

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2. **Case No. 3512/15-** Prior Environmental Clearance for **Sand Mine** in an area of 10.555 ha. for production capacity of 1,84,000 cum/year at Khasra No.-126, Vill.-Raipura, Teh.-Hoshangabad, District-Hoshangabad (MP) by Shri Vaibhav Sharma R/o 123, Magalwara Ward No. 2, Jagdishpura, Hoshangabad (MP)-461001.


The case was discussed in 385th SEIAA meeting dtd. 16.11.2016 and the Prior EC was granted with the following specific conditions


"Based on the above recommendation, it was decided to grant Prior Environmental Clearance subject to the following specific conditions in addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC-II :-

- (i). *PP shall not start mining activity before execution of lease agreement.*
- (ii). *The production capacity shall be limited to the quantity as recommended by SEAC-II.*
- (iii). *No in-stream mining shall be allowed. The Mining Officer, Hoshangabad should ensure that the mining activity is confined only in the dry portion of the river where sand is exposed.*
- (iv). *The depth of the pit shall be as per Approved Mining Plan and not exceed 3m or normal water level prevalent in the lean season whichever is less.*
- (v). *The final decision of Hon'ble NGT (CZ) Bhopal and Hon'ble NGT Principal Bench, New Delhi in OA No. 49/2015 (Amarkant Mishra Vs State of MP & others), shall be obligatory on the part of PP.*
- (vi). *A petition (OA 404/2016, MA 758/2016, MA 920/2016 & MA 1099/2016) has been filed before the Hon'ble NGT (Principal Bench) New Delhi where MP-SEIAA is one of the respondent. Any order by the Hon'ble NGT shall be binding to PP.*
- (vii). *SEAC has put a condition for obtaining Wild Life Clearance from NWLB and PP has submitted on-line application also. No mining activity shall commence till the Wild Life Clearance is given by the National Board for Wild Life. The OM dated 02.12.2009 shall be applicable in this particular case. Mining Officer, Indore shall be responsible for compliance.*
- (viii). *Grant of environmental clearance does not necessarily implies that forestry and wildlife clearance shall be granted to the project and that their proposals for forestry and wildlife clearance will be considered by the respective authorities on their merits and decision taken.*
- (ix). *PP should ensure that no access ramps are made for transportation of sand from the opposite bank of the river.*
- (x). *PP should ensure to conserve the existing trees.*
- (xi). *No transportation shall be permitted within the village.*
- (xii). *Alternate transportation route should be decided in consultation with the local Gram Panchayat.*
- (xiii). *The entire lease area should be properly fenced and boundary stones marked at the site.*
- (xiv). *PP will ensure three row plantation towards the village settlement side in the entire length of suitable species three year old to conserve and retain the banks."*

The case was further discussed in 397th SEIAA meeting dtd. 24.12.2016 based on the letter submitted by the PP regarding the actual distance of Ratapani Sanctuary from the mining lease area.....

"PP has submitted a letter dated 22.12.2016 regarding the distance of Ratapani Sanctuary from the mining lease area. Since the matter is subjudice before the Hon'ble NGT (Principal Bench) New Delhi, therefore the case can't be perused till the final orders. However for internal appraisal,


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the case may be referred to SEAC alongwith the letter and the file for examining the actual distance from the Ratapani Sanctuary. Copy to PP.."

This case was discussed and recommendation in 66th SEAC-II meeting dtd. 06.02.2017 and it was recorded as under :-

".....SEIAA vide their letter no. 4972SEIAA/17 dated 11/01/2017 has sent back the file stating that "PP has submitted a letter dated 22/12/2016 regarding the distance of Ratapani Sanctuary from the mining lease area. Since the matter is sub judicious before the Hon'ble NGT (Principal Bench), New Delhi, therefore the case cannot be perused till the final orders. However, for internal appraisal, the case may be referred to SEAC along with the letter and the file for examining the actual distance from the Ratapani Sanctuary and the same was placed before the committee.

Committee observed that in this case following three different certificates are issued by competent authority:

Committee after deliberations decided that committee has no mechanism to examine the actual distance from the Ratapani Sanctuary. However, the cases are examined on the basis of certificated issued by the competent authorities and the last certificate issued by the competent authority should prevail.

