
This case was discussed in the 206th SEIAA meeting dtd. 08.06.2015 and it was reported that :-


".....(5) It was noted that regarding production capacity the SEAC in its 183rd meeting dtd. 27.04.2015 has recorded**"production of Limestone shall be as per the mining plan not exceeding 50000 T /Year"** while in Form-1 and Mining Plan the expansion in production capacity is proposed from 50000 T /Year to 4,00,000 T/year. **It is decided to ask from SEAC to clarify about the anomaly in production capacity and inform accordingly.**

(6) It is decided to direct SNS Minerals to start back filling in their mined out area immediately and regarding common buffer zone SNS Minerals shall contribute in creation of common buffer zone with Bhatara Limestone mine."

Regarding Point No. 5 SEAC in its 210th meeting dtd. 25.07.2015 has clarified that the production capacity as per approved mining plan should not exceed 4.0 lakh ton/year. Regarding Point No. 6 PP has informed that the backfilling has already started and shall be completed by Dec. 2015 as the mining operation in the said mines are discontinued due to rains. PP should submit a month wise backfilling
