

The 164th meeting of the State Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC) was held on 7th January, 2015 under the Chairmanship of Dr. R. B. Lal. The following members attended the meeting-

The Chairman welcomed all the members of the Committee and thereafter agenda items were taken up for deliberations.

- 1. Case No. – 1989/2014 Shri Prakash Barfa S/o Shri Hiralal Barfa, Village-Rajgarh, Tehsil-Sardarpur, District-Dhar (MP) Basalt Stone Quarry Lease Area – 3.00 ha., at Khasra No. - 563/1, Village-Kanjrota, Tehsil-Sardarpur, District-Dhar (MP) Capacity – 19950 Cubic mt./Year.**

This is a case of mining of stone bolder. The application was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal. The proposed site is located at Khasra No. -563/1, Village-Kanjrota, Tehsil-Sardarpur, District-Dhar (MP) in 3.0 ha. The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site. Proposed production capacity is 19950 m³ / Year.

PP has submitted a copy of approved Mining Plan, letter from Mining Officer certifying the leases within 500 meters radius around the site and requisite information in the prescribed format duly verified by the Tehsildar and DFO. It was reported by the concerned Mining Officer of mining department, that 03 more mines are operating / proposed within 500 meter radius around the said mine; the total lease area being 7.5 Ha. PP has reported that the pit formed after mining shall be developed into a water body.

Scrutiny of the mining plan reveals the presence of certain scheduled animals in the area which needs confirmation from the forest department. The DFO in his letter has not commented on this issue. Hence, PP was asked to obtain comments of concerned DFO on this issue and submit.

- 2. Case No. – 1990/2014 Smt. Jaya W/o Late Shri Prashant Yadav, 180, Abdalpura, Ujjain (MP)-456001 Stone (Gitti) Quarry Lease Area – 4.00 ha., at Khasra No. -192, Village-Jalakhedi, Tehsil-Ujjain, District-Ujjain (MP) Capacity – 30000 Cubic mt./Year.**

This is a case of mining of stone bolder. The application was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal. The proposed site is located at Khasra No. -192, Village-Jalakhedi, Tehsil-Ujjain, District-Ujjain (MP) in 4.00 ha. The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site.

PP has submitted a copy of approved Mining Plan, letter from Mining Officer certifying the leases within 500 meters radius around the site and requisite information in the prescribed format duly verified by the Tehsildar and DFO. It was reported by the concerned Mining Officer of mining department vide letter no. 574 dated 26/09/2014, that 10 more mines are operating / proposed within 500 meter radius around the said mine and the total lease area of all the mines including this mine is 23.5 ha. PP has reported that the pit formed after mining shall be developed into a water body.

After deliberations committee decided to visit the site in view of following:

- A group of 11 mines with total lease area of 23.5 ha are proposed / operating within 500 meter radius, as a result the area expected to be under cumulative impact when all the crushers are operational. Hence, there is a need of a common EMP for the region based on the nearby land-use.

- Based on the present scenario of the region and the nearby sensitive receptors decision in the matter shall be taken after the site visit.

Neither the Project Proponent (PP) nor his representative was present to explain the query which might be raised or to make any commitment which may be desired by the committee during the deliberation. Committee decided to call the PP in subsequent meetings after hearing from PP. A request has to be made by the PP for scheduling the case in coming meetings within a month's time after which the case shall be returned to SEIAA assuming that PP is not interested to continue with the project.

This is a case of mining of stone bolder. The application was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal. The proposed site is located at Khasra No. -194,195, Village-Saaphkeda, Tehsil-Shajapur, District-Shajapur (MP) in 2.00 ha. The project requires prior EC before commencement of any activity at site.

