After perusal of the recommendations of 14th SEAC-II meeting dtd. 22.03.2016, it was reported that :-

"...The case was presented by the PP and their consultant wherein PP submitted that as per the Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change recent notification dated 15/01/2016, the criteria of cluster has been changed and now leases within 500 meters are to be considered for cluster. PP further submitted that they have submitted the revised certificate verifying the leases within 500 meters and as per the revised certificate of mining officer issued vide letter no.3829 dated 19/02/2016 no mines are sanctioned within 500 meters.
