The case was earlier discussed in the 244<sup>th</sup> & 268<sup>th</sup> SEAC meetings dated 08/12/0215 and 16/01/2016 respectively. In the 268<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting dated 16/01/2016 it was decided that:-

- 1. Replenishment details of sand are not mentioned in the mine plan. Thus PP was asked to provide replenishment details duly approved by the competent authority.
- 2. An alternate evacuation route has been proposed by the committee. PP was asked to submit alternate evacuation route as suggested by the committee.

The PP has submitted the reply of above quaries vide letter dated 18/01/2016 which was placed before the committee with the proceedings of the 244<sup>th</sup> & 268<sup>th</sup> SEAC meetings dated 08/12/0215 and 16/01/2016 respectively. PP and their consultant were also present.

The committee after scrutiny of documents found that the PP has submitted replenish plan duly approved by the competent authority and other desired informations as per the minutes of 268<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting dated 16/01/2016. Committee also decided that the District Authority should record the deposition of sand in the lease area annually in the last week of September and maintain the records in RL (Reduce Level) Measurement Book. Accordingly authority may allow lease holder to excavate the replenished quantity of sand in the subsequent year.

On the basis of above committee decided to <u>recommend the case for grant of prior EC subject</u> to the following special conditions in addition to the standard conditions at annexure  $:B\alpha$ 

- Production of Sand as per mine plan with quantity not exceeding 1,44,000 cum/year.
- District Authority should record the deposition of sand in the lease area annually in the last week of September and maintain the records in RL (Reduce Level) Measurement Book. Accordingly authority may allow lease holder to excavate the replenished quantity of sand in the subsequent year.
- Evacuation of sand should not be allowed through the roads passing through the villages
- Heavy vehicles (Hywa) should not be allowed on Kachcha, narrow roads
- If causeway (Rapta) is required to be constructed for mining. It should be removed completely before rainy season every year.
- The river bank from where access ramps are made should be restored and access should be closed every year before rainy season.
- No diversion of active channel should be allowed for mining.

During evaluation it was observed that as per the certificate issued by the DFO, Ken ghariyal Abhayaran is 8.50 kms from the QL area (a Notified PA) Clearance from NBWL is therefore needed.
