

1. **Case No. 4426/2015**, Prior Environmental Clearance for **Jariyari Laterite & Bauxite Deposit Mine** (Opencast manual/semi mechanized method) in an area of 4.00 ha. for proposed production capacity of **28431 TPA** at Khasra no. (Jariyari Forest Compartment No. 647) at Village - Jariyari, Tehsil - Maihar, Dist - Satna (MP) by M/s Jeevan Lime Chemicals Pvt. Ltd. Shri Mayank Gugalia Director, R/o Jeevan Lime Chemicals Pvt. Ltd P.O Satna District- Satna. (M.P.) - 483501

- (1) This is a project pertaining to mining of Laterite & Bauxite mine in MLA of 4.00 ha. The activity is mentioned at S.N. 1 (a) of the Schedule of EIA Notification 2006 as amended from time to time. The project is reported to be at a distance of more than 10 km from National park and sanctuary etc. the interstate boundary is more than 10 km, thus it is not attracted by the general conditions and falls under category 'B-1' by virtue of its location and mining lease area.
- (2) The case was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal of EIA for environment clearance for the project. It was submitted that this is a proposed mine having prospecting lease of 2 years from 14.07.1997 to 13.07.1999 and It was submitted that this is a proposed mine having valid lease for 30 years from 16.09.2013. with production of 28431 TPA per annum.
- (3) MoEF&CC vide letter 08.08.2013 has principally approved diversion of 4.9 ha. protected forest land for extraction of bauxite/laterite subject to certain conditions like compensatory afforestation, net present value etc.
- (4) It was reported by the PP that the lease area was granted to M/s Jeevan Lime Chemicals Pvt. Ltd. for 30 years from 16.09.2013. The Mining Plan with progressive mine closure plan has been approved by IBM (vide letter L.No. MP/Satna/Bauxite/MPLN/G-17/2014-15 dtd. 05.05.2015).
- (5) SEAC in its 48<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting dtd. 28.08.2016 has recommended the case with 14 special conditions for issuance of EC.

- (6) The case was then discussed in 371<sup>st</sup> SEIAA meeting dtd 27.09.2016 and PP/Consultant was invited for presentation. Thereafter, PP/Consultant made a presentation on all aspects of the project and all concerned issues were discussed in detail.
- (7) The proposed plantation program was examined and it was found that 2500 sapling of tree species shall be planted in an area 1.32 ha during the lease period.
- (8) It was noted that the water requirement is 9 KLD (dust suppression 6 KLD, Green Belt 2 KLD & Domestic/Drinking 1 KLD) which shall be met by Panchayat pond and tankers.
- (9) It was also noted that the Public Hearing was carried out on 23.07.2016 at mine site, at Village - Jariyati, Tehsil – Maihar, Dist – Satna (MP) under the Chairmanship of Collector, Satna. No significant issues were raised during the public hearing except that PP should give employment to the local villagers. Collector, Satna was also present at the public hearing and stated that the CSR fund should be utilized with the consent of the Gramsabha. Proper tree plantation should be done by the PP. A community hall should be constructed for SC/ST families for which CSR fund should be utilized. He further elaborated about proper maintenance and up-keep of the road to be used by PP for haulage of material.
- (10) PP has committed the top soil will be used for plantation purpose in the mine area as well as approach road side plantation. PP has ensured that he will not stack the soil for more than 3 months. PP shall make proper garland drains with settling tank on the periphery of the mining lease area.
- (11) PP has ensured that the temporary dump of the waste generated during proposed mining will be placed in the area where third year excavation will take place. Later on, from second year onward waste will be used for back filling of already excavated area. Thus from the second year excavation and backfilling will be done for each year.
- (12) After detailed discussions and perusal of recommendations of 48<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting dtd. 28.08.2016, presentation made by the PP in SEIAA & SEAC, it was decided to accept the recommendation of SEAC for grant of prior EC to the project **subject to the following specific conditions:-**
  - I. Before commencing any mining activity fencing all around the lease area and display board at all four corners of the lease area shall be constructed. Proper watch and ward arrangements should be made by the PP to avoid any untoward incident involving public and animals.
  - II. PP shall demarcate a barrier zone of 7.5 m as no mining zone in the periphery of mining lease area and develop a green belt. The two row plantation shall be carried out in the greenbelt area in current year.
  - III. Greenbelt of 1.32 ha shall be developed and proper arrangements of water should be made for the plantation.
  - IV. Transportation will be allowed only with covered vehicle.
  - V. Garland drain with settling tanks shall be constructed all around the mine. PP shall also ensure the proper cleaning and maintenance of garland drain and settling tank.

