The case was discussed in 30th SEAC-II meeting dtd. 04.06.16, it was reported that:-


"SEIAA vide letter no.10874/SEIAA/16 dated 01/02/2016 sent back the file to SEAC for re-appraisal as "in the body of the minutes this case has been described as flagstone, Murum and Bolder Stone. Case may be retured to SEAC for clarification anf also further appraisal as to how bolder stone and flag stone will be excavated from the mineas methodology of extraction is different for these two categories".


The case was presented by the PP and their consultant wherein PP informed regarding the methodology of excavation of these minerals and submitted necessary documents for consideration. After detailed deliberations and discussions, committee observed that as per the Form-1 and approved mine plan PP has applied for the Flagstone, Bolder and Murum. It was also observed from the "methodology and production bench height" submitted by PP in presentation that there is 20 mm ranging from 10mm to 30mm thicknes of chips and chachhri, again at the depth of approx. 3.5 meters, there is 1.00 meter thick chips & chachri dust which is marketable as building material in place of Murum. This will minimize the soild waste disposal at the lowest and also State Govt. will earn revenue agaist reuse of waste otherwise this will be stacked as waste material. These two layers will be minable manually with chisel and hammer. The remaining two layers of 3.0 meter and 1.5 meter of flag stone & bolder stone will be minable as per mine plan. PP has also informed during presentation that he has given marketable name as "Murum" to waste as "chips & chachri". Committee decided that the above clarification may be sent to SEIAA."


As per the above clarification and the recommendations of 254th SEAC meeting dtd. 19.12.2015, it was decided to grant Prior Environmental Clearance subject to the following specific conditions in addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC

- (i) PP shall not start mining activity before execution of lease agreement.
- (ii) The depth of the pit shall be as per the Approved Mining Plan.
- (iii) The entire area shall be fenced and three rows of plantation should be done towards the human habitation side.

Hence, Prior Environmental Clearance is granted for Flag Stone, Murrum & Boulder Quarry (Opencast Semi-Mechanized Method) in an area of 2.00 ha. for expansion in production capacity from 450 to 12,000 cum/year (Flag Stone-4800, cum/year Murrum-3600 cum/year & Boulder Stone-3000 cum/year) at Khasra No.- 858 at

In this particular case, the EC has been issued for two years ending 14.02.2015 now PP has requested for extension of the EC upto the remaining lease period i.e. 14.10.2021 for the same production capacity of 5000 cum per year. This case was again discussed in the 268th SEAC meeting dtd. 16.01.16 and it was reported that:-

"The committee after discussion decided that if the mining lease area and production remains the same and if the lease has been renewed, the EC may be extended as per the provisions of EIA Notification subject to the following: Expansion or modernization in the project, entailing capacity addition with change in process and or technology and any change in product - mix in proposed mining unit shall require a fresh Environment Clearance."

As per the above observations, since the PP has submitted the application on 02.03.2015 i.e. after the expiry of the EC period and it took more than a year to process the case the extension of EC is granted upto the lease period i.e. 14.10.2021 effective from the date of issue of EC.

The case was discussed in 30th SEAC-II meeting dtd. 04.06.16, it was reported that:-


"Today, Neither the Project Proponent (PP) nor his representative was present to explain the query which might be raised or to make any commitment which may be desired by the committee during the deliberation. On perusal of the documents committee observed that the application submitted by the PP is incomplete for which SEIAA vide letter no. 3454/SEIAA/15 dated 30/03/15 has instructed to submit the desired documents but PP has not submitted the same. SEAC also vide letter no. 215 dated 18/05/2015 has instructed PP to submit the lacking details but PP except the mine plan has not submitted other necessary documents (such as DFO, Tehsildar & MO certificat) which are essential for the appraisal of the project. Committee decided that since sufficient opportunities have been given to the PP for appraisal and consideration of the project wherein PP remain absent and have also not submitted the essential documents, the case shall be returned to SEIAA for delisting assuming that PP is not interested to continue with the project as per MoEF&CC OM No. J-11013/5/2009-IA-II (Part) dated 30/10/2012"



Committee observed that the lease of this case is < 5.00 ha and concerned Mining Officer (vide letter no.QL-15/09, dated: -13/08/15) has reported that there is no more mine operating or proposed within 500 meters around the said mine, this case can be transferred to DEIAA through SEIAA."



