The Chairman welcomed all the members of the Committee and thereafter agenda items were taken up for deliberations.

1. **Case No. – 2226/2014 Shri Nilay Jain, D-1, Machna Colony, Shivaji Nagar, Bhopal (MP)-462016 Basalt Stone Quarry Lease Area –1.493 ha. at Khasra No.147/149/1ka, 212/148/1 gha, 212/148/63ka/1,147/149/1ka, 212/148/1gha, 212/148/3ka/3,147/149/1ka, 212/148/1gha, 212/148/3ka/5 Village-Panari, Tehsil-Budhni, District-Sehore (MP) Capacity -41,160 Cum/Year**

This is a case of mining of stone bolder. The application was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal. The proposed site is located at *Khasra No.147/149/1ka, 212/148/1 gha, 212/148/63ka/1, 147/149/1ka, 212/148/1gha, 212/148/3ka/3, 147/149/1ka, 212/148/1gha, 212/148/3ka/5 Village-Panari, Tehsil-Budhni, District-Sehore (MP)* in 1.493 ha. The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site.

Neither the Project Proponent (PP) nor his representative was present to explain the query which might be raised or to make any commitment which may be desired by the committee during the deliberation. Earlier also PP was absent when the case was placed in the 174th meeting. However, committee scrutinized the application and documents submitted by the PP in the meeting. Based on the scrutiny of the application it was decided to ask the PP to submit below mentioned information within a month's time, failure to which **the case shall be returned to SEIAA for delisting / rejection** assuming that PP is not interested to continue with the project.

- Total lease area and no. of mines proposed / operating within 500 meters around the periphery of said mine to be reported after due validation from the concerned Mining Officer.
- Conceptual plan submitted reveals that no buffer zone is left for peripheral plantation.
- How the targeted production of 41,160 m³/ Year shall be achieved has not been detailed out in the documents submitted by the PP.
- The evacuation of material from the mine is not clear the same needs to be explained.

2. **Case No. – 2227/2014 Shri Sachan Tiwari S/o Shri Rajendra Tiwari, Village-Rupadon Ryt, Tehsil-Ghansor, District-Seoni (MP) Basalt Stone Quarry Lease Area –0.300 ha. Khasra No. 23 , at Village-Rupadon Ryt, Tehsil-Ghansor, District-Seoni (MP), Capacity -2850 Cum/Year.**

This is a case of mining of stone bolder. The application was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal. The proposed site is located at *Khasra No. 23 , at Village-Rupadon Ryt, Tehsil-Ghansor, District-Seoni (MP)* in 0.3 ha. The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site.

PP has submitted a copy of approved Mining Plan, letter from Mining Officer certifying the leases within 500 meters radius around the site and requisite information in the prescribed format duly verified by the Tehsildar and DFO. PP has reported that the pit formed after mining shall be developed into a water body. Concerned Mining Officer vide letter no. 2742 dated 25/12/2014 has reported that there is no mine operating /proposed within 500 meters around the said mine. No crusher is proposed in the lease area.

Scrutiny of the mining plan reveals the presence of certain scheduled animals in the area which needs confirmation from the forest department. The DFO in his letter has not commented on this issue. Hence PP was asked to submit comments of concerned Forest Officer on this issue.

This is a case of mining of stone bolder. The application was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal. The proposed site is located at *Khasra No. 546 , Village-Turmadar, Tehsil-Kundam, District-Jabalpur (MP)* in 2.610 ha. The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site.

PP has submitted a copy of approved Mining Plan, letter from Mining Officer certifying the leases within 500 meters radius around the site and requisite information in the prescribed format duly verified by the Tehsildar and DFO. PP has requested for considering the case for production capacity of 25000 m³ / year although the application was filed for the production capacity of 49590 M³/Y, committee has accepted the request of PP. PP has reported that the pit formed after mining shall be developed into a water body. Concerned Mining Officer vide letter no. nil dated 23/12/2014 has reported that there is no mine operating /proposed within 500 meters around the said mine. Submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable. Thus, based on the submissions made by the PP **the case was recommended for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions:**

