The Chairman welcomed all the members of the Committee and thereafter agenda items were taken up for deliberations.

**Discussion and decision taken on miscellaneous issues:**

- 1. Case No. – 2361/2015 Shri Ganesh Singh Patel S/o Shri Mithai Lal Singh, Village-Daldal, Tehsil-Kotma, District-Anuppur (MP)-448440 (M-9229228268) Basalt Stone Quarry Lease Area – 2.048 Ha., at Khasra No. 54, 55, Lease Period Ten Year at Village-Daldal, Tehsil-Kotma, District-Anuppur (MP) Capacity - 6980 Cum/Year. Application forwarded by SEAC by SEIAA vide letter no. 3051/SEIAA/15 dated: 12/01/2015**

This is a case of mining of stone bolder. The application was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal. The proposed site is located at Khasra No. 54, 55, at Village-Daldal, Tehsil-Kotma, District-Anuppur (MP) in 2.048 ha. The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site.

PP has submitted a copy of approved Mining Plan, letter from Mining Officer certifying the leases within 500 meters radius around the site and requisite information in the prescribed format duly verified by the Tehsildar and DFO. It was reported by the concerned Mining Officer of mining department vide letter no.1080 dated 31/10/2014, that no mine is operating / proposed within 500 meter radius around the said mine.

Presentation & submissions made by the PP were discussed in the meeting. The EMS and other submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable. However, scrutiny of the project documents revealed that the above lease area is within the 10 Kms distance from the interstate boundary but precise details about distance is not mentioned in the concerned certificate. PP was asked to clarify the same and submit exact distance certificate from the mine to the interstate boundary from the concerned competent authority.

This is a case of mining of stone bolder. The application was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal. The proposed site is located at Khasra No. 277/1, 277/4, 345/1, 347/1 at Village-Dadhi, Tehsil-Huzur, District-Rewa (MP) in 1.307 ha. The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site.

PP has submitted a copy of approved Mining Plan, letter from Mining Officer certifying the leases within 500 meters radius around the site and requisite information in the prescribed format duly verified by the Tehsildar and DFO. It was reported by the concerned Mining Officer of mining department vide letter no.1457 dated 8/9/2014, that One mine is operating / proposed within 500 meter radius around the said mine and the total lease area is 2.307 ha.

Presentation & submissions made by the PP were discussed in the meeting. The EMS and other submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable. However, scrutiny of the project documents revealed that the plans (such as conceptual, production etc.) submitted alongwith the mining plan are not approved by the mining department and submitted layouts were also not corresponding with the khasra map of the area. PP submitted that by mistake these plans were appended/ attached with htis applications. PP was asked to clarify the same and submit the plans approved by the compitent authority to SEAC through SEIAA.

It was also noticed in the certificate issued by the forest department that Panna Tiger Reserve is about 7.4 Kms from the core zone and 5.60 Kms from the buffer zone. Thus as per OM dated 20/08/2014, the PP was asked to get the relevent information in prescribed format from Chief Wild Life Warden for consideration of the project.

17. PP shall take Socio-economic activities in the region through the Gram Panchayat
18. EC will be valid for mine lease period subject to a ceiling of 5 years.

**23. Case No. – 2393/2015 Shri Suhail Khan, 27, Chataipura, Budhwara, Bhopal (MP)-462001 (M- 9425010229)** Black Stone Quarry 1.92 ha. at Khasra No. 435, 436 at Village-Jaitpura, Tehsil-Bairasia, District-Bhopal (MP) Capacity- 8,550 cum/year. Applications forwarded by SEAC by SEIAA vide letter no. 3163/SEIAA/15 dated: 19/01/2015.

This is a case of mining of stone bolder. The application was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal. The proposed site is located at Khasra No. 435, 436 at Village-Jaitpura, Tehsil-Bairasia, District-Bhopal (MP) in 1.92 ha. The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site.

PP has submitted a copy of approved Mining Plan, letter from Mining Officer certifying the leases within 500 meters radius around the site and requisite information in the prescribed format duly verified by the Tehsildar and DFO. It was reported by the concerned Mining Officer of mining department vide letter no. 73 dated 27/01/2015, that no mine is operating / proposed within 500 meter radius around the said mine. PP has reported that the pit formed after mining shall be developed into a water body.

Submissions made by the PP were discussed in the meeting. The EMS and other submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable. However, scrutiny of the mining plan reveals the presence of certain scheduled animals in the area which needs confirmation from the forest department. The DFO in his letter has not commented on this issue. Hence, PP was asked to obtain comments of concerned DFO on this issue and submit.

