1. **Case No. 96/2008**, Prior Environmental Clearance for **Agaria Iron ore mine** (Open cast Semi-mechanized Method) in an area of 20.141 ha for production capacity of 50000 TPA at Khasra No.1093 at Village - Agaria Tehsil- Sihora District - Jabalpur (M.P) by M/s Nirmala Minerals, Pathak Ward P.O. Katni, District - Katni (MP) - 483501.

- (1) This is a project pertaining to mining of **Iron ore mine** in ML area of 20.141 ha. The activity is mentioned at S.N. 1 (a) of the Schedule of EIA Notification 2006 as amended from time to time. The project is reported to be at a distance of more than 10 km from National park and sanctuary etc. and more than 250 m from the forest boundary. The interstate boundary is not applicable as mining site falls in Village – Agaria, Tehsil- Sihora, District - Jabalpur, thus it is not attracted by the general conditions and falls under category '1 (a)' by virtue of its location and mining lease area. The case was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal of EIA for environment clearance for the project. It was submitted that this is a proposed mine having valid lease for 50 years from 06.03.1987 to 05.03.2037 with production capacity of 50000 TPA.
- (2) It was reported by the PP that the lease area was granted to M/s Nirmala Mineral for 20 years w.e.f. 06.03.1987 to 05.03.2007. Thereafter, the lease has been extended for 50 years from grant of ML i.e., upto 05.03.2037 as per MMDR Amendment Act 2015. This is a case of renewal/extension of mining lease. The Mining Plan with progressive mine closure plan has been approved by IBM, Office of Regional Controller of Mines, Jabalpur (vide Letter No. MP/Jabalpur/Iron Ore / MPLN/R-19/06-07 dtd 25.07.2007).
- (3) The case was recommended in 82<sup>th</sup> SEAC Meeting dtd. 13.10.2011 for prior EC with 23 special conditions



- ii. Copy of the lease agreement between PP and State of MP in which the mining lease has been extended upto 05.03.2037.

- (8) Thereafter, the case was again discussed in 381<sup>st</sup> SEIAA Meeting dtd. 04.11.2016 and PP/Consultant was invited for presentation. PP/Consultant made a presentation on all aspects of the project and all concerned issues were discussed in detail.

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
- (9) The proposed plantation program was examined and it was found that 39400 trees shall be planted covering an area of 19.911 ha under plantation.
- (10) It was noted that the water requirement is  $11\text{M}^3/\text{day}$  (  $5\text{M}^3/\text{day}$  - Dust Suppression +  $2\text{M}^3/\text{day}$  - Green Belt +  $4\text{M}^3/\text{day}$  - Domestic use), which shall be met by mine sump and groundwater.
- (11) It was noted that the PP has provided the water quality analysis report of Agaria village and found that all parameters are falling under permissible limit.
- (12) The water table varies from 36 m. to 45 m. below ground level in the area around Gram Panchayat Agariya in Tehsil Sihora of Jabalpur district as reported by Sub Engineer, PHE Sub Division Sihora.
- (13) The public hearing was carried out on 02.09.2009 at mine site, Village – Agaria, Tehsil - Sihora District - Jabalpur (MP). Those present have submitted their complaints/suggestions which are reproduced as under :
- Employment should be given to the local villagers.
  - A bypass road should be constructed to avoid Agariya Village.
  - PP should contribute to the religious and social works in the village.
  - Continuous sprinkling of water should be done during the mining/transportation operation.
  - There is a possibility of reduction in the water table and its quality.
  - Adverse impact on the nearby agriculture fields due to mining/transportation operation.
- (14) After deliberation it was observed that the ground water table near the mine site is unclear from the references given in the EIA report (pg 285) and the ground water level indicated in the letter of Sub Engineer, PHE Sub Division Sihora. PP may be asked to submit the ground water table details from the Central Ground Water Board pertaining to the mine site latest by 10.01.2017.
2. **Case No 2356 /2015** Prior Environmental Clearance for **Basalt Stone Quarry** (opencast semi mechanized method) in an area of 1.00 ha. for production capacity of 4,000 cum/year at Khasra No. 206/4 at Village-Ghoghari, Tehsil-Chandiya, District-Umariya (MP) by Shri Mrigendra Singh, Prop., M/s Jai Shree Krishna Stone Crusher, Village-Majholikhurd, Tehsil-Chandiya, Umariya (MP) – 484661


The case was discussed in 284<sup>th</sup> SEIAA meeting dtd.23.01.2016 and recommendations of 255<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting dtd. 02.01.2016 and it was recorded that .....

*"After detailed discussion and recommendations of 255<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting dtd. 02.01.2016, from the coordinates provided by DFO, Umariya the mining site is just 15 m. from the State Highway and in close proximity to the Forest Boundary. As per the mining rules, the distance from the State Highway should be minimum 100 m. Collector, Umariya should re-examine the mining lease as per the M.P. Minor Mineral Rules. Copy to PP."*

The case was further discussed in 376<sup>th</sup> SEIAA meeting where the case was delisted for want of pending information. Collector, Umariya has submitted the desired information on 01.12.2016 and informed that the State Highway is 100 m. from the lease boundary and the forest boundary is 255 m. away from the nearest

  
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lease area (NOC from DFO Umariya was also enclosed). The case is hereby relisted after submission of the information.

