- (i) The proposed project is Bulk Drug Intermediate Manufacturing production unit comprises expansion and modification in an existing unit. The existing unit was established in 2005. Hence, Environmental Clearance was not required. The existing production capacity is 155 MTPA, which was issued with Air and Water Consent for the production of 16 APIs of which the production of four APIs have been stopped. The proposed and existing product are as follows:

- (ii) The proposed project is covered under 5 (f) category (B) of the schedule of EIA Notification issued by the Ministry of Environment & Forests vide S.O.1533 (E), dtd. 14.09.2006, hence is required to obtain prior EC.
- (iii) There is no interstate boundary within 10 km and no National Park / Sanctuary within the 5 km of the project area hence the general conditions are not attracted.
- (iv) The project is located in notified Industrial area Pithampur, Distt. – Dhar (M.P.), hence as per Gol, MoEF OM dtd 10.12.14 Public hearing is exempted.
- (v) The total land area of the project is 79819 sq. m. PP has submitted notarized copy of lease deed for land area 53909 sq.m.
- (vi) The total water requirement (Existing + Proposed Expansion) is 175.5 KLD (Fresh Water 130.5 KLD + Recycled 45.0 KLD). The source of water supply is AKVN. PP has submitted agreement dtd. 03.05.2006 between MPAKVN, Indore and M/s UNICHEM Laboratories Ltd, Pithampur Dhar.
- (vii) The total existing waste water generation is 31 KLD (26 KLD effluent + 5KLD sewage) and after expansion it will be 70 KLD (31 KLD existing + 29KLD effluent 10 KLD sewage). PP has proposed augmentation of the existing effluent treatment Plant of 40 KLD capacity to 90 KLD capacities. PP has proposed "Zero effluent discharge" from the unit. The total treated waste water is 45 KLD and is proposed to be used in green belt development. The ETP sludge is proposed to be filter press and evaporated in Multiple Effect Evaporator (MEE). PP has also proposed solvent recovery system upto 96% efficiency. While SEAC has recommended to increase solvent recovery efficiency upto 99%. PP has submitted copy of renewal of consents upto 28.02.2014 issued by MPPCB; dtd. 06.09.11 under water Act. **It is decided that :-**
 - a. **PP should reduce the chloride contents by adopting proper pollution control measures to fit for proper land use.**
 - b. **PP should conduct performance study of existing ETP**
 - c. **PP should ensure to solvent recovery efficiency upto 99%.**
- (4) The expected air emission from the product are HCL gas, CO², gas, ammonia gas, hydrogen gas, SO₂, Methylamine etc. For control of air pollution PP has proposed wet alkali (caustic) based scrubber and wet water based scrubber. For control of air pollution from boiler & DG sets, PP has proposed to provide suitable stack height as per CPCB norms to ensure proper dispersion of gases; PP has also submitted copy of renewal of consents up to 28.02.2014 issued by MPPCB; dtd. 06.09.2011 under Air Act.
- (5) For disposal of hazardous waste, PP has proposed to dispose spent oil through authorized re-processors/refiners registered with

CPCB/MPPCB and other hazardous waste is proposed to be incinerated or sent to common TSDF site Ramky, Pithampur, Dhar near Indore.

- (6) For firefighting measure PP has proposed to provide fire extinguishers, hydrant system and sprinkler system. PP has also proposed water storage lightening arrestor and self contained breathing apparatus for controlling leakage or spillage type emergency.
- (7) PP has proposed 02 underground storage tanks for collection of rainwater.
- (8) The total power requirement in operation phase shall be 1000 KVA and DG set back-up 1no. (1x1000 KVA).
- (9) PP has proposed green belt area of 26,341 sq.m. (33% of the total plot area-existing & proposed)). 15000 sq.m. area already developed into green belt with species like Gulmohar, Karanj, Jambhool, Astumbul and Neem. **It is decided that no existing trees of the plant premises will be cut for expansion of plant and PP should ensure the plantation in additional 11341 sq.m. area by planting minimum 1000 indigenous trees. Besides this all vacant area within plant premises should be covered by planting more trees.**
- (10) Under CSR activities PP has submitted that cost allocation 1500 lacs for year 2010-2014 and 1000 lacs for year 2015- 2019 for health care facility and education.
- (11) The case was discussed and it is decided that :-
 - a. PP should submit the notarized lease deed of remaining plot area of 25910 sq.m.
 - b. PP should submit revised CSR plan in consultation with tribal training centre of Pithampur and local skilled / unskilled tribal workers should be given preference in employment in the plant.
- (12) **PP should submit the above information latest by 05.12.2015.**


