SEAC in its meeting 231st dtd. 27.10.2015 as under :-

"As per the record submitted, it was observed that it was group comprising of six mines all at distant locations. However, it has been sanctioned as one unit by the mining department. PP has submitted single mining plan for all six mining sites. The submitted mine plan has few discrepancies also for example in Ch.-2 "LOCATION & ACCESSIBILITY", the grant area is mentioned as 10.796 ha., while the given area breakup is of 12.00 ha. for sand mining & 2.00 ha. for stone mining. Similarly, site wise production details are not given.

As environmental appraisal is site specific, the proposal cannot be appraised in the present form. The committee was therefore of the view that PP has to submit mine plan, including EMP and other relevant documents separately for each site. The proposal, is therefore, returned to SEIAA

PP may be asked to submit Revised application for specific area separately for each mine. It has been decided to close the case. Copy to PP & all concerned.

- (ii) The production capacity shall be limited to the quantity as recommended by SEAC-II.
- (iii) The lease area should be properly demarcated in the presence of the Revenue & Mining Officials and proper boundary stones should be established.
- (iv) No in-stream mining shall be allowed. The local authorities should ensure that the mining activity is confined only in the dry portion of the river where sand is exposed.
- (v) The depth of the pit shall not exceed 3.0 m or normal water level prevalent in the lean season whichever is less.
- (vi) The final decision of Hon'ble NGT (CZ) Bhopal and Hon'ble NGT Principal Bench, New Delhi in OA No. 49/2015 (Amarkant Mishra Vs State of MP & others), shall be obligatory on the part of PP.
- (vii) PP should ensure that no access ramps are made for transportation of sand from the opposite bank of the river.
- (viii) Before commencing the mining activity, site demarcation should be done leaving 100 mtr. from the village settlement as "no mining zone". The demarcation should be done by the Revenue Officials in the presence of Mining Officer, Hoshanabad.
- (ix) No transportation shall be permitted within the village.
- (x) Alternate transportation route should be decided in consultation with the local Gram Panchayat.
- (xi) The entire lease area should be properly fenced and boundary stones marked at the site.