1. The amount towards reclamation of the pit and land in MLA shall be carried out through the mining department. The appropriate amount as estimated for the activity by mining department has to be deposited with the Collector to take up the activity after the mine is exhausted.
2. The mined out pits shall be developed into water body being appropriately fenced and with safe stairway.
3. PP shall be responsible for discrepancy (if any) in the submissions made by the PP to SEAC & SEIAA
4. Transportation of material shall be done in covered vehicles.
5. Necessary consents shall be obtained from MPPCB and the air/water pollution control measures have to be installed as per the recommendation of MPPCB.
6. Permission / NOC shall be obtained from Gram Panchayat for lifting water from the village resources and shall be furnished to MPPCB while obtaining necessary consents under the provisions of Air / Water consents.

The proposed site is located at Khasra No. – 122/1,122/2 & 125 , Village-PratapFaliya, Tehsil-Jobat, District-Alirajpur (MP) in 0.9 ha. The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site.

PP has submitted a copy of approved Mining Plan, letter from Mining Officer certifying the leases within 500 meters radius around the site and requisite information in the prescribed format duly verified by the Tehsildar and DFO. PP has reported that the pit formed after mining shall be developed into a water body. Concerned Mining Officer vide letter no. 1966 dated 29/11/2014 has reported that there one more mine is operating /proposed within 500 meters around the said mine the total lease area being 1.9 Ha. Submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable. Thus, based on the submissions made by the PP the case was recommended for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions:

The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site.

PP has submitted a copy of approved Mining Plan, letter from Mining Officer certifying the leases within 500 meters radius around the site and requisite information in the prescribed format duly verified

by the Tehsildar and DFO. PP has reported that the pit formed after mining shall be developed into a water body. Neither the Project Proponent (PP) nor his representative was present to explain the query which might be raised or to make any commitment which may be desired by the committee during the deliberation. Earlier also PP was absent when the case was placed in the 175th meeting. However, committee scrutinized the application and documents submitted by the PP in the meeting. It was observed that the concerned Mining Officer vide letter no. 1048 dated 28/11/2014 has reported that seven more mines are proposed / operating within 500 meters around the said mine and the total lease area of 26.5 Ha. Hence the case is a cluster type and accordingly, EIA has to be carried out. Thus, the case is a cluster type and falls under category B-1 as per the MoEF O.M. No. J-13012/12/2013-IA-II (I) dated 24/12/2013, accordingly, EIA has to be carried out. Thus, Committee decided to call the PP giving him one more opportunity before issuing TOR.

Earlier also PP was absent when the case was placed in the 178th meeting. However, committee scrutinized the application and documents submitted by the PP in the meeting. It was observed that the concerned Mining Officer vide letter no. 10196 dated 26/11/2014 has reported that seven more mines are proposed / operating within 500 meters around the said mine and the total lease area of 28 Ha. Thus, the case is a cluster type and falls under category B-1 as per the MoEF O.M. No. J-13012/12/2013-IA-II (I) dated 24/12/2013, accordingly, EIA has to be carried out. This is a case of mining of stone bolder. The application was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal. The proposed site is located at Khasra No.-123/5, Village-Rewati, Tehsil-Hatod, District-Indore (MP) 4.0 ha. The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site.

PP has submitted a copy of approved Mining Plan, letter from Mining Officer certifying the leases within 500 meters radius around the site and requisite information in the prescribed format duly verified by the Tehsildar and DFO. PP has reported that the pit formed after mining shall be developed into a water body. Concerned Mining Officer vide letter no. 1734 dated 23/09/2014 has reported that 01 more mine is operating /proposed within 500 meters around the said mine the total lease area being 7.656 Ha. The lease area does not appear to support the targeted production. PP was therefore, asked to submit an explanatory note on (i) How environmentally sustainable mining shall be carried out for the stated capacity (ii) Water consumption in the mine (iii) Quantum of explosive proposed to be used with blasting frequency and (iv) Mitigation of the impacts expected from blasting. The requisite information was submitted by the PP and the same was considered by the committee at the end of the meeting. In view of environmentally sustainable mining and in order to reduce the blasting frequency and the associated impacts the production capacity in project was restricted by the committee to 2.5 lac m³ / Year.

The submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable thus, after deliberations the case was recommended subject to the following special conditions:
