

The 197<sup>th</sup>. Meeting of the State Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC) was held on 03<sup>rd</sup>. June, 2015 under the Chairmanship of Dr. R. B. Lal. The following members attended the meeting-

The Chairman welcomed all the members of the Committee and thereafter agenda items were taken up for deliberations.

- 1. No. – 2683/2015 Smt. Manorama Jain W/o Shri Mayank Shah, Budhwara Bajar, Tehsil-Buxwaha, District-Chhatarpur (M.P.)-471318. Metal Stone Quarry Lease Area-1.60 ha., Capacity - 8,000 cum/year, at Village-Magarai, Tehsil-Buxwaha, District-Chhatarpur (M.P.).**

This is a case of mining of Metal Stone Quarry. The application was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal. The proposed site is located at Village-Magarai, Tehsil-Buxwaha, District-Chhatarpur in **1.60 ha.**, The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site.

PP has submitted a copy of approved Mining Plan, letter from Mining Officer certifying the leases within 500 meters radius around the site and requisite information in the prescribed format duly verified by the Tehsildar and DFO. PP has reported that the pit formed after mining shall be developed into a water body. Crusher is not proposed in the lease area. Concerned Mining Officer vide letter no. 222 dated: 03/3/2015 has reported that there is 01 more mine operating or proposed within 500 meters around the said mine and total lease area is 3.680 Ha.

1. The production shall be as per the approved mining plan not exceeding 14250 cum / Year and the maximum depth of the pits shall be as per the approved mining plan.

submissions made by the PP the case was recommended for grant of prior EC subject to the standard conditions laid for similar cases with following additional conditions:

1. The production shall be as per the approved mining plan not exceeding 4560 cum / Year and the maximum depth of the pits shall be as per the approved mining plan.
2. PP informed that there is a Sagon tree within the lease area. It is therefore recommended not to uproot this tree and to cover the tree within 7.5 m barrier zone.

A request has to be made by the PP for scheduling the case in coming meetings within a month's time after which the case shall be returned to SEIAA assuming that PP is not interested to continue with the project.

issue from concerned forest officer and submit the same at the earliest. If DFO issues satisfactory clarification, the case may be recommended for EC after receiving such clarification.

PP has submitted a copy of approved Mining Plan, letter from Mining Officer certifying the leases within 500 meters radius around the site and requisite information in the prescribed format duly verified by the Tehsildar and DFO. PP has reported that the pit formed after mining shall be developed into a water body. Crusher is not proposed in the lease area. Concerned Mining Officer vide letter no. 1897 dated: 01/1/2015 has reported that there are 01 more mines operating or proposed within 500 meters around the said mine and total lease area is 2.534 Ha.

Submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable except the presence of scheduled animals in the Mining Plan near the site. DFO has not commented on the issue. Hence PP was asked to obtain a clarification on this issue from concerned forest officer and submit the same at the earliest to SEAC. If DFO issues satisfactory clarification, the case may be recommended for EC after receiving such clarification.

PP has reported that the pit formed after mining shall be developed into a water body. Crusher is not proposed in the lease area. Submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable. During presentation, it was observed that the mining carried out earlier by the PP, the safety zone of 7.5 meters is not left which is evident from the Google image of the site presented by the PP. PP was asked to leave the 7.5 meters safety zone as per the approved mining plan in future mining activity. Based on the submissions made by the PP the case was recommended for grant of prior EC subject to the standard conditions laid for similar cases with following additional conditions:

Submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable. Thus, based on the submissions made by the PP the case was recommended for grant of prior EC subject to the standard conditions laid for similar cases with following additional conditions due to site sensitivity:

1. The production shall be as per the approved mining plan not exceeding 11760 cum / Year and the maximum depth of the pits shall be as per the approved mining plan.
2. Only manual mining be carried out.
3. No blasting and crushing operations are allowed in the mining lease area.
4. A safety wall should be erected near the habitat area.

**18. Case No. – 2742/2015 Shri Rupesh Rai S/o Shri Durjan Prasad Rai, Mau Road, Tehsil & District- Tikamgarh (MP)-472001.** Stone Quarry in an area of 2.60 ha. (11,760 cum/year) at Village-Parsuwan, Tehsil-Tikamgarh, District- Tikamgarh (M.P.).

