
5. **Case No. 2888/2015:** Environment Clearance for proposed Construction of Residential Housing Project "Highway Karuna Sagar" at Khasra No. – 176/1, 177/3, 178/1, 179/4/2, Village -Kanadia, Tehsil & District -Indore (MP) Total Land area - 26890.00 sq.m. Total Built-up Area- 48,447.78 sq.m. M/s Highway Infrastructure Pvt. Ltd, & Mr. Vivek Agrawal (Land Coowners), Prashant Sagar Builders Developers Pvt. Ltd., 57-FA, Scheme No. 94, Pipliyahana Junction, Ring Road, Indore (MP) - 452016 Env. Consultant: Env Development Assistance System Pvt. Ltd, Lucknow.

The case was discussed in SEIAA 357th meeting dtd. 27.07.16 & it was recorded that:

".....AS per the above submission made by PP it was observed that whether the statements given by PP was verified by the committee or not, hence it is decided that the case be returned to SEAC for verifying the statements made by PP including the authority observation on the basis of site visit.

SEIAA has deliberated on the above observations and the latest Draft Notification issued by MOEF & CC, Gol dated 10.05.2016 in cases related to violation by the PP. They have proposed to form an expert group for each State (to be approved by the Ministry) which shall go into the details of violation and prepare a Environmental Supplemental Plan. This plan will include the remedial works to be carried out by the PP in gross violation of the environmental parameters and this plan will be included as specific conditions while granting the Environmental Clearance. Presently the Draft Notification is in the public domain for inviting comments and suggestions from the stakeholders. Till such time, the final Notification is issued by the MoEF & CC, Gol, all cases pertaining to violation shall be kept in abeyance. The process of EC will only follow after clear cut guidelines issued by the Ministry."

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As per SEIAA 357th meeting dtd. 27.07.16 the case was discussed in 281 SEAC meeting and recorded that:-

"The committee after deliberations observed that an inspection of the site is already carried out by a sub-committee of SEAC on dated 21/12/2015 and the site inspection report was discussed in the 256th SEAC meeting dated 03/01/2016 and based on the inspection report, the PP was called for the presentation in the 269th SEAC meeting dated 29/02/2016 and on the basis of submissions made by the PP, the case was recommended for EC in this meeting. The committee after deliberations decided that:

1. As the site inspection has already been conducted by the members of SEAC and report submitted, inspecting it again will be a duplication of work unless some specific information is required. The 15 parameters mentioned in the OM had already been considered by the committee at the time of presentation and during site inspection by the sub-committee of SEAC.

2. As regard area constructed and whether construction has been carried out as per the building permission/ other NOC's, (refer point no. 01 to 05, 08, 11 & 12 of SEIAA letter dated 03/08/2016) the committee was of the view that for exact and authentic assessment of the area constructed and whether construction has been carried out as per the building permission/requirements of the norms of the competent approval authorities/ facilities developed as per their permissions, it would be more appropriate to request the concern agencies of the State Govt. for their verification.

3. The issue of water requirement, dual plumbing and rain water harvesting etc have already addressed in the inspection report of the sub-committee. The other issues such as permission of CGWB and plantation area etc can be a part of the standard conditions.

In view of the above, committee believe that site visit is not necessary in this case as the site inspection has already been carried out by the members of SEAC and the site inspection report was discussed in the 256th SEAC meeting dated 03/01/2016 on the basis of submissions made by the PP, the case was recommended for EC in the 269th SEAC meeting dated 29/02/2016."

In response to above the matter was examined and it is decided that as per NGT order dtd. 02.09.16 against the OA No. 193/2014 and M.A. No. 751/2016 & 752/2016 it is stated that ".....While it is not in dispute that after the remand of the matter from Hon'ble Supreme court the matter is pending before the Hon'ble Principal Bench for hearing the matter pertaining to Muthuraman's case.

Looking to the facts and circumstance, we would direct that the outcome of the hearing and decision in Muthuraman's case by the Hon'ble Principal Bench may be awaited.

