After perusal of the recommendations of 263rd SEAC meeting dtd 11.01.2016, it was reported that :-


The EMS and other submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable, hence committee decided to recommend the case for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions in addition to the standard conditions at annexure 'A':

1. Production of Stone as per mine plan with quantity not exceeding 80,000 cum/year.
2. The grant of Environmental Clearance would be subject Wild Life Clearance from NBWL to be obtained by PP.

From the Google Map it was observed that the site is in close proximity of residential area. Collector Gwalior may be asked to submit the information whether the said mine falls within the planning area of the Gwalior city and whether mining activity is permitted. NOC of Joint Director of Town & Country Planning Gwalior shall be required for this purpose. Copy to PP.

After detailed discussion, perusal of the recommendation of 230th SEAC meeting dtd. 26.10.2015, query response of 256th SEIAA meeting 04.11.2015 and letter dtd. 26.11.2015 from Joint Director of Town & Country Planning Gwalior, the mining site is part of the Gwalior city planning area with land-use as "**Residential**" and part of the scheme notified as "Shatabdipuram Residential" by Gwalior Development Authority. The case may be returned to SEAC for re-appraisal. Copy to PP.




