After detail discussion and recommendations of the 43rd SEAC-II meeting dtd. 28.07.2016, it was decided to grant Prior Environmental Clearance subject to the following specific conditions in addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC-II.

- I. PP shall not start mining activity before execution of lease agreement.
- II. The production capacity shall be limited to the quantity as recommended by SEAC-II.
- III. The lease area should be properly demarcated in the presence of the Revenue & Mining Officials and proper boundary stones should be established.
- IV. No in-stream mining shall be allowed. The local authorities should ensure that the mining activity is confined only in the dry portion of Khodu Bharu site where sand is exposed.
- V. The depth of the pit shall be as per Approved Mining Plan.
- VI. The final decision of Hon'ble NGT (CZ) Bhopal and Hon'ble NGT Principal Bench, New Delhi in OA No. 49/2015 (Amarkant Mishra Vs State of MP & others), shall be obligatory on the part of PP.
- VII. No transportation shall be permitted within the village.
- VIII. Alternate transportation route should be decided in consultation with the local Gram Panchayat.
- IX. The entire lease area should be properly demarcated in the presence of the Revenue Officials, site should be properly fenced and boundary stones marked at the site.

After detail discussion and recommendations of the 43rd SEAC-II meeting dtd. 28.07.2016, it was reported that :-

"SEIAA vide letter no. 2748/SEIAA/16 dated 26/07/2016 has sent back the file to SEAC seeking justification for transfer to DEIAA which was placed before the committee. The committee again examines the case file and observed that the case is off Marble mine in an area of 1.83 ha. Concerned Mining Officer vide letter no. 3379 dated: 19/08/2015 has reported that there are 03 more mines operating or proposed within 500 meters around the said mine with total area of 8.84 ha including this mine. Being the area of lease is < 5.00 ha and the area of lease in cluster is also 5.00 ha, the case was recommended for transferred to DEIAA through SEIAA by withdrawing the recommendations made in the 252nd SEAC meeting dated 17/12/2015 as per the GOI, MoEF&CC Notification dated 15/01/2016. The case transfer request was made by the PP vide their letter 20/06/2016 and considering the request of PP the same was considered by the committee as per the GOI, MoEF&CC Notification dated 15/01/2016 and in other cases where no such requests are made by the PP, the cases are considered on the basis of EIA or Comprehensive EMP".

Minutes of the 360th Meeting of SEIAA dated. 12.08.2016


After detailed discussion of query response in 307th SEIAA meeting dtd. 22.03.2016 and recommendation of 207th SEAC meeting dtd. 22.07.2015, it was decided to grant Prior Environmental Clearance subject to the following specific conditions in addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC

- (i) PP shall not start mining activity before execution of lease agreement.
- (ii) The depth of the pit shall be as per the Approved Mining Plan.
- (iii) Before commencing the mining activity, site demarcation should be done leaving 100m. from nearest human habitation and water body bund as a "no mining zone". The demarcation should be done by the Revenue Officials in the presence of Mining Officer, Gwalior.
- (iv) The depth and length of the present garland drain should be increased as per the EMP and make 13 settling tank along the cluster to avoid flow of silt in the nearby Nalla.
- (v) PP has committed to plant 20500 trees inside and outside the lease area. He will undertake plantation of trees in consultation with the Collector, Gwalior in areas outside the lease area.
- (vi) Under CSR PP should adopt a village and undertake the following activities :-
 - a) Providing sanitation facilities and clean drinking for the schools near the mine site in consultation with Collector, Gwalior.
 - b) Skill upgradation of the youth incorporating training in digital india campaign for the villagers of nearby villages.
 - c) Sanitation activities including construction of individual toilets for local residents in consultation with village Panchayat.
 - d) Drinking water facilities for villagers of nearby villages.
- (vii) PP has committed and expenditure of Rs. 14.50 lakh under EMP for Environmental Monitoring. RO, MPPCB, Gwalior should ensure regular air, water & noise monitoring.
- (viii) The approach road from the mining lease area upto the PWD road is 8 km. PP will strengthen and consolidate the existing road so as to avoid and reduce the air pollution. PP will also plant trees along the 8 km stretch of the Kaccha Road.
- (ix) PP will ensure air pollution control measures and plant two rows of trees around the crusher area.
- (x) PP shall ensure to construct the shelter for the labours, proper health check-up of workers and payment wages to the workers as per labour laws.
- (xi) Controlled blasting should be carried out only during the day time.