- VI. Dumping should be done in predetermined area and shall be stabilized by fast growing grasses and maintained it with toe wall.
- VII. Water fogging system shall be adopted at loading site.
- VIII. PP shall construct the shed of 30 m x 20 m length with proper ventilation which accommodates 35 labours within the ML area.
- IX. Payments of wages to the workers shall be done in consonance with the provisions in the labour laws.
- X. Proper infrastructure with shelter and toilet facility shall be developed for the labourers.
- XI. PP should ensure water quality testing before it is discharged in the nearby nalla or to be used by villagers for irrigating the agriculture fields, R.O. MPPCB will ensure regular air & water monitoring of the lease area.
- XII. Under CSR activity in addition to the proposed activities following activities should be added.
  - a) Skill upgradation programme for the villagers of nearby villages under Digital India Scheme.
  - b) Sanitation activities including construction of individual toilets for local residents of nearby village in consultation with village Panchayat.
  - c) Drinking water facilities for villagers of nearby villages.
  - d) Construction of community hall for SC/ST families.
  - e) All the above activities shall be carried out in consultation with Gram Panchayat and District Collector.
- XIII. The appropriate budget provision of Rs. 5.00 lakhs shall be made for the CSR activities.

(Jariyari Forest Compartment No. 647) at Village - Jariyari, Tehsil – Maihar, Dist – Satna (MP) **for the lease period** M/s Jeevan Lime Chemicals Pvt. Ltd. Shri Mayank Gugalia Director, R/o Jeevan Lime Chemicals Pvt. Ltd P.O Satna District- Satna. (M.P.) - 483501

2. **Case No. 4688/2015** Prior Environmental Clearance for **Ambua Marble Quarry** (Open Cast Manual Method) in an area 8.090 ha. for proposed production capacity of 35000 cum/year at Khasra no. 49,66,1289,1290,1291,1292,1331,1332, &1352 at Village - Ambua, Tehsil – Alirajpur, Dist. – Alirajpur (MP) by M/s. Marvellous Marbal Pvt.Ltd, Shri Madan Maheshwari R/o 97, Siyaganj Indore (M.P.) - 457887.

- (1) This is a project pertaining to mining of Marble in MLA of 8.090 ha The activity is mentioned at S.N. 1 (a) of the Schedule of EIA Notification 2006 as amended from time to time. The project is reported to be at a distance of more than 10 km from National park and sanctuary etc. and more than 250m from the forest boundary. It was noted that the interstate boundary is more than 10 Km from mining site falls in Ambua Tehsil of District – Alirajpur, thus it is not attracted by the general conditions and falls under category 'B-2' by virtue of its location and mining lease area.



- (2) It was noted that 03 mines (9 ha.) are located in the periphery of 500 m of proposed mine. It was submitted that this is a proposed mine having valid lease 10 years from 21.07.2010 to 20.07.2020 with production of 35000 cum/year.
- (3) It was reported by the PP that the lease area was granted to M/s Marvellous Marbal Pvt. Ltd. This is a case of existing mining lease. The scheme of mining with progressive mine closure plan has been approved by DGM, Bhopal (vide letter no. 3-13/09/12/2 dtd 24.04.2010).
- (4) The case was recommended for prior EC in 49<sup>th</sup> SEAC-II meeting dtd 19.09.2016 with 13 special conditions.
- (5) The case was then discussed in 372<sup>nd</sup> SEIAA meeting dtd 28.09.2016 and PP/Consultant was invited for presentation. Thereafter, PP/Consultant made a presentation on all aspects of the project and all concerned issues were discussed in detail.
- (6) The proposed plantation program was examined and it was found that 3850 sapling of tree species covering an area of 2.5 ha shall be planted during the lease period.
- (7) It was noted that the water requirement is 27 KLD (20 KLD Dust Suppression + 05 KLD Green Belt + 02 KLD Drinking/Domestic purpose), which shall be met by five settling tank which are proposed at east, northwest, south west, south east.
- (8) After detailed discussions and perusal of recommendations of 49<sup>th</sup> SEAC-II meeting dtd 19.09.2016, presentation made by the PP in SEIAA & SEAC, it was decided that to accept the recommendation of SEAC for grant of prior EC to the project **subject to the following specific conditions:-**
  - (i). Before commencing any mining activity fencing all around the lease area and display board at all four corners of the lease area shall be constructed. Proper watch and ward arrangements should be made by the PP to avoid any untoward incident involving public and animals.
  - (ii). Plantation programme as mentioned in comprehensive EMP and presented during presentation in SEIAA & SEAC shall be followed in content and spirit.
  - (iii). PP shall demarcate a barrier zone of 7.5 m as no mining zone in the periphery of mining lease area and develop a green belt. The two row plantation shall be carried out in the greenbelt area in current year.
  - (iv). Plantation shall be initiated in 3.00 ha. starting from the current year in the non-mining area and at least 03 year old plants shall be planted in the green belt. Total number of plants as per the EMP would be 5300+700 (both side of transportation road).
  - (v). Garland drain with settling tanks shall be constructed all around the mine. PP shall also ensure the proper cleaning and maintenance of garland drain and settling tank.
  - (vi). Regular water quality monitoring shall be carried out by PP before discharging it into the nearby agriculture fields from authorised laboratory in consultation with Regional Officer, MP PCB, Indore
  - (vii). Payments of wages to the workers shall be done in consonance with the provisions in the labour laws.

