

Since then PP has neither submitted the desired information nor has requested for providing additional time to submit desired information and thus decided that this case may be recommended for delisting to SEIAA as per MoEF&CC OM No. F-11013/5/2009-IA-II (Part) dated 30/10/2012 as PP has not submitted the desired information and pending since long.".....

As per the above observation, it has been decided to delist the case on the condition that if PP intends to present the case in SEAC, it will then be relisted for appraisal. Copy to PP and all concerned.

After detailed discussion and perusal of the recommendations of 287<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting dated 25-02-17 and it was recorded that .....

....."Committee after deliberations decided that above clarification may be sent to SEIAA for necessary action confirming that PP has started construction on site which was also evident from the actual site photographs taken during inspection and appended with the report showing the ongoing construction activity at site. However, no recommendations were made for violation as per MoEF OM dated 12/12/2012 as this OM was quashed by the Hon'ble NGT in O.A. NO. 37 OF 2015 (M.A. NO. 291, 293 & 294 OF 2015) and O.A. NO. 213 OF 2014 (MA 755 of 2014 & M.A. No. 177 of 2015) in the matter of S.P. Muthuraman S/o. Ponnusamy, Tirunelveli District in their judgment dated 07/07/2015 as per available records with SEAC".....

As per the above observation cases pertaining to violation will now be dealt at Central level and a policy decision has been taken in the 417<sup>th</sup> SEIAA meeting dtd. 20.03.2017.

This case has already been identified as a violation case and therefore it should be included in the list of violation cases being sent to MoEF&CC in furtherance of the notification dated 14.03.2017. Now this case is hereby closed and now no further action is required to be taken.