Hence, Prior Environmental Clearance is granted for **B.T. Metal aggregate** (Opencast Manual / Semi Mechanized Method) in an area of 2.44 ha. for expansion of production capacity from 3,00,000 cum/year to 392080 cum/year (As per SEAC recommendation) at Khasra no. 169 at Village Sumerpada, Tehsil Morar, District Gwalior (M.P) **for the lease period to M/s Emerald Industries Ltd., Shri Anil Bhansali, C.M.D, Gyan Ganga, Nadi Gate, Jayendraganj, Lashkar,**

16. **Case No. 2615/2015** Prior Environmental Clearance for Noornagar Stone Quarry (Opencast Manual / Semi Mechanized Method) in an area of 2.834 ha. for production capacity of 23,520 cum/year at Khasra No. 297/1, 298 at Village-Noornagar, Tehsil-Udaipura, District-Raisen (MP) by M/s Monte-Carlo Limited, Shri Ravindra Kumar Singh, Village-Partalai, Tehsil-Badi, Raisen (MP) – 464665

In the above case, Prior EC was issued on 06.07.2015 with 13 specific condition and 21 general conditions. Shri Hanumant Singh Dhakad, Village Noornagar, Tehsil Udaipura, District Raisen had filed a complaint before the M.P. State Human Right Commission and the Hon'ble Commission has directed SEIAA to redress grievances of the complainant with regard to the damage done due to mining activity near his agriculture field. It seems that the PP has not followed the conditions imposed in the EC issued. According to the general practice, PP has to submit compliance report on 01st June and 1st Dec. of each calendar year to RO, MoEF&CC Bhopal and SEIAA on the terms & conditions stated in the EC. However no compliance report has been received before SEIAA. It is therefore imperative to seek a report from the RO, MoEF&CC Bhopal on the receipt of the statutory compliance report in their office and whether PP has implemented and followed the conditions imposed in the EC. Since the matter is urgent and a report to be submitted before 24.09.2016 in the M.P. State Human Right Commission, a letter be written to RO, MoEF&CC Bhopal for a site visit and compliance of the conditions by the PP.

2. Regarding the establishment of crusher and the conditions imposed by the MPPCB, a letter be sent to MS, MPPCB to submit a report on the grievances highlighted by the complainant latest by 15.09.2016.

3. On submission of these reports, the case may be put-up before SEIAA.

17. **Case No. 3443/2015** Prior Environmental Clearance for Sand Mining (Opencast Manual Method) in an area of 11.380 ha. for production capacity of 1,10,000 cum/year at Village-Pathwari, Tehsil-Badwara, Dist-Katni (MP) by Shri Sanjeev Kumar Suri, Sub Lessee the M.P. State Mining Corporation Ltd., 70, Suri Gali, Railway Quarter, Katni (MP) – 483501

In the 230th SEAC meeting dtd. 26.10.2015 it was reported that :-

"During scrutiny of documents it was observed that :-


- 1. In Form-1, name of applicant has been shown as Shri Sanjeev Kumar Suria and and M. P. State Corporation as sub-lessee. It is most unlikely that M. P. State Corporation can be sub-lessee.*
- 2. It is also observed that evacuation road is passing through two villages and no other alternate evacuation route is available.*
- 3. Gram sabah has also taken objection to the mining in this area and has not recommended this case in their meeting dated 27/06/2015.*

In view of above, the case is not recommended for grant of EC".

This case was further deliberated in 256th SEIAA meeting dtd. 04.11.2015 and it was reported that :-

"After detailed discussion, perusal of the recommendation of 230th SEAC meeting dtd. 26.10.2015, from the coordinates provided by PP, within the mining lease stretch there is an existing bridge which may cause

instability to the existing structure. Mining Corporation may be asked to submit NOC from the Works Department. Alternative evacuation route should be identified as per observation of the SEAC"

M.P. State Mining Corporation Ltd. in its letter dtd. 08.08.2016 has submitted and NOC from MP Road Development Corporation Ltd. wherein they have recommended no mining zone within 500m. upstream and downstream of the road bridge. In the new dispensation, it is appropriate that the Mining Corporation should submit a revised mining plan keeping the reduction in the production capacity due to the rider imposed by Road Development Corporation.

18. **Case No. – 1677/2013** Prior Environmental Clearance for Julwania Dolomite Limestone Mine in an area of 9.0 ha. for production capacity 125000 TPA at Khasra No. – 310/2 & 311 at Village–Julwania, Tehsil–Jhabua, Distt–Jhabua (M.P.) by Shri Nilesh Upadhyay, Surya Darshan Building, Flat no. 201, 7, White Church, District Indore, (M.P.) 495001