This is a case of mining of Stone Quarry. The application was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal. The proposed site is located at Village-Parsuwan, Tehsil-Tikamgarh, District-Tikamgarh in 2.60 ha. The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site.

PP has submitted a copy of approved Mining Plan, letter from Mining Officer certifying the leases within 500 meters radius around the site and requisite information in the prescribed format duly verified by the Tehsildar and DFO. PP has reported that the pit formed after mining shall be developed into a water body. Crusher is not proposed in the lease area. Concerned Mining Officer vide letter no. 217 dated: 18/03/2015 has reported that there are 04 more mines operating or proposed within 500 meters around the said mine and total lease area is 18.600 Ha.

Submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable. Thus, based on the submissions made by the PP the case was recommended for grant of prior EC subject to the standard conditions laid for similar cases with following additional conditions:

1. The production shall be as per the approved mining plan not exceeding 11,760 cum / Year and the maximum depth of the pits shall be as per the approved mining plan.
2. Garland drains should be provided towards the seasonal nallah.

- 19. Case No. – 2743/2015 Smt. Abhilasha Mishra W/o Shri Aditya Narayan Mishra, Nadan Shivaprasad, Maihar, Satna (MP)-485771.** Stone Quarry in an area of 1.829 ha. (18,000 cum/year) at Village-Nadan Shivaprasad, Tehsil-Maihar, District-Satna (M.P.).

This is a case of mining of Stone Quarry. The application was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal. The proposed site is located at Village-Nadan Shivaprasad, Tehsil-Maihar, District-Satna in 1.829 ha. The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site.

PP has submitted a copy of approved Mining Plan, letter from Mining Officer certifying the leases within 500 meters radius around the site and requisite information in the prescribed format duly verified by the Tehsildar and DFO. PP has reported that the pit formed after mining shall be developed into a water body. Crusher is not proposed in the lease area. Concerned Mining Officer vide letter no. 87 dated 24/01/2015 has reported that there are 02 more mines operating or proposed within 500 meters around the said mine and total lease area is **11.741 Ha**.

Submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable. Thus, based on the submissions made by the PP the case was recommended for grant of prior EC subject to the standard conditions laid for similar cases with following additional conditions:

1. The production shall be as per the approved mining plan not exceeding 18000 cum / Year and the maximum depth of the pits shall be as per the approved mining plan.

- 20. Case No. – 2747/2015 Shri Baldev Khemani, Partner, Sahib Developers, LB Enterprises, Jumerati Chowk, Bhopal (MP)-462001 .**Prior Environment Clearance for proposed Project "Prithivi Courtyard" at Khasra No. ó 418/2, 428, 429/1, 429/2, 430/1, 430/2, 431/1/1, 431/2, Village-Samardha Kaliyasot, Tehsil-Huzur, District-Bhopal (M.P.) Total Land Area- 3.919 Ha., Total Built-up Area for Multistory- 17649.68 Sqm, TotalBuilt up Area- for Casual Shop ó 4200 Sqm. .

This is a case of multistory project. The application was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal. The proposed site is located at Khasra No. ó 418/2, 428, 429/1, 429/2, 430/1, 430/2, 431/1/1, 431/2, Village-Samardha Kaliyasot, Tehsil-Huzur, District-Bhopal in Total Land Area-3.919 Ha., The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site.

After deliberations PP was asked to submit response to the following issues raised by the committee:

1. The estimation of water requirement has been made by taking 4.0 persons per unit, while the desired norm is 5 persons per unit. Thus, the water demand and waste water generation for the project appears to be on lower side. The same has to be reviewed and furnished. If, the capacity and number of proposed STP requires any modification, same should be reassessed and revised design be submitted.
2. Expected population of visitors and staff members in the campus during operation phase is also not provided. This will also affect the calculation of daily water consumption during operation phase.
3. Undertaking / certification to be submitted in connection to the location of the project boundary with respect River Kaliyasot to be submitted complying the directions of NGT issued in this regard.
4. DG Sets of suitable capacity should be provided for alternate power supply in common area and for firefighting facilities. PP should submit details of proposed DG sets which should be with acoustic enclosures.

