

1. **Case No 2642 /2015** Prior Environmental Clearance for proposed Residential Group Housing Project "Signature 360" at Khasra No. 367, 368, 369, 375, 376, 377, 378, 379, 380, at Village-Barrai, Tehsil-Huzur, District- Bhopal, M. P. Total Project area - 75,700 m² (7.57 Hect.) sq. m. Built up Area - 52,229 sq. m. by M/s Signature Builders and Colonizers Bhopal through Mr. Rajesh Parchani CEO A-101, Orchard Point, Palace Orchard Kolar Road, Bhopal- 462016 E-mail: signature360.bhopal@gmail.com. - (1) The proposed project is building & construction Residential Group Project "Signature 360" at Khasra No. 367, 368, 369, 375, 376, 377, 378, 379, 380 at village Barrai, Tehsil Huzur, District- Bhopal, M.P. The total built-up area of 52229 sq. m. hence the project comes under 8 (a) category (B) of schedule of EIA Notification, 2006.
- (2) Application for Prior Environmental Clearance was submitted by PP in SEIAA office on 26.03.15
- (3) The case was registered and forwarded to SEAC for appraisal on 30.03.15.
- (4) PP has submitted T & CP approval vide no. 2237 dtd. 11.07.2012 & building permission dtd.18.06.12 / 28.06.12 for built up area 19841.40 sqmt. & 36906.08 sqmt respectively.
- (5) Along with the application Form PP submitted affidavit stating that construction activities have already been started at site. PP also submitted Resolution dtd 16.01.2015 regarding violation.
- (6) The case was discussed in 196th SEAC meeting dtd 02.06.2015 and recorded that *"It was reported by the PP and their consultant that construction activity at site has already been initiated. Thus the case is of violation. Committee decided to return the case to SEIAA with recommendation for credible action as per the provisions of the O.M. of MoEF & CC dated 12/12/2012. The case can only be considered after receipt of evidence of credible action against the duly forwarded by SEIAA"*
- (7) The Authority is of the view that it is undisputed that PP has already started construction work for the project "Signature 360" at village Barrai, District Bhopal without obtaining prior EC under EIA Notification 2006, hence it is a case of violation. **It is decided that :-**
 - (i). As per GoI, MoEF & CC office memorandum No. J-110131/41/2006-IA-II dtd 12.12.12 and 27.06.13 PP should submit the details of date of starting the construction work, breakup of the total built up area that has been constructed, number of units sold, the present status of the construction activity, whether it is still going on or stopped and why the construction activities have been undertaken without taking prior Environmental Clearance under EIA Notification, 2006? **PP should stop the construction activities with immediate effect and should not undertake any further construction/development activity until Environmental Clearance is granted under EIA Notification 2006 otherwise strict action will be taken and another case of credible action shall be initiated.**
 - (ii). A letter should be sent to Principal Secretary, GoMP, UAD & E giving the details of violation, to take action as per office memorandum of MoEF, GoI J-11013/41/2006 IA II (I)dt. 27.06.13 & 12.12.2012 (Para 2) *"to initiate credible action on the violation by invoking powers under section 19 of*

the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for taking necessary legal action under section 15 of the Act for the period for which the violation has taken place and evidence provided to MoEF of the credible action taken." The details of legal action taken by the Principal Secretary UAD & E GoMP taken should be made available to the Authority by 30.08.2015. A copy of letter should be endorsed to MS, MPPCB.

- (iii). Details of project proponent, a copy of commitment and Resolution passed in the meeting of the Board of Directors of M/s Signature Builders & Colonizers; Bhopal should be put on the website of MPSEIAA for information of all stake holders.

