1. **Case No.5444/2016** Prior EC for proposed expansion of Mini Steel Plant from 40000 MTPA to 2,00,000 MTPA of Billets & TMT Iron Bars at Plot no. 460,461,& 475 Sector-3 Industrial Area Pithampur District - Dhar,(M.P.) Land Area- 31000 sq.m. Existing Capacity- Ms Ingots, Bar & Casting- 40000 MTPA by M/s Shivangi Rolling Mills Pvt. Ltd, through Director, Divyansgu Bansal,305-306, Airen Heights, B/h Pakiza, 14, PU-3, Commercial, Vijay Nagar, AB Road, Indore, MP - 452010 email:shivangi111@yahoo.in Ph- 0731-4208995 Env't. - (1) The proposed project is expansion of Mini Steel Plant from 40,000 MTPA to 2,00,000 MTPA of Billets & TMT Iron Bars (Existing Capacity- 40000 MTPA Proposed expansion capacity- 1,60,000 MTPA).
- (2) The proposed production capacity is more than 30,000 (using induction arc furnace) hence project is covered under 3 (a) category of the MoEF, GoI EIA Notification 2006 and its amendments.
- (3) There is no inter-state boundary within 05 km and no Wildlife Sanctuaries, National Parks, and Tiger Reserves within 05 km of the boundary hence, general conditions are not attracted.



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- (4) The ToR was issued to PP by SEAC (dtd 19.01.2017) and EIA was submitted by PP (dtd 20.03.2017).
- (5) The case was discussed in 284th SEAC meeting dated 26/11/2016 & 285th SEAC Meeting dated 26/12/2016 and 288th meeting dtd. 30.03.2017 is recommended for grant of prior EC subject to 20 special conditions.
- (6) The case was also discussed in 423th SEIAA meeting dtd. 24.04.2017, and decided to PP may call for presentation.
- (7) After deliberations by PP the case was discussed in depth & it is noted that:
- (i) PP has submitted compliance report of Consent (letter dtd.23.02.17) issued by MPPCB Regional Office, Bhopal for the existing project. As per the consent report the implementation of environmental parameters are found satisfactory and some compliance are in progress.
 - (ii) PP has submitted amended copy of registered lease deed dated 30.10.2010 & earlier lease deed (dtd.14.05.2003) between MD, Industrial Infrastructure Development Corporation (Indore) and M/s Shivangi Mills Pvt. Ltd. an area of 31000 sq.m. for the period of 30 years (w.e.f. 14.05.2003 to 13.05.2033).
 - (iii) The project is located in notified Industrial area Pithampur, District Dhar (M.P), hence as per GoI, MoEF OM dtd 10.12.14 Public hearing is exempted.
 - (iv) The source of water supply for the project is MPAKVN (agreement dtd. 04.07.2011). The total water requirement for the existing unit is 155 KLD (domestic 5.0 KLD, Cooling water 150.0 KLD). After expansion the total water requirement will be 625 KLD (domestic 25.0 KLD, Cooling Rolling Mill/Softener 600 KLD).
 - (v) The water shall be required only for cooling and domestic purpose hence no industrial effluent shall be discharged. Thus the production process is zero discharge. The total waste water generation for the existing unit is 1.0 KLD (domestic 1.0 KLD). After expansion the total waste water generation will be 22.0 KLD (domestic 22.0 KLD). PP has proposed STP for treatment of domestic waste. The treated water from STP shall be used for gardening and spraying of roads. The softener will be used instead of DM water plant, and the rejects shall be used for slag quenching.
 - (vi) The raw material is being transported from Raipur, Raigarh and from South States, the Factory is well connected with Mhow – Ghatabilload Road, which is well connected with NH-3 & NH-79.
 - (vii) PP has proposed that during the transportation of material, the vehicle does not park for more than 6 hrs. All the internal roads have been made pucca with RCC, and water spraying is in practice.(existing capacity of truck-08 nos/day & proposed capacity- 34 nos/day).
 - (viii) The air emission expected from induction furnace & DG set (500 KVA) & Fugitive Emission. For control of air emission, PP has proposed the following arrangement:-

- (ix) The solid waste generated from the process namely plant dust, mill scale, papers etc (5.0 TPA) shall be sold to local vendor. The Iron Slag (12000 TPA) generated from process will be reused in furnace and in civil work & bricks manufacturing. The spent resin from softener plant and spent oil from DG sets will be sold to MPPCB authorized vendors/agencies.
- (x) PP has proposed roof top rain water harvesting (4,000 sq.m.) for recharging of ground water.
- (xi) Storm water drains have been provided to avoid flooding in the project site area and provision has been made for runoff get diverted to recharge pits.
- (xii) PP has included disaster management plan, fire fighting provisions in the EIA report.
- (xiii) PP has submitted at present around 2160 sq.m. area has been developed as green belt by planting 1500 odd nos. of species. After expansion PP has proposed to plant approx 2000 nos of trees and shrubs of various types that include Neem, Sisham, Gulmohar, etc., approx. 1000 Nos of the species of the similar variety will be planted at the periphery of the premises. The company will cover 8070 sq. m. of land with plantation/greenbelt, thus total green area would be 10230 sqm
- (xiv) Under CSR activities PP has proposed Infrastructure development through MPAKVN, health check-up camps, campaign against plastic in Indore, Tobacco etc. Fencing nearby Graveyard, Cleaning of nearby Pond' Training to nearby tribal youth to provide them employment in the plant and construction of 4 nos. of toilet in village Sulawad with budgetary provision of Rs. 6,70,000.