2. **Case No. 1857/2014**, Prior Environmental Clearance for **Dolomite Mine** in an area of 8.094 ha (Opencast Manual / Semi-Mechanised Method) for Production Capacity of **2,50,000 TPA** at Khasra No. 49P, 51, 52 P, 53 P, 73 P, 81 P, 82 P, 83, 84P, 85, at Vill.- Gudha, Tehsil - Badwara, District - Katni (M.P.) by M/s Ujala Merchants & Traders Ltd., Dr. N.C. Mishra (Holder of Power of Attorney), R/o Kohli farm House Campus, Near Rapta Petrol Pump, Khirahni, Katni, District - Katni (M.P.) – 483501.

- (1) SEAC in its 231st meeting dtd. 27.10.2015 recommended the case for grant of prior EC with 05 special conditions.
- (2) The case was discussed in 256th SEIAA meeting dtd 04.11.2015 and it was recorded that



- (3) Thereafter, PP/Consultant made a presentation on all aspects of the project and all concerned issues were discussed in details.
- (4) It was noted that the criteria of inter-state boundary is not applicable as mining site falls in Badwara Tehsil of District - Katni, National Park/Sanctuary is not located within 10 km radius. Hence, the **General Condition is not attracted**.
- (5) Mining plan is approved by the IBM (vide letter no. MP /Katni /Dolomite /M.Sch - 43/ 2014-15 dtd. 07.11.2014).
- (6) The proposed plantation program was examined and it was found that **6750 trees** shall be planted in an area **4.5 ha** during the lease period.
- (7) It was noted that the water requirement is 16 KLD (10 KLD Dust Suppression+ 4 KLD Green Belt + 2 KLD Drinking), which shall be met from existing mine pit and proposed hand pump.
- (8) It was noted that the Public Hearing was held on 03.09.2015 at Mine Parisar, Vill. - Gudha, Tehsil - Badwara, District - Katni (M.P.) under the Chairmanship of ADM, Katni. The issues raised during public hearing were of general nature and nothing adverse was found regarding degradation of the environment.
- (9) After detailed discussions and perusal of recommendations of 231st meeting dtd. 27.10.2015, presentation made by the PP in SEIAA & SEAC, **it was decided to accept the recommendation of SEAC for grant of prior EC to the project subject to the following specific conditions:**
 - I. A water body (nallah) is in existence about 150 meters in ML area. PP should carryout extensive plantation towards water body.
 - II. Before commencing any mining activity, a buffer zone shall be demarcated in the periphery of mining lease area and fencing of the entire area shall be carried out. There should be no opening towards forest area.
 - III. Plants shall be planted in pit size of 2x2x2 foot and the pit should be filled with black cotton soil and manure.
 - IV. Four rows of 2000 plants shall be planted in the first year and proper arrangements of water should be made for the plantation by developing a dedicated pipeline in the periphery of mining area.
 - V. An alternate Pakka road up to the Village shall be developed and maintained by PP, so as to minimize the emission of particulate matters and reduce the air pollution in the surrounding area. Mining shall not commence at the site till the alternate route is provided for the villagers.
 - VI. The commitment made by the PP regarding CSR activities and afforestation plan should be implemented in content and spirit.
 - VII. Under CSR activity in addition to the proposed activities following activities should be added.
 - a) The Culvert on the Guda – Badgawan road shall be constructed in consultation with Gram Panchayat and Local Administration. PP may either construct it or provide fund to the Gram Panchayat/ Local Administration for the construction.

 - c) Sanitation activities including construction of individual toilets in consultation with Village Panchayat of Guda and Badgawan.
 - d) Installation of rainwater harvesting structure.
 - e) Up-gradation of School at Village Guda and Badgawan.
- VIII. PP should estimate the cost to meet out the provisions earmarked in the above additional proposed CSR after consulting the concerned agencies and submit a copy in SEIAA.

- (1) SEAC in its 231st meeting dtd. 27.10.2015 recommended the case for grant of prior EC with 02 special conditions.

- (2) The case was discussed in 256th SEIAA meeting dtd 04.11.2015 and it was recorded that

"After detail discussion and perusal of the recommendations of 231st SEAC meeting dtd. 27.10.2015, PP should be invited for detail presentation."

- (3) Thereafter, PP/Consultant made a presentation on all aspects of the project and all concerned issues were discussed in details.