It has also been brought to the notice that the matter had been raised before the Hon'ble High Court and the Hon'ble High Court had directed SEIAA to take a decision in the matter within 4 months. They submitted that the said period has expired. But in view of the above facts pertaining to remand of the Muthuraman's case and the decision of the Hon'ble Principal Bench being in total contrast with a direction given by this Bench, SEIAA is unable to take a decision in the matter. We would accordingly direct SEIAA to approach the Hon'ble High Court with the above facts and our order passed today for awaiting decision of the Principal Bench and seeking extension of time in the matter.

In context to above direction of NGT the case is kept in abeyance till the decision of Hon'ble Principal Bench. PP may be informed accordingly. PP has given a notice to SEIAA through their lawyer regarding the implementation of the decision given by Hon'ble High Court (Indore Bench). The above decision of the Hon'ble


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NGT (CZ) should be conveyed to the PP and the facts be brought to the notice of the Hon'ble High Court (Indore Bench).





- (1) The case was discussed in 280th SEAC meeting dtd 31.08.16 and it was recorded that :-

"The case was scheduled for the presentation in the 279th SEAC meeting dated 02/07/2016 for query reply presentation but neither the Project Proponent (PP) nor his representative was present to explain the query which might be raised or to make any commitment which may be desired by the committee during the deliberation. Committee decided to call the PP in subsequent meetings giving last chance. Thus committee decided that since sufficient opportunities have been given to the PP for appraisal and consideration of the project wherein PP remain absent and hence the case shall be returned to SEIAA for delisting assuming that PP is not interested to continue with the project."



(1) The case was discussed in 281st SEAC meeting dtd 01.09.16 and it was recorded that :-

"This is a SSP fertilizer plant proposed in a private land at Deewanganj, District Raised (M.P). The project is covered under EIA notification, mentioned at SN 5(a) of the schedule of the said notification. Hence require prior EC before commencement of any activity at site. The application was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for scoping so as to determine TOR for the project. The TOR was approved in the 135th SEAC meeting dated 04/06/2013 and the same was issued to the PP vide letter no. 662 dated 20/08/2013 which was valid for 02 years. The validity of TOR expired on 19/08/2015. The above case was placed before the committee as the TOR validity has expired on 19/08/2015. The committee observed that PP has neither submitted the EIA report nor has applied for the extension of TOR's validity period and thus decided that this case may be recommended for delisting to SEIAA as TOR's validity has expired".



(1) The case was discussed in 281st SEAC meeting dtd 01.09.16 and it was recorded that :-

"This is a medium irrigation project proposed by Department of Water Resources Government of M.P., at village –Hada, tehsil- Pawai, district – Panna in Madhya Pradesh. Nearest town is Pawai at 07 km. from the site, with CCA less than 10,000 ha. It was reported that, no protected area under international conventions, national or local legislation for their ecological, landscape, cultural or other related value is falling, within 15 km zone of proposed project location boundary and project is not affecting any ecological regions-Wetlands, watercourses or other water bodies, coastal zone, biospheres, mountain-forests. The TOR was approved in the 92nd SEAC meeting dated 09/04/2013 and the same was issued to the PP vide letter no. 212 dated 08/05/2012 which was valid for 02 years. The validity of TOR expired on 07/05/2014. Later on, as per the request of PP, the TOR's validity was extended up to 07/05/2016 vide letter no. 41 dated 10/04/2015. The above case was placed before the committee as the TOR validity has expired on 07/05/2016. "River Valley projects involving < 10,000 ha. of culturable command area and denies the general conditions falls under category "B" and have been mentioned at SN. 1(c) column B of Schedule of EIA Notification, hence such projects are required to obtain prior EC from the SEIAA. This is an independent medium size river-valley project. The TOR was approved in the 94th SEAC meeting dated 07/05/2012 and the same was issued to the PP vide letter no. 298 dated 20/06/2012 which was valid for 02 years. The validity of TOR expired on 06/05/2014. Later on, as per the request of PP, the TOR's validity was extended up to 07/05/2016 vide letter no. 59 dated 10/04/2015. The above case was placed before the committee as the TOR validity has expired on 07/05/2016. 18. Case No. 1596/13, Prior Environmental Clearance for Amoch Marble Mine (Opencast Mechanized Method) in an area 6.96 ha. for proposed production capacity of 6000 cum/year at Khasra Nos. 126 to 133 & 146 at Village - Amoch, Tehsil - Bahoriband, Dist. - Katni (MP) by M/s. Action Marble (Partner, Shri Rajesh kumar Inani S/o Shri Nandlal Inani, Shri Satish Kumar Inani & Shri Mohd. Hazi Amin) - 12 New ACC Colony District - Katni (M.P.) - 483501.

