1. **Case No. 1854/2015:** Prior Environmental Clearance for Construction of additional new storage tank to enhance the capacity of MS & HSD in existing BPCL Depot. at Bhitoni POL Depot, NH12, Shahpura, District-Jabalpur (MP) Tankage capacity Existing - 12818 KL (Class A: 2618 KL Class B: 10200 KL) Tankage capacity Proposed - 20,943 KL (Class A: 6033 KL Class B: 14910 KL) Land area: 34 Acres by Mr. R.A. Joshi, Depot-in-Charge, Bhitoni, BPCL, Bhitoni POL Depot. N.H. 12, Shahpura, District-Jabalpur (MP)-483119 email:joshiar1465@bharatpetroleum.in Env. - (1) The project pertains to the proposed construction of additional tankage for MS & HSD and associated facilities within the existing premises of BPCL Depot. at Bhitoni POL Depot, NH12, Shahpura, District-Jabalpur (MP). The Depot presently has 12818 KL of Tankage for handling Motor Spirit, High Speed Diesel, Superior Kerosene, Ethanol and proposed augmentation of existing depot with following tank capacities:

- MS storage tank : Above Ground –1x 3415 KL (FR)
- HSD storage tanks : Above Ground Tanks –1x 4710 KL(CR).

- (2) PP has submitted copy compliance report for consent to operate from Regional Officer,MPPCB Jabalpur (dtd. 19.10.15) for existing Depot.
- (3) There is no interstate boundary within 10 km (PWD letter dtd. 10.01.14) and no National Park / Sanctuary within the 5 km of the project area(DFO letter dtd. 04.01.14) hence the general conditions are not attracted.
- (4) The project includes isolated storage & handling of hazardous chemicals and covered under 6 (b) category of the MoEF, GoI EIA Notification, 2006 and its amendments.
- (5) The ToR were issued to PP by SEAC (vide letter no. 276 dated 20/12/14) and EIA was submitted by PP (vide letter dtd 11.08.2015).
- (6) Public Hearing was held on 30.06.2015 at project site Bhitoni POL Depot, NH12, Shahpura, District-Jabalpur (MP) under the Chairmanship of ADM Jabalpur. Some issues were raised during public hearing which were addressed by PP.
- (7) The case was discussed in SEAC meetings 154th dtd. 10.11.2014, 224th dtd. 16.09.2015 and 241st dtd 06.11.2015 and project is recommended for grant of prior EC subject to 09 special conditions.
- (8) PP has submitted Khasra Panchsala which is not readable.
- (9) The total existing water requirement is 6.0 m³/day. After establishment of the proposed MS tanks, water consumption may marginally increase from 6.0 m³/day to 6.5 m³/day. The source of water for the project is ground

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water. Presently, water requirement is being met by two nos. of bore wells available within plant premises.

- (10) The waste water generated about 2.0 m³/day from the depot and after establishments of two additional storage tanks it is expected to be 2.5 m³/day. About 0.5 m³/day of sanitary wastewater is being generated from different sources of domestic uses. PP has proposed no wastewater is discharged outside the premises of Bhitoni Depot. Sanitary wastewater from toilets, canteen and wash room is treated in Septic Tanks and is disposed off through soak pits. The non-sanitary wastewater such as wastewater generated due to floor washings, mock drills etc. is passed through Oil Water Separator (OWS) for arresting the oil content. The oil free wastewater is being used quantitatively in gardening / afforestation.
- (11) There is no continuous source of air pollution from the process of existing facilities of Bhitoni Depot. The proposed facilities comprise installation of additional storage tanks for MS & HSD. There shall not be any continuous source of air emission from the proposed facilities.
- (12) PP has proposed rain water harvesting pond in the de-licensed area of the plant.
- (13) No solid waste shall be generated from the proposed facilities. The oil collected in the Oil Water Separator is stored in the PP containers and sold to registered vendors approved by MPPCB. This practice is already in force and hence, no additional measures are required.
- (14) Hazardous waste generated like used oil, grease and empty drums, used paint containers and other metallic containers are disposed of through registered vendors approved by MPPCB as per Hazardous Waste (Management, Handling & Trans-boundary Movement) Rules, 2008 & subsequent amendments.
- (15) PP has submitted approved Onsite Disaster Management Plan from DMI dtd. 11.04.14 and off site emergency plan is pending with district administration.
- (16) The total existing power requirement is 250 KVA & after establishments of two additional storage tanks it is expected to be 340 KVA. The source of electricity is M. P. Pashcim Khetra Vidyut Vitran Co. Ltd. PP has proposed About 58% (18-20 Acres) of total land (34 Acres) are covered under green belt area.
- (17) **After deliberation PP was asked to submit the following information:-**
 - (i). Notarized copy of latest Khasra Panchsala.
 - (ii). Detail of landscape plan by including two rows periphery of the project area along with increasing the numbers of trees within the project area.
 - (iii). Detail proposal of CSR activity wise in consultation with Commissioner, Jabalpur Division.
 - (iv). Proposal of solar system installation for captive consumption within the premises.
 - (v). Off site emergency plan duly approved by the Competent Authority.