**24. Case No. – 2394/2015 Shri Jeevan Singh Bhati S/o Shri Chandar Singh Bhati, Village-Silepur, Tehsil-Gulana, Shajapur (MP) (M- 09754141737)** Sand Quarry 7.00 ha. at Khasra No. 289 at Village-Duglay, Tehsil-Shujalpur, District-Shajapur (MP) Capacity- 8,000 cum/year. Applications forwarded by SEAC by SEIAA vide letter no. 3165/SEIAA/15 dated: 19/01/2015.

This is a case of mining of sand. The application was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal. The proposed site is located at Khasra No. 289 at Village-Duglay, Tehsil-Shujalpur, District-Shajapur (MP) in 7.00 ha. The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site.

PP has submitted a copy of approved Mining Plan, letter from Mining Officer certifying the leases within 1000 meters radius around the site and requisite information in the prescribed format duly verified by the Tehsildar and DFO. It was reported by the concerned Mining Officer of mining department vide letter no. 260 dated 02/03/2015, that no mine is operating / proposed within 1000 meter radius around the said mine.

Based on the presentation and the submissions made by the PP committee has decided to recommend the case subject to the following special conditions:

1. The amount towards reclamation of the land in MLA shall be carried out through the mining department; the appropriate amount as estimated for the activity by mining department has to be deposited with the Collector to take up the activity after the mine is exhausted.
2. PP shall be responsible for discrepancy (if any) in the submissions made by the PP to SEAC & SEIAA.
3. It was observed during the visit to Alirajpur by the sub-committee that the banks of the tributaries have been eroded due to floods hence as special condition PP shall use the rejects and soil for plantation on these eroded banks to prevent further damages of the banks.
4. Abstraction of sand shall be as per the approved Mining Scheme but not exceeding 8000 m3 in a year and the depth of mining shall be restricted to 3m or water level, whichever is less.
5. Mining shall be carried only between 1st November to 31st May i.e. during non-monsoon period.
6. Transportation of sand shall not be carried out through forest area.

7. The mining activity shall be done manually.
8. Heavy vehicles shall not be allowed on the banks for loading of sand.
9. The sand shall be transported by small trolleys up to the main transport vehicle.
10. Transport vehicles will be covered with tarpoline to minimize dust/sand particle emissions.
11. For carrying out mining in proximity to any bridge and/or embankment, appropriate safety zone of 1 Km on upstream as well as on downstream from the periphery of the mining site shall be ensured taking into account the structural parameters, location aspects, flow rate, etc., and no mining shall be carried out in the safety zone.
12. No in stream mining shall be allowed.
13. The mining shall be carried out strictly as per the approved mining plan and ensure that the annual replenishment of sand in the mining lease area is sufficient to sustain the mining operations at levels prescribed in the mining plan.
14. Established water conveyance channels should not be relocated, straightened, or modified.
15. If the stream is dry, the excavation must not proceed beyond the lowest undisturbed elevation of the stream bottom, which is a function of local hydraulics, hydrology, and geomorphology.
16. After mining is complete, the edge of the pit should be graded to a 2.5:1 slope in the direction of the flow.
17. PP shall take Socio-economic activities in the region through the Gram Panchayat.
18. EC will be valid for mine lease period subject to a ceiling of 5 years.

**25. Case No. – 2395/2015 Shri Saurabh Garg, 85, Vinay Nagar, Sector-2, Gwalior (MP)-474010 (M- 9425115433) Metal Stone Quarry in an area of 3.00 ha. at Khasra No. 1/1 at Village-Pratappura, Tehsil-Orchha, District-Tikamgarh (MP) Capacity- 1,34,205 cum/year. Applications forwarded by SEAC by SEIAA vide letter no. 3167/SEIAA/15 dated: 19/01/2015.**

This is a case of mining of stone bolder. The application was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal. The proposed site is located at Khasra No. 1/1 at Village-Pratappura, Tehsil-Orchha, District-Tikamgarh (MP) in 3.00 ha. The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site.

Neither the Project Proponent (PP) nor his representative was present to explain the query which might be raised or to make any commitment which may be desired by the committee during the deliberation. PP has made a request for his absence vide letter dated 20/03/2014. Committee decided to call the PP in subsequent meetings after hearing from PP. A request has to be made by the PP for scheduling the case in coming meetings within a month's time after which the case shall be returned to SEIAA assuming that PP is not interested to continue with the project.
