- (1) The case was discussed in 222nd SEIAA meeting dtd 27.07.2015 and it is recorded that "After detailed discussion and perusal of the recommendations of 204th SEAC meeting dtd. 04.07.2015, PP should be invited for a detailed presentation."

- (2) After deliberations by PP the case was discussed in depth and it is noted that :-
- (i). The project pertains to development of an Industrial Estate in a plot area of 679 ha located in 8 villages viz. Mohasa, Madhavan, Jhasar seth, Goradiamoti, Peelikharar, Chaplasar, Makodia, Sanghakheda Kala covered under Babai Tehsil of Hoshangabad district.,(M.P.). The land was transferred to MPAKVN, Bhopal in July 2012 for industrial development.
 - (ii). The project includes Industrial area development of Agro based food processing unit, Textile (Yarn manufacturing based on cotton fibre), Bottling & multi product. The project envisages development of amenities viz. water supply, power, waste water treatment facilities, solid waste management facilities, road network, strengthening of social infrastructure in the vicinity areas under CSR etc.
 - (iii). There is no National park / Sanctuaries, Eco-sensitive areas (Chief Wildlife Warden letter dtd 29.10.14), critically polluted areas and inter-State boundaries within 10 km of the proposed site, hence, general conditions are not attracted.
 - (iv). The proposed Industrial estate is of area more than 500 ha and not housing any industry belonging to Category A or B i.e. only those industries shall come up in the proposed industrial estate which are not covered under the provisions of EIA Notification, 2006. Thus the project falls under 7(c), B Category of the Schedule of EIA Notification issued by the Ministry of Environment & Forests vide S.O.1533 (E) dtd.14.09.06 & its amendments. **It is decided that following industries should not be allowed in the proposed industrial area :-**
 - a. The activities covered under Category A and / or B as specified under the Schedule of EIA Notification 2006.
 - b. Highly polluting and hazardous industries and prohibited industries as per the परिशिष्ट – ए एवं बी of the म. प्र. राज्य औद्योगिक भूमि एवं भवन प्रबंधन-नियम 2015.
 - (v). The case was discussed in SEAC meetings 163rd dtd. 24.12.14 & 204th dtd 04.07.15 and is recommended for grant of prior EC subject to 05 special conditions.
 - (vi). The total project land area is 1678.73 acres (679 ha). PP has submitted copy of order from GoMP, Department of Commerce, Industry & Employment dtd. 27.07.12 and Collector, Hoshangabad order dtd. 28.09.12 regarding land allotment. As per the order, Babai Agro farm unit 4, 5 & 6 land 1678.73 acres (679 ha) has been transferred for industrial use and possession has been given to AKVN, Bhopal (letter 6116 dtd 09.11.12 from District Trade & Industry Centre, Hoshangabad).
 - (vii). Public Hearing was conducted at the proposed project site Village Mohasa, Tehsil Babai, District Hoshangabad (MP) on 04.04.2015 under Chairmanship of Add. Collector, Hoshangabad District



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Hoshangabad (M.P.). Some issues regarding ownership of land, vocational training to the nearby community, employment to local people and fear of pollution emanating from the establishment of the industrial area were raised during the Public Hearing which were addressed by PP.

- (viii). The total water requirement is 23.0 MLD (Industrial demand: 17.92 MLD + Domestic water demand 5.09 MLD). About 33% of the total water demand will be met by recycling of water. The source of water supply is Narmada River flowing at a distance of 8 km from the site. PP has proposed an intake well of 5 MGD capacity and water treatment plant of 23 MLD. PP has submitted letter dtd 11.06.13 from EE, Water Resource Department for supply of 5.0 MGD water.
- (ix). Assuming 60% of the total water utilization, the estimated industrial waste water generation from individual units is 6.0 MLD. PP has proposed that the individual unit holders shall be required to install zero discharge mechanism involving Multi Effect Evaporators (MEE) followed by sludge dryers and shall also take extra land to utilize effluent in plantation to ensure 100% recycle of the treated waste water. Domestic waste water (4.0 MLD) will be treated in STP (4.0 MLD). Treated water (3.6 MLD) from STP outlet will be utilized for plantation purpose. Thus, achieving Zero Liquid Discharge. **It is decided that PP should :-**
- a. **Ensure zero effluent discharge from the individual units and as well as from the industrial estate.**
 - b. **As recommended by SEAC (204th dtd 04.07.15) PP should provide space for common ETP for future use.**
 - c. **The location of ETP & STP should be away from the existing Nalla and flood prone zone.**
 - d. **PP should ensure channelization of the Nalla and provide 15 m wide buffer zone on both sides of the Nalla.**
- (x). The solid waste (biodegradable) is proposed to be composted and used as manure. The non-biodegradable waste like paper, plastic, glass etc. will be sold to authorized recyclers. The hazardous waste like waste oil, ETP sludge, etc. will be collected and disposed off to the common hazardous waste disposal facility offsite as per Hazardous Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 1989. **It is decided that :-**
- a. **Provide compactors for Solid Waste**
 - b. **Ensure three bin system for segregated collection of waste.**
 - c. **PP should provide incinerator with suitable pollution control equipments for disposal of solid waste.**
 - d. **PP should obtain authorization from MPPCB regarding hazardous waste disposal.**
 - e. **PP should ensure disposal of hazardous waste/ by products regularly through sale or in TSDF site and there should be no dumping of these materials in the premises/outside.**