2. **Case No. 2317/2014** Prior Environmental Clearance proposed Project "Raj Shahi Apartments, Raj Classic Apartments and Raj House" at Khasra no. 311/43, 43, 41, 45/1/1/1, 45/1/1/2/1 & 35/1, Village Narela Shankari, Tehsil Huzur, District Bhopal (MP); Total Plot Area 38823.19 sqm (3.88 ha); Total Built up Area 87653.22 sqm by M/s Raj Homes Pvt. Ltd., and Vishnupuri GNSS through Mr. Sanjay Mehta, Director, 21, Zone-II, M.P. Nagar, Bhopal-462011 (MP)

The case was discussed in 271st SEIAA meeting dtd.15.12.15 & it was recorded that:-

- (1) The case was discussed in 247th SEIAA meeting dtd. 07.10.2015 and it was recorded that :-

"....Response from Registrar Cooperative Societies M.P. is still awaited. However, PP has submitted (vide letter dtd 28.08.2015) legal opinion of Advocate Shri Rohit Shrotri (Panel Advocate Co-Operative Department) regarding legal provisions of Joint Venture Agreement. **It is decided that a DO letter sent to Registrar Cooperative Societies M.P enclosing legal opinion of Advocate Shri Rohit Shrotri (Panel Advocate Co-Operative Department) for an early reply...."**

- (2) Vide DO letter (no. 6423 dtd 19.10.2015) sent to Registrar of Cooperatives, Bhopal and reply is still awaited. It is decided that **letter sent to Principal Secretary, Cooperatives, M.P and copy to Registrar Cooperative Societies M.P."**

In response to above reply received from Commissioner Cooperative & Registrar of Cooperative Societies, Bhopal vide letter no. Gra.Ni./2015/971 dated 22.12.2015 in which it is mention that :-

Vide letter no. 359 dated 01.09.2010 SEIAA issued prior environmental clearance for the above project.

PP vide letter dated 25.08.2015 received in SEIAA office on 07.10.2015, requested due to some unavoidable circumstances project has not completed and required extension for existing Prior Environmental Clearance.

PP may be asked to submit the compliance report on the standard and general conditions imposed in the EC issued vide letter no. 359 dated 01.09.2010 duly approved by the Competent Authority and the reasons for late submission of the application for extension of validity period mentioned in the EC.

4. **Case No. 1682/2013** Prior Environmental Clearance for proposed Educational Project "Amity University, Gwalior" Promoted at Survey No. 31,38 to 46,48 to 51, Village Maharajpura, Tehsil & Distt. Gwalior, Total Plot Area 4,14,840.00 m² (41.484 ha/102.509 Acres) Total Built up Area 63,929.46 sq.m²) by Ritnand Balved Education Foundation through Brig. G.D. Sharma (Sr. Director Projects) Ritnand Balved Education Foundation (RBEF) E-27, Defense Colony, New Delhi-110024

The case was discussed in 204th SEIAA meeting dated 30.05.15 and it was recorded that :-

- (1) ".....As per decision letter was sent to PP vide 1313 dtd. 15.10.14 to submit the information as per point no. 4(i). it is noted that till date pp has not submitted the information. **It is presumed that PP is no longer interested in pursuing the project further hence it is decide to delist and close the case.**
- (i). PP shall be solely responsible for not obtaining prior EC under EIA Notification 2006 and shall be liable for legal action under the provisions of MoEF & CC Gol O.M. dtd. 12.12.12 & 27.06.13 regarding violation of EIA Notification 2006.
- (ii). A copy of letter should be sent to Project Proponent, MoEF & CC Gol, New Delhi & Regional Office Bhopal, Member Secretary MPPCB, Secretary SEAC, District Collector, Commissioner Nagar Nigam/CEO Zila Panchayat and all concerned.
- (iii). Commissioner Nagar Nigam may be directed to examine whether the building permission has been issued or not. If Building permission has been issued and work has started on the site, PP may be accordingly advised to get EC. If building permission has not been granted, PP may be asked the copy of the EC before proceeding for permission."


Vide letter dated 06.08.2015 and received in SEIAA on 12.08.2015, PP has requested to withdraw the case as per MoEF & CC, Gol Notification dated 22.12.2014 & 09.06.2015. **It is decided that a letter be written to MoEF & CC, Gol whether the educational universities are covered under the said notification or not.**



After detailed discussion on the recommendations of 245th SEAC meeting dtd. 09.12.2015, PP has submitted Online Application for Wild Life Clearances Proposal whereas SEAC has not mentioned about the clearance to be based on the final disposal of the case. Case file may be sent to SEAC.

Stone Crusher, R/o Radha Ballabh Market, Khargone District – Khargone (MP) -451001

After detailed discussion on the recommendations of 245th SEAC meeting dtd. 09.12.2015, from the coordinates provided by PP the mining site bisects the village road and part of the mining area falls within 15m. from the village road.

- (i) PP shall not start mining activity before execution of lease agreement.
- (ii) The depth of the pit shall not exceed 6m. at the end of lease period and not beyond that.
- (iii) Before commencing the mining activity, site demarcation should be done leaving 25m. from the Village Road as a "no mining zone". No mining will be permitted on the north side where the mining site is bisecting the road. The demarcation should be done by the Revenue Officials in the presence of Mining Officer, Khargone.
- (iv) The mining site should be fenced towards the road sides.

After detailed discussion on the recommendations of 245th SEAC meeting dtd. 09.12.2015, on perusal of the documents submitted, the mining lease at the time of online submission of Form-1 was in the name of Shri Anil Malviya S/o Shri Bherulal Malviya and during the course of process of the case, the mining lease was transferred by the Collector, Dhar in the name of Shri Satish Agrawal S/o Shri Balkrishan Agrawal. A revised Form-1 along with the mining plan was submitted by the new PP and this has been forwarded to SEAC on which the appraisal was done by SEAC. Necessary corrections be made in the application status of SEIAA's website.

Collector, Dhar may be asked to submit the Khasra Panchsala of the mining site where the name of the previous leaseholder Shri Anil Malviya S/o Shri Bherulal Malviya has been transferred to Shri Satish Agrawal S/o Shri Balkrishan Agrawal and the correction done in the said Khasra. Copy to PP.




