- (i) PP has submitted notarized copy of latest Khasra Panchsala (2015-2016) as per the Khasra Panchsala the land is in the name of Bharat Petroleum and Indian Oil Corporation Ltd. Jabalpur.
  - (ii) PP has submitted revised landscape plan by including two rows on the periphery of the project area along with increasing the numbers of the trees within the project area.
  - (iii) Regarding CSR activities PP has proposed drilling of deep gravel packed tube well and overhead tank without submersible pump at village Kushli, Imalia and Zurai Piplia, Tehsil Shahapura, District Jabalpur and provision of submersible pump with pipe line for the natural pond near temple, renovation of existing toilet and pipeline for planting existing trees at village Bhamki as well as water cooler arrangement with Chabutra for Khirkheda village.

- (3) The proposed project is building & construction project comprising Residential Building, Club House and School at Part of Khasra no. of 24/1/3,14/3 and 14/5/1 Village – Bawdiakalan Tehsil-Huzur, District-Bhopal (MP).The project includes construction of Residential dwelling Unit - 572 (Excluding E.W.S. & L.I.G).

- (5) The case was discussed in the 199th SEAC meeting dated 21/06/15 and it was decided that since the case pertains to 2012, the inspection of the site be carried out by SEAC to ascertain any construction activity on the site. The inspection of site reveals that the site is clear and no construction has been taken place on the site till date.
- (6) After deliberations by PP the case was discussed in depth & it is noted that:-
- (i) PP has submitted notarized copy of Khasra Panchsala 2011-12. As per Khasra Panchsala the land is in the name of Jitesh Estate Pvt. Limited Ltd. and Ku. Bharti Parwani. The applicant Ku. Bharti Parwani and Jitesh Parwani are Director of the said company. PP has not submitted documents regarding company registration.
  - (ii) The total water requirement is 393 KLD and fresh water requirement is 261 KLD. The source of water supply is Municipal Corporation, Bhopal. PP has submitted letter (dtd. 22.02.2012) from Municipal Corporation for supply of water.
  - (iii) The total waste water generation is 353 KLD. PP proposed sewage treatment plant of 375 KLD. The total treated waste water is 317 KLD, out of this 171 KLD is proposed to be recycled (132 KLD Flushing+39 KLD Horticulture) and remaining extra treated waste water 146KLD is proposed to be discharged in municipal sewer line. **PP has submitted letter (dtd. 06.12.15) from Bhopal Municipal Corporation for disposal of waste water.**
  - (iv) Approximately 1603kg /day Municipal Solid waste shall be generated. The generated biodegradable and non biodegradable waste will be collected in three coloured bin at within campus and final disposal through Municipal Corporation Bhopal. **PP has submitted letter (dtd.06.12.14) from Municipal Corporation, Bhopal for disposal of solid waste.**
  - (v) PP has proposed the maximum height of the building is Stilt + 37.7 M. PP has provided road width 60 M and internal road 9.0 M. As per MP Bhumi Vikas Niyam 2012 rule 42 (2) road width 30 m; Front MOS 15 m and side / rear MOS 7.50 m for building height up to 45.
  - (vi) PP has proposed to provide Internal Fire Hydrant System with landing valve, hose reel, first aid hose reels, CO<sub>2</sub> Extinguishing system, Hand held fire extinguishers etc. as per NBC 2005.
  - (vii) PP has submitted roof top rain water harvesting system for ground water recharging and has proposed 11.no of recharging pits.
  - (viii) The total power requirement is 3365 KW. The source of electricity is Madhya Pradesh Kshetra Vidyut Vitran Company Limited. PP has also provided power back up 1 DG sets of 250 KVA. For control of energy PP has proposed Energy efficient LED lamps for common areas, Multiple circuit for lighting to switch off unwanted lights, Use of LED lightings, Use of low loss capacitors etc. PP has not proposed solar lighting system for conservation of energy

SEIAA after detailed discussions and perusal of EIA Notification 2006 Para - 11 and considering the consents given by both the parties have decided to transfer Prior EC in the name of M/s Shiva Corporation (India) Ltd. for the same area, production capacity and same terms & conditions as issued in the EC letter dtd. 15.01.2016.

- 14. Case No. 3078/2015** Prior Environment Clearance for approval of **Sand Quarry** in an area of 5.360 ha. (1,60,000 cum/year) at Village-Manpur, Tehsil-Anuppur, District-Anuppur (MP) by Shri Amit Khampariya, M/s Sonbhadra Tolls, Gardha, Jabalpur (MP)-482003

In the above case, Hon'ble NGT (CZ) in Appeal No. 49/2015 (Order No. 8) dtd. 12.02.2016 has directed SEIAA as under :-


*..... We find from the conditions imposed in the EC under the category „A“ of specific condition, under condition no. 4 the same condition which was recommended by SEAC has been incorporated that "road near the school shall not be used for evacuation" and yet the full quantity as applied for i.e. 1,60,000 cubic meters per year has been allowed under the EC. We are unable to reconcile the matter with regard to the recommendations made by SEAC which have partially been accepted on the basis of the reasoning given in the reply filed by SEIAA in its EC conditions and yet the reason for reducing the quantity while recommending the case of the Respondent No. 2 to SEIAA by SEAC has not been stated by SEIAA.*


*We would therefore direct that the matter be remanded back to SEIAA for reconsideration in the light of the reasoning given in the reply filed by SEIAA on the recommendations of SEAC in favour of the Respondent No. 2. We direct that the SEIAA would reconsider the matter and decide the matter within 15 days of the copy of this order being placed before it.*


*The SEIAA while reconsidering the matter after remand shall decide the same in accordance with the fresh guidelines issued by MoEF&CC.*

The case is returned to SEAC along with the replies filed by SEIAA & SEAC in the Tribunal for re-appraisal in the light of the guidelines issued by MoEF & CC and other orders issued by Hon'ble NGT in case of sand mining. Since the matter has to be decided early, SEAC may take it on top priority