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- f. PP should ensure handling, disposal and management of hazardous waste as per the related prescribed rules.
- (xi). Bio Medical waste will be generated from Health Centre which is proposed to be collected as per the Bio Medical waste handling and management rules and handed over to authorized agency. **It is decided that, Bio Medical Waste (Handling and management) rules should be followed strictly for the disposal of bio medical waste.**
- (xii). For control of air pollution PP has proposed the following:
- a. Vehicles carrying raw materials would be covered by water proof sheets, dust suppression by water sprinkling on earthworks and transportation routes. **It is decided that PP should provide fogging system for dust suppression.**
 - b. Sufficient height of exhausts of DG set's for proper dispersal of exhaust emissions. **It is decided that PP should ensure installation of DG sets with canopy and the stack height should be as per the MPPCB norms.**
 - c. Regular monitoring of air pollution and noise levels on site and nearby receptors to ensure compliance with CPCB prescribed standards during day and night time. **It is decided that PP should install continuous air quality monitoring station in coordination with MPPCB.**
- (xiii). The internal power supply requirement is proposed to be met with 10 MVA through 2 no of electric substations of 5 MVA each. The two substations would be fed from existing 132/33 KV substation at Gujarwada located at a distance of 20.5 km by 33 KV power supply line. PP has submitted Madhya Pradesh Madhya Kshetra Vidyut Vitaran Company Limited (MPMKVVCL) for 33 KV power supply and internal distribution of 11 KV network from Gujarwada Sub-station. **It is decided that PP should ensure installation of photovoltaic cells (solar energy) for lighting in common areas, LED light fixtures, and other energy efficient plant machineries and equipments.**
- (xiv). PP has proposed Rainwater harvesting structures to collect and reuse the rain water for green area development and also to feed into the sub-soil so as to raise the ground water level. **It is decided that PP should ensure the rain water harvesting. In addition, PP should provide recharging trenches. The base of the trenches should be Kachha with pebbles.**
- (xv). PP has proposed phased development of surface car and truck parking, adequate provision of lighting & security. **It is decided that PP should ensure the traffic movement plan, parking facilities and road width.**
- (xvi). PP has included disaster management plan, fire fighting provisions as part of EIA. **It is decided that PP should :-**

- a. Prepare the onsite & offsite risk / disaster management plan, health and safety management plan and duly approved by the Competent Authority.
 - b. Provide Fire station within the industrial area.
- (xvii). PP has proposed Green belt of 5 m (two row plantations) to be developed all along the periphery of the industrial area, major roads & between residential and industrial area. **It is decided that :-**
 - a. PP should develop 15 m wide green belt with four rows of trees all along the periphery.
 - b. The plant specie selection should be as per CPCB guidelines for plantation in industrial area.
 - c. Besides, as proposed by PP 28% of the land under open area and 25m of buffer area along the natural drain passing through the site should be maintained as green area.
 - d. Every effort should be made to conserve the existing cluster of the tree groves in the project area.
- (xviii). Under the CSR activities PP should ensure :-
 - a. Total sanitation in the villages within 5 km radius of the site.
 - b. PP has mentioned that in the vicinity villages the education infrastructure is poor. PP should ensure strengthening of infrastructure in schools located in village within 5 km radius.
 - c. Regular health checkups / camps for the workers and villagers in the vicinity areas.
 - d. Vocational training for employment to the local people for skilled / semi-skilled jobs.
 - e. PP should ensure employment to the local village population for unskilled jobs.
- (3) It is decided to accept the recommendations of 204th SEAC meeting dtd 04.07.15 with 05 special conditions and accord prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed Industrial Area Development Project at Tehsil-Babai, District-Hoshangabad, (M.P.) Plot area: 1678.73 acres (679 ha) by Mr. Sarkar, General Manager, Madhya Pradesh Audyogik Kendra Vikas Nigam, 1st Floor, Tawa Complex, Bittan Market, E-5, Arera Colony, Bhopal **subject to all specific conditions imposed by SEIAA in its meetings.**

 - (1) The case was discussed in 218th in SEIAA meeting dtd 14.07.2015 and it is recorded that "After perusal of the recommendation of 200th SEAC meeting dtd 30.06.2015 PP may be asked for presentation. They should submit T & CP permission, details of final mode of disposal of waste water, clear NOC for disposal of waste water, MSW, Bio-Medical & hazardous waste, energy conservation, road


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

widths, landscape plan with area and details of number and species of trees to be planted, circulation plan for firefighting tender, parking plan and other details as per MoEF & CC, Gol office memorandum dtd 19.06.2013."

