1. **Case No. 714/2013** Prior Environment Clearance for proposed development of additional tankage for MS & ATF and Tank Truck Loading Facility at existing IOCL terminal at Bangrod, District Ratlam by Shri D.M. Nimje, Dy. General Manager (Operations) Indian Oil Corporation, M.P. State Office, 16, Arera Hills, Jail Road, Bhopal (M.P.) – 462011, Ph. No. 0755-2524800, Email subratatb@indianoil.in, Environment Consultant Shriram Institute for Industrial Research, Delhi.

- (1) The project pertains to the proposed additional tankage for MS & ATF and Tank Truck Loading Facility at existing IOCL terminal at Bangrod, District Ratlam. – 462011. The project proponent is Shri D.M. Nimje, Dy. General Manager (Operations) Indian Oil Corporation, M.P. State Office, 16, Arera Hills, Jail Road, Bhopal (M.P.).
- (2) Major Activities of Existing and proposed IOCL Terminal at Bangrod (Ratlam) are as follows :-

- (3) Earlier prior Environmental Clearance was granted by MoEF & CC vide letter No. J-11011/69/2005-IA II (I), dated 17.05.2006. PP has submitted compliance report of earlier prior EC certified by MoEF & CC Regional Office, Bhopal (dtd. 18.08.2015). As per the report the implementation of environmental safeguards are found satisfactory and complied whereas some compliances are not complied up to the mark as stipulated. PP has been advised to take care for conditions like environmental management, green belt development, social upliftment and community development plans and regular safety audits and also the submission of the report of the risk analysis/ uploading of six monthly compliance report as per stipulation.
- (4) There is no interstate boundary within 10 km and no National Park / Sanctuary within the 5 km of the project area hence the general conditions are not attracted.
- (5) The ToR were issued to PP by SEAC (vide letter no. 616 dtd 25.09.2012) and EIA was submitted by PP (vide letter dtd 12.08.2014).
- (6) Public Hearing was held on 18.02.2014 at project site IOCL Terminal at village Bagrod, District Ratlam under the Chairmanship of Joint Collector District Ratlam.
- (7) The case was discussed in SEAC meetings 98th dtd. 23.07.2012, 132nd dtd. 14.05.2013, 136th dtd 23.07.2013, 149th dtd. 05.09.2014, 150th dtd 26.09.2014, 164th dtd. 07.01.2015 and 223rd dtd 15.09.2015 and project is recommended for grant of prior EC subject to 11 special conditions.
- (8) The case was considered in 247th SEIAA dtd 07.10.2015 and call for presentation on 30.10.2015.



- (9) After deliberations by PP, the case was discussed in depth & it is noted that:
- (i). The total existing area of the project is 35.17 ha. Out of this PP has submitted notarized copy of Khasra Panchsala 2011-2012 for the land 31.410 ha and also submitted Collector, Ratlam allotment order dtd 14.08.2008 for the area 3.780 ha.
 - (ii). The total water requirement is 11 MLD (Domestic-5 MLC, Gardining-5 MLD & Hydrant Tank-1 MLD). The source of water for the project is ground water. PP has submitted acknowledgement no. 21-4(140) NCR/CGWA dtd. 03.12.12 for extraction of ground water.
 - (iii). The waste water generated 3.8 KLD from terminal and PP has proposed oil water separator (OWS) to treat effluent from the terminal. Domestic waste water (3.5 KLD) will be disposed of through septic tank followed by soak pit.
 - (iv). Hazardous waste generation from cleaning of storage tanks reported to be once in five years. The waste is being disposed off through CTSDf. PP has obtained Membership from RAMKY, Pithampur, Dhar for disposal of Hazardous Waste.
 - (v). The total power requirement is 1000 KVA. The source of electricity is M. P. Pashcim Khhetra Vidyut Vitran Co. Ltd. PP has also provided power back up 2 nos. DG sets of 500 KVA & 1 no. of 200 KVA.
 - (vi). PP has proposed 38700 sq.m. to be developed as green area along the periphery of the terminal.
 - (vii). Under Corporate Social Responsibility PP has proposed construction of toilets for girls schools in Bangrod & Ratlam.
- (10) It is decided to accept the recommendations of 223rd SEAC meeting dtd. **15.09.2015 with 11 special conditions and accord prior Environmental Clearance** to proposed development of additional tankage for MS & ATF and Tank Truck Loading Facility at existing IOCL terminal at Bangrod, District Ratlam by Shri D.M. Nimje, Dy. General Manager (Operations) Indian Oil Corporation, M.P. State Office, 16, Arera Hills, Jail Road, Bhopal (M.P.) **subject to following specific conditions imposed by SEIAA :-**
- (i). PP should ensure the implementation of the observations of MOEF & CC RO, Bhopal report dtd 18.08.2015.
 - (ii). Adequate buffer zone around the tank age facilities, as may be required as per IOCL or other statutory requirements.
 - (iii). VOC and HC shall be regularly monitored in the work zone in the plant along with other parameters and data shall be submitted to MPPCB and R.O. of MoEF.
 - (iv). The company shall construct garland drain all around the project site to prevent runoff of any oil containing waste into the nearby water bodies. Separate drainage shall be created for oil contaminated and non-oil contaminated streams. During rainy seasons, the storm water drains shall be connected to oil water separator and passed


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
through guard pond. Water quality monitoring of guard pond shall be conducted.


- (v). The project authorities shall comply with the provision made in Manufacture, storage and Import of Hazardous Chemicals Rules 1989, as amended and the Public Liability Insurance Trans – boundary Movement) Rules 2008.
- (vi). Company shall obtain all requisite clearance for fire safety and explosives and shall comply with the stipulations made by the respective authorities.
- (vii). Green area including thick green-belt shall be developed in at least 33% of the plot area to mitigate the effect of fugitive emissions all around the plant in consultation with the forest department as per the guidelines of CPCB.
PP should ensure to provide two rows of thick canopy trees along the right side boundary wall (opposite to administrative building and the missing portion on the left side of the boundary wall)
- (viii). All recommendations mentioned in the EMP/ DMP shall be binding for the project authorities.
- (ix). Dedicated parking facility for loading and unloading of material shall be provided in the plant. Management shall develop and implement god traffic management system for incoming and outgoing vehicles to avoid congestion on public road.
- (x). Occupational health surveillance of worker should be done on a regular basis and maintained as per the Factory Act.
- (xi). The project authorities shall comply with the provision made in Manufacture, storage and Import of Hazardous Chemicals Rules 1989, as amended and the Public Liability Insurance Trans – boundary Movement) Rules 2008.
- (xii). PP should ensure the implementation of above CSR activities on regular basis. PP should also made budgetary provision for health, education, water and sanitation etc. in and around the project area.
- (xiii). PP should prepare off-site and on-site emergency plans and carry out mock drills in consultations and coordination with the District Administration and as per safety rules of the Industrial Health and Safety.
- (xiv). All other conditions as laid in the earlier EC and the consents of MPPCB shall be applicable.