5. During presentation, it was observed from T&CP approved map that two H.T. lines are passing from the project site. PP informed that these HT lines are now shifted from the site. PP should submit confirmation of above statement from the competent authority.
6. PP should also submit a layout map showing locations of STPs, Rain water harvesting pits and MSW storage area with total area allocated for the individual facility.
7. In form 1-A at, it is mentioned that ground water will be extracted for fresh water requirement of the project accordingly permission of CGWB should be obtained.
8. In point no. 2.14, it is clearly mentioned that treated waste water will not be used for toilet flushing while in EMP budgetary details öBasic Cost Estimatesö, capital cost of dual plumbing is mentioned. Since two statements are contradicting each other, needs clarification from PP.
9. The road has been shown as blocked in the North Eastern end. For the easy fire tender movement this blockage should be removed. All internal roads should be atleast 7.5 meter wide.

This is a case of mining of Stone Quarry. The application was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal. The proposed site is located at Village-Charkhedi, Tehsil-Kalapipal, District-Shajapur in 1.00 ha. The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site.

PP has submitted a copy of approved Mining Plan, letter from Mining Officer certifying the leases within 500 meters radius around the site and requisite information in the prescribed format duly verified by the Tehsildar and DFO. PP has reported that the pit formed after mining shall be developed into a water body. Crusher is not proposed in the lease area. Concerned Mining Officer vide letter no. 143 dated : 2/2/2015 has reported that there are no mines operating or proposed within 500 meters around the said mine.

Submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable. Thus, based on the submissions made by the PP the case was recommended for grant of prior EC subject to the standard conditions laid for similar cases with following additional conditions:

1. The production shall be as per the approved mining plan not exceeding 4200 cum / Year and the maximum depth of the pits shall be as per the approved mining plan.

**22. Case No. – 2751/2015 Shri Lokendra Singh S/o Gajraj Singh Sisodia, Village-Tulaheda, Tehsil-Ghatia, District-Ujjain (MP)-456550.** Stone/Boulder Quarry in an area of 1.00 ha. (4,685 cum/year) at Village-Ghatia, Tehsil-Ghatia, District-Ujjain (M.P.) .

This is a case of mining of Stone/Boulder Quarry. The application was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal. The proposed site is located at Village-Ghatia, Tehsil-Ghatia, District-Ujjain in 1.00 ha. The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site.

PP has submitted a copy of approved Mining Plan, letter from Mining Officer certifying the leases within 500 meters radius around the site and requisite information in the prescribed format duly verified by the Tehsildar and DFO. PP has reported that the pit formed after mining shall be

developed into a water body. Crusher is not proposed in the lease area. Concerned Mining Officer vide letter no. 1032 dated: 05/3/2015 has reported that there are 04 more mines operating or proposed within 500 meters around the said mine and total lease area is 9.0 Ha.

Submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable. But the EMP submitted by the PP carries mistakes and is also not clear. Thus the PP was asked to submit the revised EMP. After receiving the satisfactory EMP by SEAC, the case can be recommended for grant of prior EC subject to the standard conditions laid for similar cases with following additional conditions:

1. The production shall be as per the approved mining plan not exceeding 4685 cum / Year and the maximum depth of the pits shall be as per the approved mining plan.

**23. Case No. – 2760/2015 Shri Gopal Singh S/o Shri Chandar Singh Ji, Village-Ranayara, Tehsil-Shamgarh, District-Mandsaur (MP)-458990.** *Shakkarkhedi Group River Sand Auction Quarry Lease Area - 13.680 ha., Capacity - 8,000 cum/year, at Khasra No. – 1, 243, 40, 210, 105, 803, Village-Shakkarkhedi Group, Tehsil-Sitamau, District-Mandsaur (M.P.) .*

This is a case of mining of *River Sand Auction Quarry*. The application was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal. The proposed site is located at *Khasra No. – 1, 243, 40, 210, 105, 803, Village-Shakkarkhedi Group, Tehsil-Sitamau, District-Mandsaur* in **13.680 ha.**, The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site.