- (viii). Proper infrastructure with shelter and toilet facility shall be developed for the labourers.
- (ix). PP shall maintain the approach road from the mining site to the main road.
- (x). Under CSR activity in addition to the proposed activities following activities should be added:
  - a) Promotion of Swach Bharat Abhiyan
  - b) Skill upgradation of the youth incorporating training in digital india campaign for the villagers of nearby villages.
  - c) Sanitation activities including construction of individual toilets for local residents in consultation with village Panchayat.
  - d) Drinking water facilities for villagers of nearby villages.
  - e) Creche for the working women in the mining unit.
- (xi). PP has proposed a budget provision Rs. 4.00 lakhs for the CSR activities.

The case was discussed in 217<sup>th</sup> SEIAA meeting dtd. 10.07.2015 and it is recorded that :-

- (i). *In response to 204<sup>th</sup> SEIAA meeting dtd.30.05.2015 PP has submitted copy of reminder letter to Nagar Nigam, Indore regarding NOC for supply of water, disposal of MSW and disposal of treated waste water. The NOCs are still awaited. It is decided that since more than six month period has lapsed and PP has not submitted the required information/ NOC from Nagar Nigam, last chance may be given to PP to submit the above information latest by 30.07.2015 else the case will be delisted as per the MoEF & CC, Gol Office Memorandum dtd. 30.10.12 and 22.08.14."*
- (1) In response to above query, letter (3436 / Tech dtd 18.06.2015) from EE, Sandharan Khand No. 2 Nagar Palika Nigam, Musakhedi, Indore has been received in SEIAA office on 30.06.15 and it is recorded that "इस क्रम में लेख है कि वर्तमान में उल्लेखित स्थल पर नगर निगम की नर्मदा जलप्रदाय की व्यवस्था नहीं होने से जलप्रदाय किया जाना संभव नहीं है। नर्मदा तृतीय चरण से पूरी क्षमता 360 एमएल.डी. जलापूर्ति प्रारंभ होने के उपरांत तथा नगर निगम सीमा में सम्मिलित किये गये नवीन 29ग्रामों हेतु योजना बनाने, स्वीकृति व क्रियान्वयन तथा तत्समय निगम की प्रचलित नीतियों व सक्षम स्वीकृति उपरांत ही किसी प्रकार की पेयजल व्यवस्था संभव हो सकेगी।"

Ltd., Shri Sailendra Kumar Worah, Director & Owner, Station Road, P.O.-Maihar, Distt-Satna (M.P.) - 485771 Kachhagawan Limesone and Dolomite Mine Lease Area - 7.42 ha.,Capacity-1,60,000 TPA at Khasra Nos.-96, part; 97 part; 100P, 129/1, 130/1, 131P at Vill.-Kachhagawan, Th.- Murwara, Distt-Katni (M.P.)

The case was discussed in 47<sup>th</sup> SEAC-II meeting dtd. 27.08.2016 and it was recorded that :-

*"The case was scheduled for the EIA presentation but neither the Project Proponent (PP) nor his representative was present to explain the query which might be raised or to make any commitment which may be desired by the committee during the deliberation. Committee decided to call the PP in subsequent meetings and even if the PP remains absent, the case shall be returned to SEIAA for delisting assuming that PP is not interested to continue with the project."*

As per the above observation the case is hereby delisted. The case shall be relisted once the PP shows his inclination to attend the meeting. Copy to PP and all concerned..

5. **Case No. - 3289/2015** Prior Environment Clearance for approval of Limestone, Dolomite and Barites Mines in an area of 10.21 ha. (expansion in production capacity from 5000 TPA to 36418 TPA) at Village-Sejha, Tehsil-Badwara, District-Katni (MP) by Shri Vijay Gupta, Partner, M/s V.S. Minerals & Co., 1st Floor, Near Guru Nanak Dharmkanta, NH-7, Bargawan, District-Katni (MP)-483501

SEAC had issued ToR on 09.09.2015 for an expanded capacity of 36418 TPA. Now PP has submitted a revised Form-1 and Feasibility Report for an expanded capacity of 39105 TPA limestone and 27632 TPA dolomite. Since one year has elapsed after the issue of ToR and therefore any revision in the Form-1 shall attract closer of the case for purposes of appraisal and PP will have to apply afresh with modified production capacity with the new approved mining plan of the competent authority. PP may be informed accordingly. Copy to SEAC-II.
