

"Later on in 169th SEAC meeting dated 27/01/15 it was recommended that as PP has not submitted the desired information since long and assuming that the proponents of this projects is not interested to continue with their projects the case was recommended for rejection / delisting. The six cases was discussed in 229th SEAC meeting dated 01.10.2015 and it was observed that :-


"Being defaulter cases, it is clear that PP ignored the provisions of Environment Protection in these projects not only at planning stage but also at the construction stage. These six projects are not meeting most of the norms set for Environment Protection. Moreover, it is extremely difficult to implement environment Protection measures at this advance stage of completion of these projects. In view of the above, these six cases may not be recommended for grant of EC MPSEIAA may be recommended to issue directions to stop all construction & development activities with immediate effect. An advertisement stating the decision in these cases, may be given in local News Papers in the larger public interest.

The site inspection report of the sub-committee, response from the PP to the quarries and subsequent comments and recommendations made by the subcommittee were placed before the committee. After discussions & deliberations committee, while agreeing with the recommendations of the sub-committee, decided that in the view of the recommendations made by the sub-committee these above six cases (2335/15, 2336/15, 2337/15, 2338/15, 2339/15 & 2340/15) cannot be recommended for grant of Environmental clearance at this stage."


The above observation of SEAC recommendations were discussed. Since the violation cases, in view of the NGT order quashing the MoEF & CC, Gol Office Memorandum dated 12.12.2012 & 27.06.2013 and its subsequent stay by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, MoEF & CC, Gol has to issue fresh guidelines in further scrutinizing the cases which were stalled in SEIAA. Meanwhile in the above cases, the policy directions as per 204th SEIAA meeting dtd 30.05.2015 in this regard are as follows :-

"It is decided that the SEAC / SEIAA should follow the above procedure strictly and in such cases SEAC should visit the site to assess the construction/ development activities already done at site, whether the construction is continued or stopped. SEAC should also ascertain whether the construction activity have been under taken as per the conditions of Town & Country Planning layout and building permission or not and if there is any deviation. Thereafter the case should be appraised and clear recommendation be given accordingly."

Each case needs to be appraised separately and succinctly as per the provisions enumerated as per the Office Memorandum dated 19.06.2013 which is self explanatory and also guides the environmental aspects to be covered in each and every case. The recommendation of the SEAC falls short of these guidelines. Therefore, it has been decided to return the case and direct SEAC to appraise each case individually and give its recommendations separately for each case.

After detailed discussion and perusal of the query response of 245nd SEIAA meeting dtd. 30.09.2015 & recommendation of 187th SEAC meeting dtd. 01.05.2015, PP has submitted the letter of Collector Rajgarh in which it is mentioned that the Dam site is 225m. from the leased area. It was decided to grant Prior Environmental Clearance subject to the following specific conditions in addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC

- (i) PP shall not start mining activity before execution of lease agreement.
- (ii) The depth of the pit shall not exceed 6.0 m. at the end of lease period and not beyond that.
- (iii) Before commencing any mining activity, the demarcation should be done in the presence of Mining Officer, Revenue and Works Department. No mining activity will be carried out in 225m distance from the proposed Dam.

Hence, Prior Environmental Clearance is granted for **Basalt Stone & Murrum Quarry (Opencast Semi – Mechanized Method)** in an area of 4.00 ha. for production capacity of **Basalt Stone** 44263 cum/year & **Murrum** 14754 cum/year (as per SEAC recommendation) at Khasra nos.291/4/10, 291/4/13 at Village – Mundla, Tehsil.- Rajgarh, Distt.-Rajgarh (MP) **for the lease period** to M/s Agroh Infrastructures Developers Pvt. Ltd. CEO, Shri Neeraj Agrawal CEO, Aqua Point, Old AB Road, Village-Umaria Mhow, Distt -Indore (M.P.)-453441.