M.P. State Mining Corporation has submitted a letter No. 1020 dated 02.03.2017 to SEIAA annexing a copy of the NOC given by PCCF (Wild Life) and Chief Wild Life Warden (L.No. 1274 dtd. 28.02.2017) to confirm the distance of mining lease from Ratapani Sanctuary to be 12.362 km. (SMC-0237 and Case No. 3512/2015 as per SEIAA's registration) which is recorded as under :

"संदर्भित पत्र क्रमांक -2 के संबंध में वनमण्डलाधिकारी, औबेदुल्लागंज सामान्य वनमण्डल द्वारा जांच कर रेत खदान रायपुर-4 समूह कोड-SMC008 मेसर्स शिवम इंटरप्राइजेस शिवाजी नगर भोपाल तथा रायपुर-26 समूह कोड-SMC 0237 मेसर्स श्री वैभव शर्मा, जगदीशपुरा, होशंगाबाद को स्वीकृत खदानों की रातापानी अभ्यारण के निकटतम कक्ष क्रमांक 984 से दूरी क्रमशः 10.507 कि. मी. तथा 12.362 कि.मी. सत्यापित कर अवगत कराया गया है। पत्र में उक्त खदानों के अक्षांश-देशांश दर्शाये गये हैं। सुलभ संदर्भ हेतु पत्र की छायाप्रति संलग्न प्रेषित है। संदर्भित पत्र क्रमांक-1 में उल्लेखित शेष 29 खदानों के अक्षांश देशांश की जानकारी मार्निंग ऑफिसर होशंगाबाद से अपेक्षित होना बताया गया है। उक्त जानकारी प्राप्त होने पर पृथक से अवगत कराया जायेगा। वनमण्डलाधिकारी, औबेदुल्लागंज सामान्य वनमण्डल द्वारा प्रेषित प्रतिवेदन एवं उनके द्वारा जांच कर रेत खदानों से अभ्यारण की सत्यापित दूरी से इस कार्यालय की सहमति व्यक्ति कर सूचनार्थ एवं आवश्यक कार्यवाही हेतु प्रेषित है।"

As per the DFO, Obedullaganj report (L.No. 369 dtd. 22.02.2017) regarding the longitude and latitude of the said site for which the NOC has been issued are as under :

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Since PCCF (Wild Life) and Chief Wildlife Warden has confirmed 12.362 km. distance of mining lease having longitude & latitude (1. 22°45'31.07"N 77°46'53.34"E, 2. 22°45'35.51"N 77°47'13.69"E, 3. 22°45'42.00"N 77°47'11.31"E, 4. 22°45'38.95"N 77°46'49.63"E) from Ratapani Sanctuary as certified by Mining Officer, Hoshangabad. Hence condition no. viii & ix given in Prior EC are hereby withdrawn subject to the conditions that PP will withdraw their online application from NBWL duly verified by them after submitting the latest NOC of PCCF (Wild Life) and Chief Wild Life Warden, GoMP regarding distance of mining lease area from Ratapani Sanctuary and submit the withdrawal letter of NBWL to SEIAA.

However the mining activity shall not commence at the mining site till the final outcome of Case No. 404/2016 under hearing with the Hon'ble NGT (Principal Bench) New Delhi. Mining Officer, Hoshangabad shall be responsible to oversee that PP or his representative shall adhere to this condition strictly.

3. **Case No.-5494/2016** Prior Environmental Clearance for **Sand Quarry** (Open cast manual method) in an area of 5.50 ha. for production capacity of 2800 cum /year at Khasra no. 194 at Village- Kumharra, Tehsil - Mungaoli, Dist. Ashoknagar (MP) by Mr. Shivendra Singh Dangi, Gram Kukawali Tehsil Mungaoli, District Ashoknagar, MP – 473443.

