

1. Opening Remarks of the Chairman

The Chairman welcomed all the members of the Committee (**Annexure-1**) and thereafter agenda items were taken up for deliberations. The list of participants present during meeting is annexed as **Annexure-2**.

2. Consideration of the Projects:

08 Cases (for TOR / EIA deliberations) were invited. Out of these proposals only 07 proposals were presented before the committee the case no. 398/2010 scheduled for 67th meeting was also allowed for presentation. It is decided to hold the 69th & 70th meetings on 15th & 16th November 2010.

TOR for carrying out EIA / EMP was issued dated 12/09/08. Conduct the public hearing dated 19/09/2009. The public hearing issues were discussed in detail. During deliberations it was reported that, this is an existing sand mine. The type of Land is Govt. Revenue Land. The site is located at 21° 50' 34" N Latitude & 80° 10' 00"E Longitude at Village-Kanki, Tehsil-Waraseoni, District-Balaghat. Nearest Railway Line Gondia-Balaghat 2.5 Km., nearest National /State Highway -26 is reported to be 1.5 Km from the site. The area comprises of sand bank of Wainganga River. The sand bank runs in North-South Direction. It was reported that there is no notified national park / sanctuary in the 10 Km radius around the site.

The deposition of sand takes place as the flood recedes. The deposits are from fine grained material to coarse material comprising essentially of feldspathic material. The deposit is by and large is seasonal and not in-situ.

The lease is acquired for mining of sand from Wainganga River. The production of the mine is 70000 m³ /annum. The sand shall be extracted exclusively for filling of U/G Manganese mines. No storage facility is provided at site as the extracted sand shall be directly loaded in the truck for transportation. The proven reserves are estimated to be approximately 99,108 m³ /year. This being a mining project with lease area between 50 ha to 5 ha is listed at S.N. 1(a) of schedule under 'B' Category of EIA Notification, 2006 and is to be appraised by SEAC. TOR for carrying out EIA / EMP was issued dated issued vide letter no 1078 dt. 19/11/09. Conduct the public hearing dated 19/09/2010. The public hearing issues were discussed in detail. This is an existing mine presently closed. The deliberation further revealed that, village Suddi is the nearest habitat at 1.0 KM from the site. River Mahanadi 1.0 Km. Nearest Reserved Forest is Ghughari at 2.0 Km. in (NW). No Archeological Monument, National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary and Interstate Boundary have been reported in the 10 Km radius around the mining site. The documents revealed that the Mining Lease is in name of Shri Ramzan Bhai with validity from 18/10/2002 to 17/02/2022. PP has requested to change the proponent's name in view of the Mining Resource Department letter no. 3-1/2002/12/2 dated 27/07/2010. The said letter states that the lease for the remaining period is transferred to Shri Ankush Pathak R/o Pathak Ward Dist. Katni (M.P). Committee has agreed to make the change as per the request of PP. After deliberations committee has asked the PP for submission of information and supporting documents on the following queries:

- Map showing micro-level features in 2Km radius around the site.
- Location of OB area to be shown on conceptual plan.
- Details of CSR activities with budgetary provision to be submitted; a commitment has to be submitted that the funds shall be spent through Gram Panchayat.
- Plantation scheme with provision to complete the desired plantation in 33% of total lease area within the lease period. Scheme should clearly indicate the species of plants to be planted. At least 2000 plants per Hectare should be planted.
- NOC from Gram Sabha for mining.

This being a mining project with lease area between 50 ha to 5 ha is listed at S.N. 1(a) of schedule under 'B' Category of EIA Notification, 2006 and is to be appraised by SEAC. TOR for carrying out EIA / EMP was issued dated issued vide letter dated 03/04/2010. Conduct the public hearing dated 25/07/2010. The public hearing issues were discussed in detail. The deliberation further revealed that, the nearest habitat is Village Jura which is more than 500 meters. Nearest National Highway(NH-7) reported to be 1.7 Km.

It was observed that out of 29.163 Ha PP has acquired only 3 ha land. The remaining land is private land which is yet to be acquired. PP has failed to submit agreement documents regarding surface rights. Committee asked the PP to explain that how activities pertaining to mining shall be carried out in the land (3 Ha) occupied presently. Approach for the occupied site could not be explained by the PP. Committee has therefore decided to visit the site before any decision in the matter.

This being a mining project with lease area between 50 ha to 5 ha is listed at S.N. 1(a) of schedule under 'B' Category of EIA Notification, 2006 and is to be appraised by SEAC. During deliberations it was reported that, this is case of fresh Mine. The project is proposed in Khasra No. is 107/4, 122,123, 124,125 at Private Revenue Land. The dolomite is considered for estimation of proved category reserves to be 7 m depth. The Geological Reserves of Dolomite is 25,37,000 Tonnes . Mineable reserves are 8,10,000 Tonnes. Proposed production 10,000 TPA of Dolomite from this mine. Anticipated life of the mine is 81 Years. The mining operation will be carried out manually by the opencast manual method. The mining operation will be done with the help of drilling and blasting in the southern part of the area. The depth of water table is reported to be 18 m to 19 m. Ultimate depth of working shall be 7 m, thus mining shall not intersect ground water table. No surface water bodies have been reported in the lease area and the adjoining area. It was reported that the project site is situated at more than 10 Km distance from the Maharashtra State Border.

After deliberations committee has approved the TOR for carrying out EIA/EMP with inclusion of following points:

- Duly attested & certified Mining Plan approved by competent authority has to be submitted along with the copy of current lease deed and lease letter.

- Monitoring has to be taken up as per the norms using appropriate air/water quality modeling, based on meteorological data (wind-rose) of the region.
- All chemical analyses report from approved laboratory in original format. The chemical analyses should incorporate method of analyses, instruments used and the details of standards used. The date and time of sampling should also be mentioned in the report.
- All monitoring has to be conducted as per the notification dated 16/11/2009.
- Total area for which afforestation has been proposed – plan stating how much plantation shall be taken up yearly, has to be submitted. Plantation of local species along with Sheesham, Neem, Tendu, Kachnar & various fire-wood trees should be taken up. Map showing green belt to be submitted.
- Plantation in at least 33% of the total area has to be ensured with the lease period; accordingly plan with map depictions has to be submitted with EIA.
- PFR should include cost benefit analyses considering- social cost, environment cost and pre-occupational cost.
- For welfare of the mine-workers various activities such as regular health checkups, first-aid, shelter for rest and meals, drinking water etc. has to be taken up. Nearby mine owners may form a society and funds for welfare of mine-workers may be created from various govt. schemes and other sources. This aspect has to be covered in the EMP.
- Management of OB solid waste generated during mining has to be addressed through incorporation of a concrete plan for the same. The OB area should be as away as possible from the water bodies in vicinity of the site.

- Location is also to be shown in Tehsil map procured from revenue department.
- The EIA should be prepared based on model TOR for appraisal of mining projects issued by MoEF, Delhi
- NOC from Gram Sabha for mining as well for supply of water from the village sources.
- NOC from forest department mentioning the distances of lease area from reserve forest, wild life sanctuaries, national parks etc.
- All distances have to be reported along with GPS co-ordinates.
- EMP should address the measures planned to protect the water bodies in vicinity of the project site.
- EIA has to be conducted by NABET approved consultant only.
