Ltd., Sub Lessee of MPSMCL, Shri Litesh Jha, Authorized Signatory, H.I.G.D.-5, Dindayal Nagar, Phase-1, Kanth Road, Muradabad (UP)-462001.

PP has submitted a representation that the production capacity of 509280 cum/year was approved in the mining plan, however in the EC issued it has been reduced to 440000 cum/year (as per SEAC recommendation), he has requested for a review in the production capacity. From the record, PP has applied for a production capacity of 509280 cum/year and the mining plan was approved for 509280 cum/year.
