultant :Apex Minetech Consultants, Udaipur (Raj.) ToR issued vide letter no. 633 dt. 01/10/12. **EIA Presentation.**

This is a mining project submitted to SEIAA for grant of EC, TOR was issued to the project vide letter dated 01/10/2012. The EIA report and the Public Hearing proceedings were forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal and necessary recommendations. The case was presented by the Attorney of PP Shri Shelendra Singh Gaur and his consultant before the committee. After deliberations PP was asked to submit following information along with the supporting documents:

1. NOC from Gram Sabha (Proceedings).
2. NOC from Forest deptt. Showing distances of Forest boundaries from the Site and distance of nearest Notified Area.
3. Activity wise CSR budget break-up.

Discussion on query responses received from PP could not be taken up in the meeting hence it was decided that the same be taken up in later meetings.

Next meeting were decided to be held on 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> of October 2013.