This case was recommended in 66th SEAC meeting dtd. 06.02.2017 and it was recorded that :-

.....The case was presented by the PP and their consultant and during presentation it was observed by the Google image of Feb.2016 based on the co-ordinates provided by the PP that approx. 50% of the lease area is submerged in water body. PP submitted that sand is available and can be evacuated as the quantity is very less i.e. only 2800 cum/year. It was also observed that a stop dam is in existence but at a distance of 280 meters. The other submissions made by PP were found satisfactory and acceptable and thus the committee decided to recommend the case for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions in addition to the standard conditions at annexure 'B':

Based on the above recommendation, it was decided to grant Prior Environmental Clearance subject to the following specific conditions in addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC-II :-

- (i). PP shall not start mining activity before execution of lease agreement.
- (ii). The production capacity shall be limited to the quantity (2800 cum/year) as recommended by SEAC-II.
- (iii). No in-stream mining shall be allowed. The Mining Officer, Ashoknagar should ensure that the mining activity is confined only in the dry portion of the river where sand is exposed.
- (iv). The depth of the pit shall be as per Approved Mining Plan and not exceed 3m or normal water level prevalent in the lean season whichever is less.
- (v). The final decision of Hon'ble NGT (CZ) Bhopal and Hon'ble NGT Principal Bench, New Delhi in OA No. 49/2015 (Amarkant Mishra Vs State of MP & others), shall be obligatory on the part of PP.
- (vi). PP should ensure that no access ramps are made for transportation of sand from the opposite bank of the river.

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- (vii). PP should ensure to conserve the existing trees.
- (viii). No transportation shall be permitted within the village.
- (ix). Alternate transportation route should be decided in consultation with the local Gram Panchayat.
- (x). The entire lease area should be properly fenced and boundary stones marked at the site.
- (xi). PP will ensure three row plantation towards the village settlement side in the entire length of suitable species three year old to conserve and retain the banks.

Hence, Prior Environmental Clearance is granted for **Sand Quarry** (Open cast manual method) in an area of 5.50 ha. for production capacity of 2800 cum /year at Khasra no. 194 at Village- Kumharra, Tehsil - Mungaoli, Dist. Ashoknagar (MP) **for the lease period to Mr. Shivendra Singh Dangi, Gram Kukawali Tehsil Mungaoli, District Ashoknagar, MP – 473443.**

4. **Case No. 3653/15** Prior Environmental Clearance for **Flag Stone Quarry** in an area of 3.00 ha. for production capacity of **40,000 cum/year**(as per revised Form-I) at Khasra No.- 4157, 4158, 4174, & 4175, Vill.-Parsen, Tehsil-Gwalior, District-Gwalior (MP) by Shri Ramniwas Sharma S/o Shri Sriram Sharma, E-25, New Vivekanand Colony, Thatipur, Murar, Gwalior (MP)-475001.

This case was recommended in 66th SEAC meeting dtd. 06.02.2017 and it was recorded that :-

.....The case was placed in meeting for discussion, wherein PP and their consultant remains absent. Further during scrutiny of document it was observed by the committee that PP vide letter dated-2/12/2016 had requested to transfer this case to DEIAA as the lease area is < 5ha and sanctioned before 9/9/2013 & thus does not fall under the pervue of cluster as per the MOEF Notification dated 1/07/2016. Committee further observed that as per Director, Geology and Mining, Bhopal letter no. 16670-73 dated 21/10/2011, the lease is sanctioned from 01/11/2007 to 30/09/2017. Hence committee after discussion and deliberations' decided to forward this case to DEIAA through SEIAA on request of PP (vide letter dated 2/12/2016) as the lease is sanctioned prior to 09/09/2013 considering the MoEF&CC notification dated 01/07/2016.

As per the above observation, it has been decided to transfer the case to DEIAA, Gwalior with the following condition :-

1. Chairman DEIAA, Gwalior should review the number of mines and its area within 500 m. periphery and its ramifications according to the latest MoEF&CC circular of 01.07.2016.

Ltd., P-4, Lal Bahadur Nagar, Durgapura, Jaipur (Raj.)

This case was recommended in 66th SEAC meeting dtd. 06.02.2017 and it was recorded that :-

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.....PP vide letter vide letter dated 30/12/2016 has submitted the response on above queries which was placed before the committee. The committee after deliberations decided that the reply submitted by the PP is satisfactory and acceptable and thus the committee decided to recommend the case for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions in addition to the standard conditions at annexure 'B':

Based on the above recommendation, it was decided to grant Prior Environmental Clearance subject to the following specific conditions in addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC-II :-

- (i). This EC will be subject to the Hon'ble NGT, Principal Bench, New Delhi final orders in OA No. 404/2016. No mining operation shall commence on the lease area till the final orders are issued. Mining Officer, Bhind shall be responsible to oversee that PP or his representative shall adhere to this condition.