The case was discussed in 30th SEAC-II meeting dtd. 04.06.2016 and after detailed discussions on the recommendations it was decided to grant Prior Environmental Clearance subject to the following specific conditions in addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC

- I. PP shall not start mining activity before execution of lease agreement.
- II. The production capacity shall be limited to the quantity as recommended by SEAC-II.
- III. The lease area should be properly demarcated in the presence of the Revenue & Mining Officials and proper boundary stones should be established.
- IV. No in-stream mining shall be allowed. The local authorities should ensure that the mining activity is confined only in the dry portion of the river where sand is exposed.
- V. The depth of the pit shall be as per Approved Mining Plan and not exceed 3m or normal water level prevalent in the lean season whichever is less.

(20,000 cum/year) at Khasra No.-3579/7, 3577, Vill.-Billaua, Tehsil-Dabra, District-Gwalior (MP) by Shri Sushil Kumar Jain S/o Shri B.K. Jain, M/s Stuti Stone Crushing Co. R/o J-82, Kalka Jee, Delhi-474001.

(1) The case was discussed in 279th SEIAA meeting dtd. 08.01.2016 and it was recorded that :-

"After detailed discussion and recommendations of 249th SEAC meeting dtd. 14.12.2015, this case pertains to Village Biloua and therefore should have been a part of Biloua Cluster for which Hon'ble NGT has also directed to form a committee for a site visit and thereafter its site report. SEIAA has decided to return the case to SEAC for appraisal as per the directives of Hon'ble NGT."

(2) In the 30th SEAC-II meeting dtd. 04.06.2016, it was reported that :-

Accordingly a two member's sub committee comprising of Shri. Prashant Shrivastava and Dr. Mohd. Akram Khan visited the site on 22.05.2016 wherein it is recorded that mine registered with case no. Case No.-3876/15 of Shri Sushil Kumar Jain S/o Shri B.K. Jain, M/s Stuti Stone Crushing Co. R/o J-82, Kalka Jee, Delhi-474001 Prior Environment Clearance for approval of Stone Quarry Lease Area - 1.435 ha., Capacity - 20,000 cum/year, at Khasra No.-3579/7, 3577, Vill.-Billaua, Tehsil-Dabra, District-Gwalior (MP) is located > 500 meters away from the above mines with can be verified from the letter issued by concerned mining Officer (letter no.-Q-L-50/2015, dated: 21/08/2015) wherein it has been reported that there are no more mines operating or proposed within 500 meters around the said mine. This site is a single lease of 1.435 ha with no other mine within 500 meters located in the northwestern side of the billaua cluster. Two crushers are located on the western side of this lease and both were non-operational at the time of inspection. The wind direction at the time of inspection was from North to Southeastern direction. No demarcation/mine boundary pillars were available on site to verify the exact distances of this lease from the other sensitive environmental factors and billaua cluster. The mining officer and PP present during inspection also could not establish the exact mine boundary of this lease and their respective distances from the billaua cluster and other sensitive environmental factors. Thus sub-committee asked the concerned mine owner and officers from mining department to prepare a surface map of all the lease with the help of Tehsildar/Patwari/Mining Officer mentioning their exact distances from billaua cluster, nearby industry, billaua village, Main road etc and this map should be duly verified by the Tehsildar/Patwari/Mining Officer for further considerations. The repor of the committee was placed in the 28th SEACII meeting dated 02/06/2016.


PP vide letter dated 25/05/2016 has submitted the desired information which was placed before the committee. Committee observed that PP has submitted surface map which is duly verified by the Tehsildar stating the distances of this lease which are as follows:



The committee after deliberations decided that since this mine is >700 meters away from the billaua cluster and it single mine, the committee stands by its earlier recommendations made in the 249th SEAC meeting dated 14/12/2015."

From the above observation and the issues raised in the 279th SEIAA meeting, it was pin pointed query to SEAC for giving explanation on the Hon'ble NGT, Bhopal directives issued from time to time. However, SEAC has not covered the directives of Hon'ble NGT, Bhopal in analyzing the given situation. The case is returned to SEAC for elaborating on the directives of Hon'ble NGT with reference to this particular case.