(8) **PP should submit the above information latest by 30.07.2015.**

- (1) This is a case of Manufacturing of bulk drugs (Vitamins and Intermediate). The proposed site is located at Plot No. 06, New Industrial Area Phase-II Mandideep, District- Raisen (M.P.) The project is covered under 5 (f) category B of the Schedule of EIA Notification issued by the Ministry of Environment & Forests vide S.O.1533(E), dtd. September 14, 2006 and its amendments.
- (2) Application for Prior Environmental Clearance was submitted by PP received in SEIAA office 23.04.15.
- (3) The case was registered and forwarded to SEAC for appraisal on 28.04.15.
- (4) The case was discussed in 198th SEAC meeting dtd 04.06.2015 and recorded that "The case was scheduled for the approval of proposed TOR. During deliberation and as per the information submitted by the PP in the application, it was noticed that this unit has already undergone an expansion in the year 2008 and 2014 respectively without obtaining EC which constitutes the violation of EIA Notification, 2006 and thus credible action has to be initiated as per the provisions of OM dated 12/12/2012 issued by MoEF&CC, Delhi. In the light of above facts, the case is sent back to SEIAA for onward necessary action".
- (5) PP has submitted letter dtd 03.07.2015 along with the copy of the NGT order dtd 07.04.2015 in which he has been directed to obtain EC. **It is decided that PP may be called for presentation.**

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3. **Case No. 2190/2014** Prior Environment Clearance for proposed Residential Project "Shri Krishna Heights" at Village Barrai, Tehsil-Huzur, District- Bhopal (M.P.) by Mr. K.L. Moolani, MD, Bhojpal Builders & Developers Pvt. Ltd., Mez. Floor-3, R.K. Tower, 93-94, Zone-II, M.P. Nagar, Bhopal-462011 (MP)-

- (1) The proposed project is building & construction Residential Project "Shri Krishna Heights" at Village Barrai, Tehsil-Huzur, District- Bhopal (M.P.). The total built-up area of 51179.76 sq. m. hence the project comes under 8 (a) category (B) of schedule of EIA Notification, 2006.
- (2) SEAC has informed that this is a case of violation and should be dealt accordingly. They have also made site visit on 16.04.15 and noted that construction is in progress in all the seven towers and 168 flats. **It is decided that :-**

- (i) **PP should stop the construction activities with immediate effect and should not undertake any further construction/ development activity until Environmental Clearance is granted under EIA Notification 2006 otherwise strict action will be taken and another case of credible action shall be initiated.**

- (ii) PP should be called for a presentation on the following point:-

Details of date of starting the construction work, breakup of the total built up area that has been constructed, number of units sold, the present status of the construction activity, whether it is still going on or stopped and why the construction activities have been undertaken without taking prior Environmental Clearance under EIA Notification, 2006?

- (iii) A letter should be sent to MS, MPPCB to submit the site inspection report conducted for initiating legal action under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

4. **Case No. 2092/2014** Prior Environment Clearance for proposed commercial project "Pacific Business Centre" at Village-Bawadia Kalan, Tehsil-Huzur, District - Bhopal (MP) M/s SARC Infrastructure & Technology, Near Bawarchi Restaurant, Hoshangabad Road, Bhopal-462026 -

- (1) The proposed project is building & construction Commercial Project ""Pacific Business Centre" at Village-Bawadia Kalan, Tehsil-Huzur, District - Bhopal (MP). The total built-up area of 52152.36 sq. m. hence the project comes under 8 (a) category (B) of schedule of EIA Notification, 2006.
- (2) SEAC has informed that this is a case of violation and should be dealt accordingly. They have also made site visit on 15 & 16 April 2015 and noted that construction is in progress. **It is decided that :-**

- (i). **PP should stop the construction activities with immediate effect and should not undertake any further construction/ development activity until Environmental Clearance is granted under EIA Notification 2006 otherwise strict action will be taken and another case of credible action shall be initiated.**



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- (ii). PP should be called for a presentation on the following point:-

Details of date of starting the construction work, breakup of the total built up area that has been constructed, number of units sold, the present status of the construction activity, whether it is still going on or stopped and why the construction activities have been undertaken without taking prior Environmental Clearance under EIA Notification, 2006?

- (iii). A letter should be sent to MS, MPPCB to submit the site inspection report conducted for initiating legal action under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

5. Case No 2458/2015 Prior Environmental Clearance for proposed Group Project "Silver Estate Vertica" located at 60, 61, 62, 63, 64/1, and 66 Village- Katara Tehsil Huzur District Bhopal M.P. Plot Area - 16,700 sq.m. and built-up area is 27,033.28 sq.m. by Mr. Neeraj Bhushan Macker 501, 5th Floor, Ashima Corporate Zone, Ashima Mall, Hoshangabad Road, Bhopal- 462026 E-mail info@mackerrealventures.com Telephone No. 405-3444, 6461989