6. **Case No. - 2483/2015** Prior Environmental Clearance for Sand Quarry in an area of 10.00 ha for production capacity of 10,000 cum/year at Khasra No.-34, at Village-Piplod Purani, Tehsil-Shujalpur, District-Shajapur(M.P.) by Shri Rajesh Rathore , S/o Shri Prem Narayan Rathore R/o Village-Talen, District- Rajgarh (M.P.).

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This case was recommended in 66th SEAC meeting dtd. 06.02.2017 and it was recorded that :-

.....Today, the case was again scheduled for the presentation today but neither the Project Proponent (PP) nor his representative was present to explain the query which might be raised or to make any commitment which may be desired by the committee during the deliberation. Earlier PP was also absent in the 54th and 61st SEAC II meeting. Committee decided that since sufficient opportunities have been given to the PP for appraisal and consideration of the project wherein PP remain absent, the case shall be returned to SEIAA for delisting assuming that PP is not interested to continue with the project.

As per the above observation the case is hereby delisted, PP and all concerned may be informed accordingly.





Committee also observed that the query raised by SEIAA vide letter no. 5170/SEIAA/17 dated 01/02/2017 probably based on the mine plan submitted by PP along with the Form-1 on dated 04/04/2015 (forwarded by SEIAA) which is not approved by the competent authority. Committee after deliberations decided that the case may be sent to SEIAA for necessary action with above clarifications..

From the google map of Nov. 2016, 80% of the area appears to be submerged under water. The spot location google map print should be sent alongwith the file to SEAC for clarification on the availability of sand in 7.5 ha. area (220000 cum/year). Copy to PP.

23. **Case No. 3704/15** Prior Environmental clearance for **Sand Quarry** (Open cast manual method) in an area of 24.400 ha. for production capacity of 2,40,000 cum/year at Khasra No. 410 at Village-Niwsairidiya, Tehsil-Roun, District-Bhind (MP) by M/s Amit Raghuwanshi, 337, Ward No. 15, Dayanand, District-Shivpuri (MP)-473551

This case was recommended in 66th SEAC meeting dtd. 06.02.2017 and it was recorded that :-

.....PP vide letter vide letter dated 30/12/2016 has submitted the response on above queries which was placed before the committee. The committee after deliberations decided that the reply submitted by the PP is satisfactory and acceptable and thus the committee decided to recommend the case for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions in addition to the standard conditions at annexure 'B':

Based on the above recommendation, it was decided to grant Prior Environmental Clearance subject to the following specific conditions in addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC-II :-

- (i). This EC will be subject to the Hon'ble NGT, Principal Bench, New Delhi final orders in OA No. 404/2016. No mining operation shall commence on the lease area till the final orders are issued. Mining Officer, Bhind shall be responsible to oversee that PP or his representative shall adhere to this condition.
- (ii). PP shall not start mining activity before execution of lease agreement.
- (iii). The production capacity shall be limited to the quantity (240000 cum/year).
- (iv). No in-stream mining shall be allowed. The Mining Officer, Bhind should ensure that the mining activity is confined only in the dry portion of the river where sand is exposed.
- (v). The depth of the pit shall be as per Approved Mining Plan and not exceed 3m or normal water level prevalent in the lean season whichever is less.
- (vi). The final decision of Hon'ble NGT (CZ) Bhopal and Hon'ble NGT Principal Bench, New Delhi in OA No. 49/2015 (Amarkant Mishra Vs State of MP & others), shall be obligatory on the part of PP.
- (vii). PP should ensure that no access ramps are made for transportation of sand from the opposite bank of the river.
- (viii). No transportation shall be permitted within the village.
- (ix). Alternate transportation route should be decided in consultation with the local Gram Panchayat.
- (x). The entire lease area should be properly fenced and boundary stones marked at the site.
- (xi). PP will ensure three row plantation towards the village settlement side in the entire length of suitable species three year old to conserve and retain the banks.

Hence, Prior Environmental Clearance is granted for **Sand Quarry** (Open cast manual method) in an area of 24.400 ha. for production capacity of 2,40,000 cum/year at Khasra No. 410 at Village.-Niwsairidiya, Tehsil-Roun, District-Bhind (MP) **for the lease period to** M/s Amit Raghuwanshi, 337, Ward No. 15, Dayanand, District-Shivpuri (MP)-473551.
