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



The case was discussed and it was decided to call Mining Officer, Hoshangabad and OIC, M.P. State Mining Corporation for clarification.

The case was discussed and recommended in 46<sup>th</sup> SEAC-II meeting dtd. 26.08.2015 and it was reported that :-

*"The case was presented by the PP and their consultant wherein during scrutiny of documents it was observed by the committee that following 05 mining leases are sanctioned which are not contiguous in nature and also not in accordance with the MP MMR, 1996 rule 04 (3):*

*The committee also observed that single mine plan is prepared for all the above leases. Earlier in cases of similar nature (please refer the minutes of 231st SEAC meeting dated 27/10/2015 and subsequent decision taken by SEIAA in its 327th meeting dated 05/05/2016) SEIAA has decided to close the case. The committee decided to obtain SEIAA's opinion in this case for its further considerations".*

The committee discussed the above observation of SEAC and it has been decided that as environmental appraisal is site specific, the proposal can't be appraised in the present form. The committee therefore directs that PP has to submit mine plan, including EMP and other relevant documents separately for each site. It has been decided to close the case. Copy to PP & all concerned.



After detailed discussion and recommendation of 47<sup>th</sup> SEAC-II meeting dtd. 27.08.2016, it was decided to grant Prior Environmental Clearance subject to the following specific conditions in addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC.

- I. PP shall not start mining activity before execution of lease agreement.
- II. The production capacity shall be limited to the quantity proposed by SEAC-II.
- III. The lease area should be properly demarcated in the presence of the Revenue & Mining Officials and proper boundary stones should be established.
- IV. No in-stream mining shall be allowed. The local authorities should ensure that the mining activity is confined only in the dry portion of the river where sand is exposed.
- V. The depth of the pit shall not exceed 1.5 m or normal water level prevalent in the lean season whichever is less.
- VI. The final decision of Hon'ble NGT (CZ) Bhopal and Hon'ble NGT Principal Bench, New Delhi in OA No. 49/2015 (Amarkant Mishra Vs State of MP & others), shall be obligatory on the part of PP.
- VII. PP should ensure that no access ramps are made for transportation of sand from the opposite bank of the river.
- VIII. The transportation route should be decided in consultation with the local Gram Panchayat.
- IX. The entire lease area should be properly fenced and boundary stones marked at the site.
- X. PP will ensure three row plantation towards the village settlement side in the entire length of suitable species three year old to conserve and retain the banks.

Hence, Prior Environmental Clearance is granted for River Sand Quarry (Opencast Manual Method) in an area of 9.24 ha. for production capacity of 1872 cum/year at Khasra No. 632, 511, 760, 807, 359 at Village-Shribacch, Teh-Khachrod, Dist-Ujjain (MP) **for the lease period** Shri Darshan Porwal S/o Shri Iswar Porwal, R/o G-2, Rishi Nahar, Ujjain, Teh & Dist-Ujjain (MP)-470661.

The case was discussed and recommended in 47<sup>th</sup> SEAC-II meeting dtd. 27.08.2015 and it was reported that :-

*"The other submissions made by PP were found satisfactory and acceptable and thus the committee decided to recommend the case for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions in addition to the standard conditions at annexure 'B':*

*Production of Sand as per mine plan with quantity not exceeding 82,610 cum/year.*

- District Authority should record the deposition of sand in the lease area at an interval of 50 meters annually in the last week of September and maintain the records in RL (Reduce Level) Measurement Book. Accordingly authority may allow lease holder to excavate the replenished quantity of sand in the subsequent year.
- Evacuation of sand should not be allowed through the roads passing through the villages.
- Heavy vehicles (Havya) should not be allowed on Kachcha, narrow roads
- If causeway (Rapra) is required to be constructed for mining. It should be removed completely before rainy season every year.
- The river bank from where access ramps are made should be restored and access should be closed every year before rainy season.
- No diversion of active channel should be allowed for mining".

From the above observation, it is revealed that SEAC in their recommendation has indicated the production capacity as 82,610 cum/year, whereas in Form-1 and Mine Plan the production capacity is indicated as 42,610 cum/year. The case is therefore sent to SEAC for clarification.

*"The case was again scheduled for the presentation today but neither the Project Proponent (PP) nor his representative was present to explain the query which might be raised or to make any commitment which may be desired by the committee during the deliberation. Earlier PP was also absent in the 41th SEAC II & 44th SEAC II meeting. Committee decided that since sufficient opportunities have been given to the PP for appraisal and consideration of the project wherein PP remain absent, the case shall be returned to SEIAA for delisting assuming that PP is not interested to continue with the project"*



Enhancement in Production capacity from 1,285 TPA to 12,495 TPA at Khasra no.-274, Village-Sonegaon, TehsilTirodi, District-Balaghat (M.P) by Shri Dinesh S/o Shri Devendralal Agrawal, Vijay Nagar, Balaghat Road, Gondia (Maharashtra) Pin code- 441601.

This case was delisted in 342<sup>nd</sup> SEIAA Meeting dtd. 21.06.2016 on the recommendation of 29<sup>th</sup> SEAC-II dtd. 03.06.2016 on account of absence of PP. Now PP has submitted a letter on 26.08.2016 stating that due to some genuine reason they could not attend the SEAC meeting. The committee has now decided to relist the case and revert to SEAC for appraisal and PP be given last chance for presentation before SEAC. In case of absentism on account of PP, the case may be recommended for closer.

18. **Case No. 565/2010** Prior Environmental Clearance for Limestone & Laterite Mine 8.09 ha. for expansion production capacity from 5000 MT/Year to 50000 MT/Year (40000 TPA of Limestone & 10000 TPA Laterite) at Khasra No. 411 at Village Tihari, Teh- Rampur Baghelan, Distt- Satna (MP) by Smt. This case was discussed in 356<sup>th</sup> SEIAA meeting dtd. 26.07.2016 and PP was asked to submit the renewed lease agreement. PP has submitted an application on 01.09.2016 that from their side, all formalities regarding extension of mining lease before the State Govt. has been completed, but they are unable to receive the renewal of mining lease. The committee has decided to issue letters to Secretary Mineral Resources & Collector, Satna on the present status of the lease agreement.

20. **CASES TO BE DECIDED AS PER RECENT GOI, MoEF&CC NOTIFICATION DATED 01/07/2016 RECOMMENDED BY SEAC.**


SEAC has submitted a list of 144 cases of minor mineral which are less than 5 ha. and recommended for transfer to DEIAA in 147<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting dtd. 27.08.2016 as per the notification issued by MoEF&CC dtd. 01.07.2016. SEIAA was informed that Environment Department, GoMP shall be issuing detailed instructions as a follow-up of the above notification. It has been decided to wait for the instructions and till such time these cases are hereby deferred.

**C. COMPLIANCE IN RESPONSE TO THE HON'BLE NGT DIRECTIVES IN OA No. 134/2014 AND ORDER DTD. 19.08.2016.**

Hon'ble NGT had directed SEIAA and the State Govt. to issue necessary directions to DEIAA for implementation of sustainable sand mining management guidelines 2016. Member Secretary has issued instructions to Collectors and Chairman DEIAA of all districts to strictly follow the management guidelines while appraising cases of sand mining. The letter may be put-up before the Hon'ble NGT on the next hearing.