Case No. 1681/2013** – Prior Environment Clearance for **Limestone mine** (Opencast Manual / Semi-Mechanized Method) in area of 3.670 ha at Khasra No. 185, 185, 187, 188, 183/2, 187/1, Village - Devsari, Tehsil-Vijayraghavgarh, Distt.-Katni (M.P.) by Shri Jaheer Ahamed, M/s Ismile & Sons, Mission Chowk, District-Katni (M.P.) - 483501

PP has made a representation that the case which was delisted as per the decision taken in 146th SEIAA meeting dtd. 12.09.13, wherein it was reported as:-

"In view of MoEF, GoI EIA Notification S. O. 2731 (E) dtd 09.09.2013 it is decided that the 4 cases of major mineral with lease area less than 5 ha mentioned at S. No. 7 to 10 of the above table be delisted. It is also decided that other cases registered under this category will also be delisted"

PP has further submitted that in the light of the judgment of NGT on Case No. 123/2014 passed on 31.01.2015 that mining leases of less than 5 ha. have to obtain EC from SEIAA, the ToR issued by SEAC before it was delisted in SEIAA, PP has prepared EIA and would like to relist the case. After detail discussions, it was decided that the case be relisted and returned to SEAC for appraisal of the case. SEAC should also examine whether it is necessary to issue revised ToR as the data must have been old and redundant. It is also noticed that PP must have started mining activity at the given site, therefore before appraising EIA, consents issued by MPPCB and its ramifications should also be considered by SEAC. 

Case No. 2177/2014 - Prior Environment Clearance for **Stone Quarry** (Opencast Manual / Semi-Mechanized Method) in an area of 1.00 ha for production capacity of 10920 TPA at Khasra No. 405/1 at Village-Lathgaon, Tehsil-Gotegaon, District-Narsinghpur by Shri Sanjay Kumar Singhvi S/o Shri Gyanchand Singhvi, Kamat Ward, Post & Tehsil-Gotegaon, District-Narsinghpur (MP)-487118

(A) In the minutes of 216th SEIAA meeting dtd. 07.07.2015, the above case has been formatted as **Case No. 2117/2014**, however, after verification from the Form-1, this case has been registered as Case No. 2177/2014. This correction should be made while issuing the EC.

(B) In the same case, the EC has been granted for production capacity of 10920 cum/year. However, after verification of the record this should have been 10920 TPA (4550 cum/year). While issuing EC, this correction should be made.

20. Case No. 2291/2014 - Prior Environmental Clearance for **Metal Stone Quarry** (Opencast Manual/ Semi Mechanized Method) in an area of 2.00 ha. for production capacity 44460 cum/year (**as per mining plan**) at Khasra no. 143/1, 143/2 at Vill. Panjira Tehsil- Narsinghpur, District- Narsinghpur (M.P) by Smt. Anita Patel through Shri V.S. Patel, R/o 24, Sai Villa, Ganga Nagar Colony, Jabalpur, District - Jabalpur (MP) – 483002.

In the minutes of 224th SEIAA meeting dtd. 10.08.2015 and original recommendation of SEAC 177th dtd. 23.03.2015 and its revision in 199th SEAC dtd. 21.06.2015. While examining this case during 224th SEIAA meeting, the original recommendation of 177th SEAC was put-up and the decision thus taken. However it came to the notice at a later stage that SEAC has revised their recommendations in 199th SEAC meeting. The PP has made a representation before SEIAA to rectify the mistake. After detailed discussion, it was decided to grant **corrected Prior Environmental Clearance** subject to the following specific conditions in addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC

- (i) PP shall not start mining activity before execution of lease agreement.
- (ii) The depth of the pit shall not exceed 12 m. (as per SEAC recommendation) at the end of lease period and not beyond that.
- (iii) Since the depth is more than 6 m., Mine Safety Rules shall be invoked in this case. PP should obtained NOC from Director, Mine Safety before commencing the mining activity.

Hence, Prior Environmental Clearance is granted for **Metal Stone Quarry** (Opencast Manual/ Semi-Mechanized Method) in an area of 2.00 ha. for production capacity 44460 cum/year (as per mining plan) at Khasra no. 143/1, 143/2 at Village-Panjira Tehsil- Narsinghpur, District- Narsinghpur (MP) **for the lease period** to Smt. Anita Patel through Shri V.S. Patel, R/o 24, Sai Villa, Ganga Nagar Colony, Jabalpur, District – Jabalpur (MP) – 483002.