PP has submitted a copy of approved Mining Plan, letter from Mining Officer certifying the leases within 500 meters radius around the site and requisite information in the prescribed format duly verified by the Tehsildar and DFO. 8. Production of stone boulder shall be as per the mining plan not exceeding 30000 m³/Year and maximum average depth of pits shall not exceed 6 meters.
9. The proposed plantation should be carried out along with the mining and PP would maintain the plants for five years including casualty replacement.
10. Transportation shall not be carried out through forest area.
11. Appropriate activities shall be taken up for social up-liftment of the Region. Funds reserved towards the same shall be utilized through Gram Panchayat.
12. PP will take adequate precautions so as not to cause any damage to the flora and fauna during mining operations.
13. The validity of the EC shall be as per the provisions of EIA Notification subject to the following: Expansion or modernization in the project, entailing capacity addition with change in process and or technology and any change in product - mix in proposed mining unit shall require a fresh Environment Clearance.

3. Case no. - 720/2012 Smt. Manisha Nayak, M/s Sohini Agency Pvt. Ltd., Nayak House, 114 Manbhawan Nagar, Madaorao Sindhiya Chauraha, Indore (M.P.) - Bijaiyan Laterite & Quartz Deposit Mine at Khasra No. - 59 Part, 88 Part, 90 Part, 91 Part, and 92 Village ó Bijaiyan, Tehsil ó Sihora, Distt. ó Jabalpur (M.P.) Area- 16.87 ha, Capacity & Minerals: Laterite & Quartz mine ó 10,000 MTPA.- Qry Reply SEAC.

The case was considered in the 153rd meeting dated 21/10/2014 whereby the PP was asked to furnish a clear revenue map. The same was submitted by the PP and examined by the committee.

The EMS and other submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable, hence committee decided to recommend the case for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions:

1. PP shall be responsible for discrepancy (if any) in the submissions made by the PP to SEAC & SEIAA
2. Transportation of material shall be done in covered vehicles.
3. Necessary consents shall be obtained from MPPCB and the air pollution control measures for crusher have to be installed as per the recommendation of MPPCB.
4. Permission / NOC shall be obtained from Gram Panchayat for lifting water from the village resources and shall be furnished to MPPCB while obtaining necessary consents under the provisions of Air / Water consents.
5. The proposed plantation should be carried out along with the mining and PP would maintain the plants for five years including casualty replacement.
6. Garland drains shall be constructed around all the OB dumps and shall be connected to a settling tank of appropriate size.
7. PP will take adequate precautions so as not to cause any damage to the flora and fauna during mining operations.

4. Case No. – 1804/2014 Shri Dhiraj Prakash Agrawal, Director, M/s H.G.

Infratech Pvt. Ltd., Govind Bagh, Gandhi Road, Thatipur, R.K. Puri POGwalior, Distt- Gwalior (M.P.)-474011. Building Construction. SEIAA letter no. 1157 dt. 25/09/14 Rec. Dt. 25/09/14 ***Emerald Greens of M/s H.G. Infratech Pvt. Ltd. at Khasra No. – 477,483,481/2, 491/2, 493, 494, 495, 501/1 Village – Khureri, Tehsil & Distt. – Gwalior (M.P.)***

Case was discussed in the 153rd SEAC meeting dated 21/10/2014 whereby the PP was asked to submit response to the following queries:

- A. Agreement / permission / commitment from Gwalior Municipal Corporation for disposal of surplus treated sewage into the municipal drain. The detail of such plan has to be furnished with drawing of the sewer system existing as well as proposed in the region. - Not satisfactory.
- B. Review the proposed road net-work including the width for smooth movement of fire tender; possibility should also be explored additional emergency gate for fire tenders from near the towers.- Satisfactory submission.
- C. Filter press has to be placed for drying the STP sludge; accordingly plan to be submitted. - Not submitted.
- D. Provisional NOC for fire-fighting plan to be furnished. Satisfactory submission.
- E. Capacity of the proposed STP has to be reviewed in light of the waste-water generation from the project. Satisfactory submission.
- F. The location of the STP also needs to be reviewed keeping in mind the contours and locations of the other features in the project.
- G. The distance of Air Force installations has been shown to be about 9.0 Km from the site in the application form, whereas the same was reported to be more than 10 Km. The issue needs clarification. 6 Satisfactory submission.

