- Case No. 2466/2015, Prior Environmental Clearance for Jamuni Khurd Limestone & Dolomite Mine (Opencast Other than Fully Mechanized Method) in an area of 4.420 ha. for production Capacity 1,00,000 TPA at Khasra Nos.- 54, 55, 56, 60, 61 Vill.- Jamuni Khurd Teh.-Vijayraghogarh, District-Katni (M.P.) by M/s. S.N.S Minerals, Shri Hemansu Kothari Nominated owner R/o N.H.-7, Rewa Road P.O. Maihar District Satna (M.P.) 485771
 - (1) This is a project pertaining to mining of **Limestone & Dolomite Mine** in MLA of 4.420 ha. The activity is mentioned at S.No. 1 (a) of the Schedule of EIA Notification 2006 as amended from time to time. The project is reported to be at a distance of more than 10 km from National Park /Sanctuary etc. and forest boundary is more than 250 m distance from the ML area. The interstate boundary is not applicable as mining site falls in Jamuni Khurd Teh.-Vijayraghogarh, District-Katni (M.P.), thus it is not attracted by the general conditions and falls under category 'B-1" by virtue of its location and mining lease area. The case was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal of EIA for environment clearance for the project. It was submitted that this is a proposed mine having valid lease for 30 years with production 1,00,000 TPA
 - (2) It was reported that the previous lease was granted for 10 year (from 07.04.1993 to 06.04.2003) in fever of Shri Madan Lal Grover thereafter lease was transferred to M/s. S.N.S Minerals, R/o N.H.-7, Rewa Road P.O. Maihar District Satna (M.P.) by Minerals Resources Deportment Govt. of MP vide letter no. F3-17/08/12/2 dtd.23.02.2012. Now the lease period was extended to 20 years from (07.04.2003 to 06.04.2023). The Mining scheme with progressive mine closure plan has been approved by IBM (vide Letter. No. MP/Katni/Limestone/M.Sch.-31/14-15/5080 dtd. 23.09.2014).
 - (3) The case was recommended in 59th SEAC -II meeting dtd 07.03.2017 with 16 special conditions.
 - (4) The case was then discussed in 418th SEIAA meeting dtd 23.03.2017 and PP/Consultant was invited for presentation. Thereafter, PP/Consultant made a presentation on all aspects of the project and all concerned issues were discussed in detail.

- (5) The proposed plantation program was examined and it was found that 3600 sampling of tree species shall be planted including greenbelt in an area of 1.22 ha during the lease period.
- (6) It was also noted that the Public Hearing was carried out on 16.09.2016 at mine site, Vill.- Jamuni Khurd Teh.-Vijayraghogarh, District-Katni (M.P.) The commitments made in the public hearing are to be fulfilled by PP.
- (7) It was noted that the water requirement is 15 KLD (09 KLD Dust Suppression 2.0 KLD Plantation + 4.0 KLD Drinking and domestic purpose), 4.0 KLD shall be obtain from Gram Panchyat Khirwa No-2 (village are Padrehi, jamunikhurd, Khirwa No-2) 11 KLD met from nearby already existed mine sumps or pond.
- (8) PP shall demarcate a barrier zone of 7.5 m as no mining zone in the periphery of mining lease area and develop a green belt. The three row plantation shall be carried out in the greenbelt area in current year
- (9) PP has committed that out of 4.420 ha lease area, only 3.6 ha area is mineable.
- (10) Total 6300 sapling of trees shall be planted during lease period. 2780 in backfill area & 1000 in barrier zone will be planted in the current year
- (11) Garland drains (1085m x 2m x 1.5m) with 04 settling pits RCC/ Concrete size (20-25m x 6m x 3m) settling pits shall be provided to avoid silt discharge. As proposed, connected with garland drains shall be provided for proper sedimentation.
- (12) The budget provision of Rs.17.0 lakh is made for construction of 700 m tar road from mining site to main road. DFO Satna will ensure Pakka road shall not be allowed in Forest area & transportation is restricted from forest area.
- (13) 6 m. high solid curtain wall of steel sheets all around the periphery of the lease area would be constructed before start mining activity. It should be monitored by Mining Officer Satna
- (14) PP has committed to provide Mask & Muff for workers
- (15) Proper infrastructure with shelter, drinking water, toilet and first-aid facilities shall be provided for the 75 labourers. A provision shall be made to construct a 1000 sqm. shed with toilet and drinking water facility.
- (16) PP shall undertake muffle blasting operation only during day time.
- (17) After deliberation the case was discussed in depth and PP was asked to submit the following information :
 - Source of water with consent of owners
 - Revised plan of EMP including construction of Pakka road, curtain & plantation during first year
 - · Revised budget of CSR plan of 5.0 lakh
 - CGWB report regarding ground water table of Jamuni Khurd village
 - Consent of all land owners.

 Details of existing trees with species, height and gerth in Barrier zone, non-mining zone & mining zone.

M/s Fortune Stone Ltd. has submitted a request for revalidation of environmental clearance for amalgamating the two lease areas of Case No. 885/2012 and 886/2012 measuring 21.736 ha. and 6.0 ha. respectively. They have also obtained the NOC of the Director, Geology & Mining, GoMP vide L. No. 2591 dated 15.02.2016. PP has also submitted a similar case of amalgamation of mine lease of M/s Shri Rai Bhadur Seth Shreeram Narsingdas Pvt. Ltd. (State of Karnatka) wherein amendment in EC has been done in the 6th EAC meeting dated 23-24 May 2016. After detail discussions and perusal of the MoEF&CC Notification 14-09-2006, no such procedure or process of these kind of amalgamation has been spelled out, therefore it is decided to forward the application to MoEF&CC for giving appropriate directions in this case.