- (1) The proposed project is building & construction Group housing residential project at Village- Katara Tehsil Huzur District Bhopal M.P. The project includes Residential Block (06); Convenient Shops; Club house & EWS.
- (2) As per the T & CP Bhopal (vide let no.3091 dtd.29.10.11). The total land area is 1.67 ha (16,700 Sq.m.) The total built up area proposed by PP is 27,033.28 sq.m. The project comes under 8 (a) category (B) of schedule of EIA Notification, 2006 because total construction is between 20,000 sq mt. & 1, 50,000 sq mt. and plot area is less than 50 ha.
- (3) It is a case of violation of EIA Notification 2006 as PP has started the construction work before obtaining prior Environmental Clearance. As per SEAC 182nd meeting dtd. 28.03.15 *"..It was reported by the PP that this is a case of violation where credible action has been initiated. It was submitted that approx.50% construction is complete prior to submission of application for grant of EC. The construction has been ceased presently. The application and the evidence pertaining to legal action against the PP have been forwarded by the SEIAA for appraisal of the case on merits of the project..."*
- (4) Member Secretary, SEAC vide letter no. 771/PS-MS/MPPCB/SEAC dtd 06.11.2013 informed that credible action has been initiated under section 15 of EPA, 1986 against the M/s Macker Real Ventures for the violation committed by them in the Court of CJM, Bhopal on 01.11.2013.
- (5) The case was discussed in SEAC meetings 182nd dtd. 28.03.15 & 198th dtd. 04.06.15 and is recommended for grant of post – facto EC subject to 03 special conditions.
- (6) The case was discussed in depth and it is decided that :-
 - (i). **PP should be called for presentation.**
 - (ii). **MS, MPPCB should be asked to submit copy of site visit report conducted at the time of initiating the credible action against PP for the said project.**



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- (iii). It is noted that Hon'ble National Green Tribunal, Central Zone, Bhopal Bench in original application no. 153/2014 (CZ) has passed order dtd 13.08.2014 as under :-

"We make it clear by this order that we do not wish to interfere or make any observation with regard to any action which the SEIAA may have initiated prior to filing of this application on the basis of letter dtd 08.10.13 (Annexure – A5). It is also necessary to mention that in accordance with the conditions imposed by Director of Town & Country Planning (T & CP), no occupation of the building shall be allowed without inspection by the T & CP and without obtaining completion certificate."

6. **Case No. 631/2011**, Prior Environmental Clearance for Group Housing Project "Chinar Dream CT" land area 95456.68 sqmt. (T & CP approval) 11.362 ha (.ppt & 81st SEAC meeting dtd 12.10.11) at Village Ratanpur Sadak & Narela Hanumant, Tehsil Huzur, Distt Bhopal, MP by M/S Chinar Reality Pvt. Ltd. through Director Shri Sunil Moolchandani, H.No. 231, Zone-II, MP Nagar, Bhopal.

- (1) The case was discussed in 173rd SEIAA meeting dtd 09.01.2015 and it is recorded that "(1).... (2)...."

- (3) *The case was discussed in depth and in view of clarification received from MoEF, GoI (vide letter dtd 24.11.2014 and office memorandum dtd 22.08.14) regarding relisting/reopening of cases which are pending due to non submission of information. It is decided that :-*


- The case may be relisted.*
- The project is not located in the Municipal Corporation limit hence the permission of CGWA for ground water extraction of (411 m³ / day) is accepted until the municipal water supply comes in the project area.*
- A letter along with case file should be sent to SEAC to submit the report regarding present status of the project w.r.t status of municipal water supply and construction based on site visit. A copy of the letter should be endorsed to PP.*

- (2) In response to the above the case was discussed in 198th SEAC meeting dtd 04.06.2015 and it is recorded that "

- It is a violation case as a part of the project is completed & handed over. The project proponent has provide all necessary requirements for Environment Conservation like STP, Plantation, Open Spaces, Infrastructure for reuse of treated water for flushing & horticulture. However, PP may be asked to provide more area for plantation with no. of plants & species marked on site plan, to improve STP operating efficiency one grit chamber of appropriate size, Solar heaters & street lights and effective rain water harvesting within project area.*
- The area is not yet notified under the BMC limit hence no permission for water supply has been issued by BMC. Presently using ground-water from the 5 tube-wells for which no permission has been issued by the concerned authority. No MSW storage has been provided.*
- Construction of phase II & III may not be started until EC is granted*
- Adequate land may be left for plantation & the tree may be planted this rainy season.*
- STP project may be improved to deliver treated water of targeted standards. No treated or untreated sewage may be discharged into the drain & land available adjacent to its boundary or railway line side. All outlets on their side towards railway track may be closed permanently no MSW may be disposed/thrown on open land towards railway track.*
- They be considered for recommending the grant of EC after the written commitment given by PP and all necessary document as stated above are submitted & found acceptable by SEAC.*