- (4) It was noted that the criteria of inter-state boundary is not applicable as mining site falls in Badwara Tehsil of District - Katni, National Park/Sanctuary is not located within 10 km radius. Hence, the **General Condition is not attracted**.


- (5) Mining plan is approved by the IBM (vide letter no. MP/Katni/Dolomite/M.Sch-80/2014-15 dtd. 09.02.2015).


- (6) The proposed plantation program was examined and it was found that **1125 trees** shall be planted in an area **0.75 ha** during the lease period.

- (7) After detailed discussions and perusal of recommendations of 231st meeting dtd. 27.10.2015, presentation made by the PP in SEIAA & SEAC, **it was decided to accept the recommendation of SEAC for grant of prior EC to the project subject to the following specific conditions:**

- I. Before commencing any mining activity, a buffer zone of 22.5 m shall be demarcated towards habitation and develop a thick green belt in it.
- II. Fencing shall be carried out in the periphery of mining lease area.

- III. Plants shall be planted in pit size of 2x2x2 foot and the pit should be filled with black cotton soil.
- IV. An existing kachha road of about 600 meters which will be used for the transportation of minerals be made Pakka Road and maintained by the PP.
- V. The commitment made by the PP regarding CSR activities and afforestation plan should be implemented in content and spirit.
- VI. Under CSR activity in addition to the proposed activities following activities should be added.
 - a) Skill upgradation programme for the villagers of nearby villages.
 - b) Sanitation activities including construction of individual toilets in consultation with village Panchayat.
 - c) Installation of rainwater harvesting structure.
 - d) Up-gradation of School building at nearby Village.
- VII. PP should estimate the cost to meet out the provisions earmarked in the above additional proposed CSR after consulting the concerned agencies and submit a copy in SEIAA.

After detailed discussion and perusal of the recommendations of 222nd SEAC meeting dtd.28.08.2015 and query response to 242th SEIAA meeting dtd. 24.09.2015, it was decided to grant Prior Environmental Clearance subject to the following specific conditions in addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC.

- (i) PP shall not start mining activity before execution of lease agreement.
- (ii) The depth of the pit shall not exceed 6 m. at the end of lease period and not beyond that.
- (iii) Before commencing the mining activity, site demarcation should be done leaving 150m. from the National Highway as a "no mining zone". The demarcation should be done by the Revenue Officials in the presence of Mining Officer, Sehore.

7. **Case No. 2300/2014** - Prior Environmental Clearance for Sumrakhedi Stone Quarry (Opencast Semi Mechanized Method) in an area of 1.0 ha. for production capacity of 5700 cum/year at Khasra No. 454 at Village – Sumrakhedi, Tehsil - Agar, District - Agar (M.P) by Shri Gabbar Singh S/o Shri Rameshchandra Gurjar, R/o Vill-Gaata, Tehsil-Agar, Dist-Agar (M.P)-465441.

After detailed discussion and perusal of the recommendations of 178th SEAC meeting dtd. 24.03.2015 and query response to 250th SEIAA meeting dtd. 14.10.2015, Mining Officer, Agar Malwa has concealed the information regarding no. of mines within 500m periphery. Director Geology & Mining should be informed that disciplinary action should be initiated against the erring officer. Initially he has certified that there are no mines within 500m periphery, thereafter, from the Google map it was observed by SEIAA that intensive mining activity is prevailing in the 500m periphery. MO, Agar Malwa was asked to confirm and certify. In response to this query, MO, Agar Malwa has indicated two more mines (4.0 ha.) sanctioned and operating in 500m periphery.

It was decided to grant Prior Environmental Clearance subject to the following specific conditions in addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC.

- (i) PP shall not start mining activity before execution of lease agreement.
- (ii) The depth of the pit shall not exceed 6m. at the end of lease period and not beyond that.

Hence, Prior Environmental Clearance is granted for Sumrakhedi Stone Quarry (Opencast Semi Mechanized Method) in an area of 1.0 ha. for production capacity of 5700 cum/year at Khasra No. 454 at Village – Sumrakhedi, Tehsil - Agar, District - Agar (M.P) **for the lease period to Shri Gabbar Singh S/o Shri Rameshchandra Gurjar, R/o Vill-Gaata, Tehsil-Agar, Dist-Agar (M.P)-465441.**

A query was raised in the 214th SEIAA meeting dtd. 30.06.2015 to submit the requisite information. After detailed discussion it was decided to delist the case as PP & other concerned could not the submit information within the reasonable time. However, on submission of the information by PP the case shall be liable for re-listing. Copy to PP & all concerned.