PP has submitted a copy of approved Mining Plan, letter from Mining Officer certifying the leases within 500 meters radius around the site and requisite information in the prescribed format duly verified by the Tehsildar and DFO. Concerned Mining Officer vide letter no. 656 dated: 01/5/2015 has reported that there are 04 mines operating or proposed within 1000 meters around the said mine.

The EMS and other submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable. Thus committee decided to recommend **the case for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions:**

1. The amount towards reclamation of the land in MLA shall be carried out through the mining department; the appropriate amount as estimated for the activity by mining department has to be deposited with the Collector to take up the activity after the mine is exhausted.
2. PP shall be responsible for discrepancy (if any) in the submissions made by the PP to SEAC & SEIAA.
3. Plantation shall be carried out on the banks for stabilization of the banks.
4. Abstraction of sand shall be as per the approved Mining Scheme but not exceeding 8000 m<sup>3</sup> in a year and the depth of mining shall be restricted to 3m or water level, whichever is less.
5. Mining shall be carried only between 1<sup>st</sup> October to 31<sup>st</sup> May i.e. during non-monsoon period.
6. Transportation of sand shall not be carried out through forest area.
7. The mining activity shall be done manually.
8. Heavy vehicles shall not be allowed on the banks for loading of sand.
9. The sand shall be transported by small trolleys up to the main transport vehicle.
10. Transport vehicles will be covered with tarpauline to minimize dust/sand particle emissions.

11. PP has submitted a copy of approved Mining Plan, letter from Mining Officer certifying the leases within 1000 meters radius around the site and requisite information in the prescribed format duly verified by the Tehsildar and DFO. Concerned Mining Officer vide letter no. 1601 dated: 25/2/2015 has reported that there are no mine is operating / proposed within 500 meters around the said mine.

The EMS and other submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable. Thus committee decided to recommend **the case for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions:**

1. The amount towards reclamation of the land in MLA shall be carried out through the mining department; the appropriate amount as estimated for the activity by mining department has to be deposited with the Collector to take up the activity after the mine is exhausted.
2. PP shall be responsible for discrepancy (if any) in the submissions made by the PP to SEAC & SEIAA.
3. Plantation shall be carried out on the banks for stabilization of the banks.
4. Abstraction of sand shall be as per the approved Mining Scheme but not exceeding 8000 m<sup>3</sup> in a year and the depth of mining shall be restricted to 3m or water level, whichever is less.

PP has submitted a copy of approved Mining Plan, letter from Mining Officer certifying the leases within 500 meters radius around the site and requisite information in the prescribed format duly verified by the Tehsildar and DFO. PP has reported that the pit formed after mining shall be developed into a water body. Crusher is not proposed in the lease area. Concerned Mining Officer vide letter no. 86 dated: 24/01/2015 has reported that there are 04 more mines operating or proposed within 500 meters around the said mine and total lease area is 13.008 Ha.

Submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable. Thus, based on the submissions made by the PP the case was recommended for grant of prior EC subject to the standard conditions laid for similar cases with following additional conditions:

1. The production shall be as per the approved mining plan not exceeding 10,000 cum / Year and the maximum depth of the pits shall be as per the approved mining plan.

**26. Case No. – 2769/2015 Smt. Ratna Singh W/o Shri Sudhir Singh, Krishna Nagar, District- Satna (MP)-485011 For- TOR.** Prior Environment Clearance for Limestone & Laterite Mine in an area of 17.408 ha. (Expansion in production capacity from 20,000 MTA to 4,18,635 TPA) at Village-Aber, Tehsil-Rampur Baghelan, District-Satna.

This is a case of mining of Limestone & Laterite Mine. The application was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal. The proposed site is located at Village-Aber, Tehsil-Rampur Baghelan, District-Satna in 17.408 ha. The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site.

On being informed by PP that monitoring activities on site have been started since March, 2015 as per the standard TOR as prescribed by the MoEF&CC the committee allowed pp to use this date in EIA report.

After deliberations committee recommended for inclusion of following points to be addressed in the EIA / EMP in addition to standard TOR prescribed by the MoEF&CC :-

1. PP should submit MoEC&CC compliance report.
2. PP should also submit year wise production details since 2005 duly certified by the competent authority.
