The Chairman welcomed all the members of the Committee and thereafter agenda items were taken up for deliberations.

This is a case of mining of stone bolder.The application was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal. The proposed site is located *Khasra No. 30 & 35 (Part) Vill.-Mordad Khurd, Th.--Burhanpur, Dist-Burhanpur(MP)* in **3.40 ha.**. The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site.

SEIAA vide office letter no. 2039 dated: 15/4/2015 has forward the letter of PP whereby PP has requested that no industry falling under Category A or B is proposed in the proposed Industrial Area and as the total plot area is also less than 500 Ha prior EC may not be required hence PP is interested to withdraw the application. It was decided to return the case to SEIAA for further action in the matter.

3. An uninterrupted operation of STP has to be ensured in terms of dedicated power supply with appropriate back-up.
4. MSW storage / collection areas with 48 hr storage capacity shall be constructed with proper loading provisions.

The case was considered in the 197<sup>th</sup> SEAC Meeting dated 03/06/15 whereby the PP was asked to submit response to the following queries-

1. The estimation of water requirement has been made by taking 4.0 persons per unit, while the accepted is 5 persons per unit. Thus, the water demand and waste water generation for the project appears to be on lower side. The same has to be reviewed and furnished. If, the capacity and number of proposed STP requires any modification, same should be reassessed and revised design be submitted.
2. Expected population of visitors and staff members in the campus during operation phase is also not provided. This will also affect the calculation of daily water consumption during operation phase.
3. Undertaking / certification to be submitted in connection to the location of the project boundary with respect River Kaliyasot to be submitted complying the directions of NGT issued in this regard.
4. DG Sets of suitable capacity should be provided for alternate power supply in common area and for firefighting facilities. PP should submit details of proposed DG sets which should be with acoustic enclosures.
5. During presentation, it was observed from T&CP approved map that two H.T. lines are passing from the project site. PP informed that these HT lines are now shifted from the site. PP should submit confirmation of above statement from the competent authority.
6. PP should also submit a layout map showing locations of STPs, Rain water harvesting pits and MSW storage area with total area allocated for the individual facility.
7. In form 1-A at, it is mentioned that ground water will be extracted for fresh water requirement of the project accordingly permission of CGWB should be obtained.
8. In point no. 2.14, it is clearly mentioned that treated waste water will not be used for toilet flushing while in EMP budgetary details öBasic Cost Estimatesö, capital cost of dual plumbing is mentioned. Since two statements are contradicting each other, needs clarification from PP.
9. Provision for free movement of fire tenders has to be made by opening the blocked road in the NE of project.

The response submitted by the PP for the above queries was scrutinized by the committee and found to be satisfactory and acceptable. Based on the submissions and the presentation made by



the PP the case was recommended for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions:

1. Fresh Water requirement of the project during operation phase shall not exceed 114 KLD.
2. Efforts shall be made to provide Solar based lights in the common spaces including the street lights.
3. Two-row-plantation shall be carried out all around the periphery of the project site.

- Provision of mandatory buffer zone of 7.5 meters all around the periphery of the mining site.
- Mineral evacuation plan including road network, man-power and infra-structure requirement.
- Activity-wise Environment Management Scheme with appropriate budgetary provisions for execution of the same on an Affidavit.

The response submitted by the PP on above points was forwarded to SEAC for scrutiny and necessary recommendations. After scrutiny of the matter SEAC stands by its earlier recommendations and decided to forward the case to SEIAA.

Following standard conditions shall be applicable for the mining projects of minor mineral in addition to the specific conditions:

**Annexure- 'A'**

**Standard conditions applicable to Stone/Murrum and Soil quarries:**

1. The amount towards reclamation of the pit and land in MLA shall be carried out through the mining department. The appropriate amount as estimated for the activity by mining department has to be deposited with the Collector to take up the activity after the mine is exhausted.
2. PP shall be responsible for discrepancy (if any) in the submissions made by the PP to SEAC & SEIAA
3. Transportation of material shall be done in covered vehicles.
4. Necessary consents shall be obtained from MPPCB and the air/water pollution control measures have to be installed as per the recommendation of MPPCB.
5. Curtaining of site shall be done using appropriate media.
6. The proposed plantation should be carried out along with the mining and PP would maintain the plants for five years including casualty replacement.
7. Transportation shall not be carried out through forest area.
8. Appropriate activities shall be taken up for social up-liftment of the area. Funds reserved towards the same shall be utilized through Gram Panchayat.
9. PP will take adequate precautions so as not to cause any damage to the flora and fauna during mining operations.
10. The validity of the EC shall be as per the provisions of EIA Notification subject to the following: Expansion or modernization in the project, entailing capacity addition with change in process and or technology and any change in product - mix in proposed mining unit shall require a fresh Environment Clearance.

**Annexure- 'B'**

**Standard conditions applicable for the sand Mine Quarries\***

1. The amount towards reclamation of the land in MLA shall be carried out through the mining department; the appropriate amount as estimated for the activity by mining department has to be deposited with the Collector to take up the activity after the mine is exhausted.
2. PP shall be responsible for discrepancy (if any) in the submissions made by the PP to SEAC & SEIAA.
3. Plantation shall be carried out on the banks for stabilization of the banks.

4. The mining activity shall be done manually.
5. Heavy vehicles shall not be allowed on the banks for loading of sand.
6. The sand shall be transported by small trolleys up to the main transport vehicle.
7. Transport vehicles will be covered with tarpoline to minimize dust/sand particle emissions.
8. For carrying out mining in proximity to any bridge and/or embankment, appropriate safety zone on upstream as well as on downstream from the periphery of the mining site shall be ensured taking into account the structural parameters, location aspects, flow rate, etc., and no mining shall be carried out in the safety zone.
9. Mining should be avoided during Monsoon.
10. No in-stream mining shall be allowed.
11. The mining shall be carried out strictly as per the approved mining plan and ensure that the annual replenishment of sand in the mining lease area is sufficient to sustain the mining operations at levels prescribed in the mining plan.
12. Established water conveyance channels should not be relocated, straightened, or modified.
13. If the stream is dry, the excavation must not proceed beyond the lowest undisturbed elevation of the stream bottom, which is a function of local hydraulics, hydrology, and geomorphology.
14. After mining is complete, the edge of the pit should be graded to a 2.5:1 slope in the direction of the flow.
15. PP shall take Socio-economic activities in the region through the Gram Panchayat.
16. EC will be valid for mine lease period subject to a ceiling of 5 years.