- (1) This is a project pertaining to mining of **Marble Mine** in MLA of 6.96 ha The activity is mentioned at S.N. 1 (a) of the Schedule of EIA Notification 2006 as amended from time to time. The project is reported to be at a distance of more than 10 km from National park and sanctuary etc. and falls under the more than 250 m from the forest boundary.
- (2) The Divisional Level Committee, Jabalpur Division has given NOC to the lessee (vide letter no. 40/QL/13 dtd 07.09.2013). The interstate boundary is not applicable as mining site falls in Bahoriband Tehsil of District - Katni, thus it is not attracted by the general conditions and falls under category 'B-1' by virtue of its location and mining lease area.
- (3) The case was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal of EIA for environment clearance for the project. It was submitted that this is a proposed mine having valid lease for 30 years from 29.09.2003 to 26.09.2033 with production of 6000 cum/year.
- (4) It was reported by the PP that the lease area was granted to M/s Action Marbles on 22.09.2003 for 10 years. Later the lease period was extended to 30 years from 29.09.2003 vide Government order dtd 04.03.2014. This is a case of existing mining lease. The scheme of mining with progressive mine closure plan has been approved by Director, Geology & Mining (vide Letter. No. 9893 dtd. 28.05.2015).
- (5) The case was recommended in 33rd SEAC -II meeting dtd 24.06.2016 with 11 special conditions.

- (6) The case was then discussed in 369th SEIAA meeting dtd 23.09.2016 and PP/Consultant was invited for presentation. Thereafter, PP/Consultant made a presentation on all aspects of the project and all concerned issues were discussed in details.
- (7) The proposed plantation program was examined and it was found that 3918 sampling of tree species shall be planted including greenbelt in an area of 3.9204 ha during the lease period.
- (8) It was also noted that the Public Hearing was carried out on 15.01.2016 at mine site, Village - Amoch, Tehsil- Bahoriband, Distt. – Katni (MP) 3
- (9) It was noted that the water requirement is 20 KLD (5 KLD Dust Supression + 3.0 KLD Green Belt + 02 KLD Drinking/Domestic purpose + Mining Allied Activities 10 KLD), which shall be met by Tube well, mine sump and tankers from nearby village.
- (10) After detailed discussions and perusal of recommendations of 33rd SEAC -II meeting dtd 24.06.2016, presentation made by the PP in SEIAA & SEAC, it was decided that :-
 - I. PP shall submit a proper plan for storage and management of top soil excavated during mining operation.
 - II. PP informed during the presentation that 1.04 ha area under ML area shall remain undisturbed. However, the details related with the use of undisturbed area has not been given by PP. Therefore, a detail plan for utilizing the undisturbed area shall be submitted by PP.
 - III. PP shall also submit the five year stage-wise conceptual plan mentioning the existing and proposed land use separately.
 - IV. PP shall re-submit the compliance in detail against the ToR condition No. VIII.
 - V. PP shall also submit a plan which properly covers the detail of structures, garland drain, settling tank, tube-well, dug well, and surface water run-off calculation in ML area.
 - VI. PP shall submit a proper plan for activities taken under CSR and enhance the budget upto Rs 5.00 lakhs.
 - VII. PP shall submit the detail plan for construction of shed of appropriate size with drinking water facility and toilet for the labourers.