- (2) It was informed by PP that their Environment Consultant is not present for the presentation and requested for extension of time. **It is decided that PP should come for presentation along with the Consultant on 25.08.2015.**
3. **Case No.1369/2013** Prior Environment Clearance for **Manganese Ore Mine** (Opencast other than fully mechanized method) in an area of 8.09 ha for Expansion in Production Capacity from 1200 TPA to 5000 TPA at Khasra No. 747 at Village - Jam, Tehsil - Katangi, Distt. - Balaghat (M.P.) by Smt N D Updhyay, PO at Tirodi, Distt. - Balaghat (M.P.) - 481449
- (1) It was noted that the prior EC issued to PP vide SEIAA letter No. 36/EPCO-SEIAA/09 dtd 07.05.2009 in the same mining lease area and being the case of expansion of production capacity from 1200 TPA to 5000 TPA, the PP applied for afresh Prior EC.
- (2) The case was recommended in 196th SEAC meeting dtd. 02.06.2015 with 07 specific conditions.
- (3) The discussed in 222nd SEIAA meeting dtd 27.07.2015 , thereafter, the PP made prsentation and all concerned issues were discussed in detail.
- (4) It was noted that the inter-state boundary, National Park/Sanctuary are not located within 10 Km. radius. Hence, the **General Condition is not attracted.**
- (5) It was noted that the mining plan is approved by the IBM (vide letter no. BGT/Mn/MPLN – 717/ NHP dtd. 12.03.2009. As per mine plan the life of mine is 11 years.
- (6) The proposed plantation program was examined and it was found that **3.2 ha** area shall be covered under plantation and 5000 trees shall be planted at the end of lease period. The plantation program was found satisfactory.
- (7) It was noted that the water requirement is 08 KLD (04 KLD for Dust Supression + 02 KLD for Green Belt + 02 KLD for Domestic purpose), it will be met by the groundwater and mine pit water.
- (8) It was noted that the Public Hearing was held on 15.07.2014 at Mine Parisar, Village - Jam, Tehsil - Katangi, Distt. – Balaghat (M.P.) under the Chairmanship of DM, Balaghat. The issues raised during public hearing were of general nature and nothing adverse was found regarding degradation of the environment.
- (9) After detailed discussions and perusal of recommendations of 196th SEAC meeting dtd 02.06.2015, presentation made by the PP in SEIAA & SEAC, it **was decided to accept the recommendation of SEAC for grant of prior EC to the project subject to the following specific conditions:**
- I. Water fogging arrangment on haul roads, loading and unloading and transfer point shall be provided and properly maintained.
 - II. The PP shall construct 06 settling tanks along the length of the garland drain. The settling tank capacity shall be so fixed as to allow adequate retention period for proper settling of silt material.

- III. Regular removal of the settled silt from the settling tank should be ensured.
- IV. Ambient air quality shall be monitored quarterly and the report of the same be submitted to MPPCB.
- V. The PP shall undertake the following activities in nearby villages on priority and made separate budget provisions under the CSR for these activities:
 - a) Sanitation activities including construction of toilets in consultation with village Panchayat.
 - b) Installation of rainwater harvesting structure.
 - a) Plantation of fruit bearing plants in nearby villages.
- VI. Individual health cards will be issued to the villagers of Arjuni tola and mine workers including women and children. Every three months, the card holders will be examined in a health camp specially lung function test etc. (to be organized by PP) in consultation with the local panchayat.

Hence, Prior Environmental Clearance is granted for **Manganese Ore Mine** (Opencast other than fully mechanized method) in an area of 8.09 ha for Expansion in Production Capacity from 1200 TPA to 5000 TPA at Khasra No. 747 at Village - Jam, Tehsil - Katangi, Distt. - Balaghat (M.P.), **for the lease period to M Smt N D Updhyay, PO at Tirodi, Distt. - Balaghat (M.P.) - 481449**

- (1) After detailed discussion and perusal of the recommendation of 205th SEAC meeting dtd. 20.07.2015, it was decided to grant Prior Environmental Clearance with slight modifications in the conditions imposed by SEAC.
 - (i) PP shall not start mining activity before execution of lease agreement.
 - (i) The average depth of the pit shall not exceed 2.0m or water level whichever is less.
 - (ii) The Hon'ble NGT (CZ) Bhopal by order dated 20.07.2015 in the case OA No. 49/2015 (Amarkant Mishra Vs State of MP & 3 others), has stayed the order dated 30.06.2015 passed by the MRD, Govt. of M.P. regarding the extension of sand mining up to 31st July. (1) After detailed discussion and perusal of the recommendation of 205th SEAC meeting dtd. 20.07.2015, it was decided to grant Prior Environmental Clearance with slight modifications in the conditions imposed by SEAC.

- (i) PP shall not start mining activity before execution of lease agreement.
- (ii) The average depth of the pit shall not exceed 6.0m at the end of lease period and not beyond that.

- (ii) The average depth of the pit shall not exceed 1.0m or water level whichever is less.