Based on the above recommendation, it was decided to grant Prior Environmental Clearance subject to the following specific conditions in addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC-II :-

- I. PP shall not start mining activity before execution of lease agreement.
- II. The depth of the pit shall be as per the Approved Mining Plan.
- III. Before commencing the mining activity, site demarcation should be done leaving 100 m. from the State Highway and 250 m. from the Forest Boundary as a "no mining zone". The demarcation should be done by the Revenue Officials in the presence of Forest, PWD and Mining Officer, Umariya.
- IV. No crusher shall be allowed within the mining lease area.
- V. The entire area shall be fenced and three rows of plantation should be done on the periphery of the boundary.
- VI. Proper sign boards highlighting the dangers of trespassing by the villagers should be installed at four corners of the lease area.

Hence, Prior Environmental Clearance is granted for **Basalt Stone Quarry** (opencast semi mechanized method) in an area of 1.00 ha. for production capacity of 4,000 cum/year at Khasra No. 206/4 at Village-Ghoghari, Tehsil-Chandiya, District-Umariya (MP) **for the lease period to** Shri Mrigendra Singh, Prop., M/s Jai Shree Krishna Stone Crusher, Village-Majholikhurd, Tehsil-Chandiya, Umariya (MP) – 484661.



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4. **Case No. 3077/2015** Prior Environment Clearance for **Sand Quarry** in an area of 5.00 ha. for production capacity of 1,50,000 cum/year at Khasra No. 688 at Village-Gulidand, Tehsil-Kotma, District-Anuppur (MP) by Shri Amit Khampariya, M/s Sonbhadra Tolls, Gardha, Jabalpur (MP)-482003.

The case was discussed in 259<sup>th</sup> SEIAA meeting dtd. 19.11.2015 and recommendations of 205<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting dtd. 20.07.2015 and it was recorded that .....

*"A query was raised in the 226<sup>th</sup> SEIAA meeting dtd. 12.08.2015 to submit the requisite information by 15.09.2015. After detailed discussion it was decided to delist the case as PP & other concerned could not submit the information within the reasonable time. However, on submission of the information by PP the case shall be liable for re-listing. Copy to PP & all concerned.."*


*"From the record available, Mining Officer, Rajgarh has submitted the information about the number of mines in 1000 m. periphery. But in the latest notification information is desired within 500 m. periphery. Mining Officer, Rajgarh should submit the detail of mines in 500 m. periphery showing status of mines like date of sanction, whether operative or not, EC granted or under appraisal etc. Mining Officer, Rajgarh should be asked to submit this information latest by 15.12.2016. Copy to PP."*


PP has submitted the required information of number of mines within 500 m. periphery duly verified by the Mining Officer, Rajgarh.

Based on the above recommendation, it was decided to grant Prior Environmental Clearance subject to the following specific conditions in addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC-II :-

- (i). PP shall not start mining activity before execution of lease agreement.
- (ii). The production capacity shall be limited to the quantity (15000 cum/year) as recommended by SEAC-II.
- (iii). No in-stream mining shall be allowed. The Mining Officer, Rajgarh should ensure that the mining activity is confined only in the dry portion of the river where sand is exposed.
- (iv). The depth of the pit shall be as per Approved Mining Plan and not exceed 3m or normal water level prevalent in the lean season whichever is less.
- (v). The final decision of Hon'ble NGT (CZ) Bhopal and Hon'ble NGT Principal Bench, New Delhi in OA No. 49/2015 (Amarkant Mishra Vs State of MP & others), shall be obligatory on the part of PP.

  
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- (vi). A petition (OA 404/2016, MA 758/2016, MA 920/2016 & MA 1099/2016) has been filed before the Hon'ble NGT (Principal Bench) New Delhi where MP-SEIAA is one of the respondent. Any order by the Hon'ble NGT shall be binding to PP.
- (vii). PP should ensure that no access ramps are made for transportation of sand from the opposite bank of the river.
- (viii). PP should ensure to conserve the existing trees.
- (ix). No transportation shall be permitted within the village.
- (x). Alternate transportation route should be decided in consultation with the local Gram Panchayat.
- (xi). The entire lease area should be properly fenced and boundary stones marked at the site.
- (xii). PP will ensure three row plantation towards the village settlement side in the entire length of suitable species three year old to conserve and retain the banks.

Hence, Prior Environmental Clearance is granted for **Sand Quarry** (Open cast manual method) in an area of 24.00 ha. for production capacity of 15000 cum/year at Khasra No.-01, Village.-Naiheda, Tehsil-Rajgarh, District-Rajgarh (MP) **for the lease period to Shri Jaswant Singh S/o Shri Suraj Singh Ghosi, Villages-Naiheda, Tehsil-Rajgarh, District-Rajgarh (MP)-465693.**



Based on the above recommendation, it was decided to grant Prior Environmental Clearance subject to the following specific conditions in addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC-II :-

- I. PP shall not start mining activity before execution of lease agreement.
- II. The depth of the pit shall be as per the Approved Mining Plan.
- III. Before commencing the mining activity, site demarcation should be done leaving 100 m. (excluding the 7.5 m. barrier zone) from the HFL of the water body and 100 m. from the road as a "no mining zone". The demarcation should be done by the Revenue Officials in the presence of WRD, Works Department and Mining Officer, Khandwa.
- IV. No crusher shall be allowed within the mining lease area.
- V. The entire area shall be fenced and three rows of plantation should be done on the periphery of the boundary.

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- VI. Proper sign boards highlighting the dangers of trespassing by the villagers should be installed at four corners of the lease area.
- VII. Garland drain all around mining lease area including the settling tank shall be constructed by the PP as per the recommendation of SEAC.