Scrutiny of the response submitted by the PP reveals that, response to the following queries is not satisfactory / not submitted:

- Agreement / permission / commitment from Gwalior Municipal Corporation for disposal of surplus treated sewage into the municipal drain. The detail of such plan has to be furnished with drawing of the sewer system existing as well as proposed in the region.
- Filter press has to be placed for drying the STP sludge; accordingly plan to be submitted.

Hence committee decided to ask the PP to immediately submit the requisite information along with the supporting documents for further necessary action in the matter.

5. Case No. – 1907/2014 Shri Devendra Singh S/o Shri Sardar Singh, A-394, 1st Floor, Flat No. 7, Durga Vihar, Devli Exy. Khanpur, New Delhi. Sand Quarry at at Khasra No. – 405, Village- Lasgarha, Tehsil- Lavkushnagar, District-Chhatarpur (MP) ,Lease Area – 2.00ha.,Capacity - 58613Cubic mt. / Year.

This is a case for prior EC for Riveróbed sand mining from a lease area of 02.00 Ha. The application for the prior EC was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal and necessary recommendations.

The case was discussed in the 159th meeting letter from Mining Officer pertaining to number of mines operating / proposed within 1 Km from the peripheries of this mine was not furnished by the PP. The same has been submitted by the PP and has been examined by the SEAC. It is reported by the concerned mining officer vide letter no. 39dated 08/01/2015 that no mine is operating / proposed within 1 Km from the peripheries of this mine.

The submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable hence based on the visit observations and PP's submission the case was recommended for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions:

1. The amount towards reclamation of the land in MLA shall be carried out through the mining department; the appropriate amount as estimated for the activity by mining department has to be deposited with the Collector to take up the activity after the mine is exhausted.
2. PP shall be responsible for discrepancy (if any) in the submissions made by the PP to SEAC & SEIAA.
3. It was observed during the visit to Alirajpur by the sub-committee that the banks of the tributaries have been eroded due to floods hence as special condition PP shall use the rejects and soil for plantation on these eroded banks to prevent further damages of the banks.
4. Annual abstraction of sand shall be as per the approved Mining Scheme and the depth of mining shall be restricted to 3m or water level, whichever is less.
5. Mining shall be carried only between 1st November to 31st May i.e. during non-monsoon period.
6. Transportation of sand shall not be carried out through forest area.
7. The mining activity shall be done manually.
8. Heavy vehicles shall not be allowed on the banks for loading of sand.
9. The sand shall be transported by small trolleys up to the main transport vehicle.
10. Transport vehicles will be covered with tarpoline to minimize dust/sand particle emissions.
11. For carrying out mining in proximity to any bridge and/or embankment, appropriate safety zone of 1 Km on upstream as well as on downstream from the periphery of the mining site shall be ensured taking into account the structural parameters, location aspects, flow rate, etc., and no mining shall be carried out in the safety zone.
12. No in stream mining shall be allowed.
13. The mining shall be carried out strictly as per the approved mining plan and ensure that the annual replenishment of sand in the mining lease area is sufficient to sustain the mining operations at levels prescribed in the mining plan.
14. Established water conveyance channels should not be relocated, straightened, or modified.
15. If the stream is dry, the excavation must not proceed beyond the lowest undisturbed elevation of the stream bottom, which is a function of local hydraulics, hydrology, and geomorphology.
16. After mining is complete, the edge of the pit should be graded to a 2.5:1 slope in the direction of the flow.
17. PP shall take Socio-economic activities in the region through the Gram Panchayat.
18. PP will take adequate precautions so as not to cause any damage to the flora and fauna during mining operations.
19. EC will be valid for mine lease period subject to a ceiling of 5 years.

6. Case No. 665 /2012 - SADA Special Area Development Authority, 12, city centre, Gwalior -474001 Township project 805 ha. at village sojna, Tighra, Kaitha, Kulaith, Teh & Distt. Gwalior-M.P.