(3) **The case was discussed in depth and it is decided that :-**


- (i). MS, MPPCB vide letter no. 2856 dtd 29.04.15 has informed that credible action has been initiated in the CJM, Court, Bhopal on 20.03.15. He should be asked to submit a copy of site visit report, photographs and relevant documents, conducted at the time of initiating the credible action against PP for the said project.
- (ii). Since it is a case of violation of EIA Notification 2006, as per GoI, MoEF & CC office memorandum No. J-110131/41/2006-IA-II dtd 12.12.12 and 27.06.13 PP should submit the details of date of starting the construction work, breakup of the total built up area that has been constructed, number of units sold, the present status of the construction activity, whether it is still going on or stopped and why the construction activities have been undertaken without taking prior Environmental Clearance under EIA Notification, 2006? **PP should stop the construction activities with immediate effect and should not undertake any further construction/ development activity until Environmental Clearance is granted under EIA Notification 2006 otherwise strict action will be taken and another case of credible action shall be initiated.**
- (iii). PP should submit the Resolution (as per MoEF & CC, GoI dtd 12.12.12 & 27.06.13) duly passed in the meeting of its Board of Directors regarding violation of EIA Notification 2006.
- (iv). Once the Resolution is submitted by the PP, details of project proponent, a copy of commitment and Resolution passed in the meeting of the Board of Directors of M/S Chinara Reality Pvt. Ltd., Bhopal should be put on the website of MPSEIAA for information of all stake holders.
- (v). **PP should be called for presentation in the third week of July 2015.**

- (2) The case was discussed in SEAC meetings 86th, dtd 14.12.11, 87th dtd 07.01.12 where in PP was absent and 109th dtd 06.11.2012, 132nd dtd 14.05.13 and recommended the case for EC.

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(3) The case was discussed and it is noted that:-


- (i). The case was discussed in SEIAA meetings 140th dtd 04.07.13 and PP was asked to submit query reply latest by 31.08.2013 and 147th dtd 17.09.2013 letter was sent to MS-SEAC, Commissioner Nagar Nigam, Indore & PP for clarification on certain queries vide letter no. 1781, 1783, 1780 dtd 08.10.13 respectively.
- (ii). As per decision in 174th SEIAA meeting dtd 12.01.15 a DO letter was sent to Collector, Indore dtd. 28.02.2015 to give necessary directions to concerned authority to issue clear permission / NOCs to PP for water supply, disposal of extra treated waste water and MSW. **It is noted that no response has been received till date. It is decided that :-**
 - a. **The case is delisted as per MoEF & CC, Gol 30.10.12 & 20.08.14. On submission of information the case will be relisted for review.**
 - b. If any construction / activity is started by PP without obtaining prior EC under EIA Notification 2006, the provisions of MoEF Gol O.M. dtd. 12.12.12 & 27.06.13 regarding violation of EIA Notification 2006 shall be attracted and PP shall be solely responsible for it and liable for legal action.
 - c. A copy of letter should be sent to Project Proponent, MoEF & CC Gol, New Delhi & Regional Office Bhopal, Member Secretary MPPCB, Secretary SEAC, District Collector-Indore, Commissioner Nagar Nigam-Indore/CEO Zila Panchayat and all concerned.
 - d. Commissioner Nagar Nigam, Indore may be directed to examine whether the building permission has been issued or not. If Building permission has been issued and work has started on the site, PP may be accordingly advised to get EC. If building permission has not been granted, PP may be asked the copy of the EC before proceeding for statutory permission.

11. **Case No. 670/2012** - Prior Environmental Clearance for **Barahia Limestone Mine** in an area of 7.102 ha. for production capacity 30,000 TPA at **Village-Barahia, Teh-Maihar, Dist-Stana (MP)** by M/s K.J. 