The case was discussed in length in the 111th meeting dated 5/12/2012 and 124th meeting dated 13/03/2013, whereby PP was asked to submit response to several queries along with NOC from Forest department regarding the land-use of the patch of RF Reserve Forest (RF-19 & part of RF-20) falling within the project boundary. The same was submitted by the PP. The case is recommended for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions:

1. Cleaning and grubbing shall be done in planned manner as construction progresses and will be limited to areas where construction is proposed.
2. Top soil will be stripped to specified depth not exceeding 150 mm and stored in stockpiles not exceeding 2m height. Top soil shall not be unnecessarily trafficked either before stripping or when in stockpile.

3. All existing trees within the premises shall be conserved. The non-built up areas will be covered with grass turfing.
 4. Garbage shall not be dumped in open areas but stored and disposed only as per proposed plan.
 5. The construction site will be encapsulated from all sides to avoid wind laded with construction material.
 6. All dust producing construction materials will be transported with proper cover as tarpaulin.
 7. Regular sprinkling of water shall be done at site for dust suppression.
 8. Heavy construction machinery and vehicle plying on site will be regularly maintained, shall conform to vehicular emission norms and shall be checked periodically.
 9. Green belt development along road side to attenuate the effect of air pollution will begins from construction phase.
 10. The different waste arising out shall be handled and disposed according to following rules depending upon the applicability:
 - Municipal Solid Waste (Management and Handling) Rule 2000.
 - Hazardous Waste (Management and Handling) Rule 2003 and
 - Batteries (Management and Handling) Rule 2001.
 - Biomedical waste (M&H) Rule, 1998
 11. Mobile Toilets with portable STP will be provided for workers and staff on the site.
 12. Use of recycled water for Flushing, Gardening, and DG cooling purposes etc.
 13. STP of capacity 30 MLD is proposed to treat the sewage and recycled within premises at max extent.
 14. Use of water saving devices i.e. low flow flushing cisterns, sensor based fixtures, automated flushing urinals.
 15. Rain water harvesting to augment the ground water.
 16. 596.5 acres area i.e. 30% of total area is under Green.
 17. All arterial roads (60 m ROW) with 10 m wide central verge & 3 m buffer comprising a green strip.
8. **Case No. – 714/2013 – Shri D.M. Nimje, Dy. General Manager (Operations) Indian Oil Corporation, M.P. State Office, 16, Arera Hills, Jail Road, Bhopal (M.P.) – 462011- EIA Presentation- Construction of additional tankage for MS & ATF and Tank Truck Loading Facility at existing IOCL terminal at Bangrod, District Ratlam. SEIAA letter no. 2130 dt 19/11/2014.**
The salient features of the project, impacts and proposed additional mitigations were discussed in the meeting. The case pertains to enhancement in the storage / loading capacities. Although PP and his consultant presented the compliances of the existing EC, the verification report from MoEF was not submitted. The same is still awaited. PP may be asked to submit the same at the earliest for further necessary action in the matter.
9. **Case No. - 1793/2014 Smt. Neeta Garg W/o Shri Rajesh Garg, 35, Shalini Marg, Sardarpur, Tehsil-Sardarpur, District-Dhar (M.P.)-454111 Pasawada Basalt Stone Quarry Lease Area –2.0 ha. Khasra No. – 424 at Village-Pasawada, Tehsil-Sardarpur, District-Dhar(M.P.) Lease Period – 10 Year, Capacity – 14440 Cu.mt./Year. Case Recommended 152nd SEAC Meeting dt. 20th Oct. 2014. SEIAA letter no. 2313 dt. 26/11/2014.**

SEAC has recommended the case for grant of EC with validity of EC as follows:

‘Validity of the EC shall be maximum for 05 years (i.e. up the lease period).’

SEIAA has asked the justification for the validity of EC recommended by SEAC as above. The case was examined in light of the SEIAA letter dated 26/11/2014 and the submissions made by the PP.

It was concluded that the validity period has now been decided to be as follows- *The validity of the EC shall be as per the provisions of EIA Notification subject to the following: Expansion or modernization in the project, entailing capacity addition with change in process and or technology and any change in product - mix in proposed mining unit shall require a fresh*

Environment Clearance. – The same be considered for this case also. Other conditions suggested by the SEAC shall be applicable as such.

10. **Case No. - 625/2011 Mr. Utpal Debnath, Registrar I/C, Indira Gandhi National Tribal University, Amarkantk, Mekal Sadan, Kapildhara Road – Amarkantk (M.P.) - 484886** For Building Construction Indira Gandhi National Tribal University Amarkantak , at Khasra No.- 136-217, 658- 684, 180/715, 201/71, 201/717, 207/718 in Village - Lalpur ; 342, 344 - 454 in Village - Sendurkhar ; 2-99, 129-136, 138/1, 139 in Village - Bijori Bhauri (Indore By Pass Road) Village - Lalpur, Sendurkhar , Bijori Tehsil - Amarkantk District ó Anuppur (M.P.) Plot Area - 1501440 sq mt., Total. Built up Area - 575998.85 sq mt. Env. Consultant: GRC I. (P) Ltd. Noida (U.P.) ToR issued vide letter no 262 dt. 12/09/13. SEIAA letter no. 927 dt. 04/09/2014

Case was recommended from SEAC in 146th SEAC Meeting dt. 08th Nov. 2013. SEIAA asked the PP to submit following ó Proper layout, showing details of buildings, parking etc., NOC from concerned agencies for water, waste water discharge, MSW disposal and fire fighting system etc. and simultaneously returned the case to SEAC for re-appraisal on the basis of above submissions. The requisite information is yet not submitted by the PP. Thus the case shall be considered only after submission of the requisite information and the supporting documents.

11. **Case No. 403/2009 - Dr. S.S. Mishra, Dean Sagar Medical College, District Hospital Tili, Sagar, (M.P) 470-002-** *Construction of Medical College with 150 admissions & Hospital with 750 beds, at Sagar.* Case forwarded vide SEIAA letter no. 971 dt 12/09/2014

Case was discussed in the 28th meeting dated 11/06/2009, 109th meeting dated 06/11/2012 and 119th meeting dated 02/02/2013. PP was required to submit response to the queries mentioned below which were not submitted despite of several reminders. The case was recommended for delisting by SEAC. SEIAA delisted the case in its meeting dated 22/04/2013. Later, the detailed reply to the queries was submitted by the PP directly to the SEIAA with request for re-considering the case as the facility is being operational in the interest of public. SEIAA accepted the request of PP and forwarded the case to SEAC for scrutiny of the response submitted by the PP.

1. Quantity and source of water during construction and operational phases have to be reported separately accordingly necessary permission / commitment from the concerned agency to be submitted.
2. A lay-out of the site showing proposed green area & locations of tube-wells have to be furnished with area calculation for green belt. 33% of total area should be ensured for green area in the proposal.
3. Location of the site and the proposed additional land (where ETP, STP & incinerator etc. is proposed) - showing land use of at least 2-6 Km area around these has to be provided.
4. Documents pertaining to procurement of additional land.
5. Category-wise Quantity & space for storing the segregated BMW prior to disposal, location of incinerator, shredder, autoclave and deep-burial site has to be submitted on lay out.
6. Details of the design and specification of deep burial site and incinerator has to be submitted.
7. ETP / STP details to be provided along with the disposal of liquid effluent.
8. Proposal for the re-use and recycle of treated effluent has to be submitted.
9. Details of the safety measures to be provided w.r.t. to fire, accidents, radiations etc,
10. Plan for disposal of hazardous wastes (used oil and filters from DG-Sets or any other HW expected) to be submitted.
11. Building permission from Municipal Corporation to be furnished.
12. Wind speed / direction with wind rose to be submitted.
13. Analyses of water and the base line ambient air quality to be reported through Govt. approved laboratory.

14. Use of solar energy has to be promoted; in view of this a plan has to be submitted.
15. Quantification of the recharge expected from water harvesting system to be furnished.
Precaution taken to avoid any infiltration of infectious contaminants from Bio-medical waste has to be addressed.

Point-wise response to the above queries was submitted by the PP. It was decided to call the PP in coming meetings for a presentation on the above issues along with the recent status of the project.