It is decided to accept the recommendations of 288th SEAC meeting dtd 30.03.2017 with 20 special conditions and accord Prior Environmental Clearance for Expansion of Mini Steel Plant from 40,000 MTPA to 2,00,000 MTPA of Billets & TMT Iron Bars at Plot no. 460,461,& 475 Sector-3 Industrial Area Pithampur District - Dhar,(M.P.) Land Area- 31000 sq.m. Existing Capacity- Ms Ingots, Bar & Casting- 40000 MTPA by M/s Shivangi Rolling Mills Pvt. Ltd, through Director, Divyansgu Bansal,305-306, Airen Heights, B/h Pakiza, 14, PU-3, Commercial, Vijay Nagar, AB Road, Indore, MP – 452010 subject to following specific conditions imposed by SEIAA :-

- (1) The entire demand of fresh water should be met through AKVN supply and there should be no extraction of ground water.
 - (2) PP should ensure zero waste water discharge from the process.
 - (3) PP should ensure air pollution control measure as proposed in EMP and should conduct regular monitoring of stack emissions and ambient air as per MPPCB / CPCB norms. For regular monitoring of air emission PP should installed ambient air monitoring stations.
 - (4) PP should ensure the disposal of hazardous waste through authorized agencies and obtained consents from competent Authorities.
 - (5) Raw material should be unloaded from raw material yard only through main road to avoid traffic congestion and accident.
 - (6) PP should ensure entire roof top area of plant should be used for rain water harvesting for ground water recharge with 02 nos of recharging pit.
 - (7) The concrete road of the site area should be regularly cleaned.
 - (8) PP should obtain NOC for fire and approval for onsite offsite emergency plan, health and safety plan from the Competent Authorities.
 - (9) Under green area development PP should ensure : -
 - (a) Plantation in three rows all along the periphery of the project area, and along the roads, subject to minimum of 33% of the total area of the project with budgetary provision of Rs12.50 lakh.
 - (b) Plantation of the trees of indigenous local varieties like Neem, Peepal, Kadam, Karnj, Kachnaar etc.
 - (c) Periphery Plantation (750 nos of trees) should be completed within one year within the plant premises.
 - (d) Every effort should be made to protect the existing trees on the plot.
 - (10) PP should ensure implementation of CSR activity of Rs. 10.0 lakh in consultation with Collector, Dhar and ensure to submit one copy of the proposal in SEIAA.
 - (11) PP should ensure preference should be given to local tribal youth to fulfill the man power requirement.
 - (12) PP should ensure all the raw material including scrap, coal, slag, sludge and oily waste shall be stored separately in designated place.
 - (13) Monthly monitoring should be done of all the environmental parameters and Environmental Management Cell meeting should be carried out every month.

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Hon'ble NGT (CZ) in its Order No. 29 dated 21.04.2017 has directed SEIAA to carry out fresh inspection of the site in response to the compliance affidavit submitted by the PP :

It is prayed by the Learned Counsel for the Respondent No. 1 that the SEIAA may be directed to carry out a fresh inspection. We direct that the expert committee which was earlier constituted and which carried out the inspection on 06.02.2016 shall as far as possible with the same Members or in case some of the Members are not available the committee be reconstituted by the Chairman, SEIAA for carrying out the inspection of the hospital and the Medical College for the purposes of ascertaining whether the EC can be granted or not. Since the matter involves the fate of 150 students who have been admitted by the oversight committee constituted by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, we direct that the Chairman, SEIAA to carry out the aforesaid task as soon as possible and submit the report before this Tribunal with its recommendations on the next date of hearing

In the earlier action, the case was discussed in 417th SEIAA meeting dated 20-03-17 and it was recorded that ..

It has been decided taking cognizance of the above notification, PPs who have violated and identified as violator by SEIAA and those cases which have been kept on hold/abeyance for a final notification should be informed to apply online afresh in the MoEF&CC. All related record and technical files should be properly formatted and collated for onward transfer to MoEF&CC when needed by them. The first list of following 44 violation cases which were put on hold/abeyance will be deemed to have been closed for our record. Necessary modification be done on the website in the "Application Status" field. A copy of the new notification should be displayed at the website of www.mpseiaa.nic.in and necessary instructions be given to SEAC not to appraise and recommend violation cases to SEIAA. SEAC should close the matter as it is and send the file to SEIAA for onward transfer to MoEF&CC.


After detail discussion it has been decided to re-group the same committee members for the site visit and verify the compliance submitted by the PP in response to the directives issued by the Hon'ble NGT (CZ). However, it was also decided that the new notification (14.03.2017) regarding appraisal of violation cases should be submitted before the Hon'ble NGT (CZ) with the prayer that in future it will not be possible by MP-SEIAA to clear the EC in this particular case and now the final decision of granting EC of violation cases rest with the MoEF&CC.

The case was discussed in 71st SEAC-II meeting dated 10-04-17 ToR recommended by SEAC is hereby approved.

6. **Case No. 2110/2014** Prior Environmental Clearance for Stone Quarry in an area of 4.00 ha. for expansion in production capacity from 1000 Cum/Year to 39,900 Cum/Year at Khasra no. 282/5 at Village-Pandhana, Tehsil-Pandhana, District-Khandwa (MP) by Shri Bhagchand Nemnani S/o Shri Manikchand Nemnani, Pandhana, Khandwa (MP)-450337

The case was recommended in 71st SEAC-II meeting dated 10-04-17 and it was recorded that :-

".....The case was again scheduled for presentation today but neither the Project Proponent (PP) nor his representative was present to explain the query which might be raised or to make any commitment which may be desired by the committee during the deliberation. Earlier PP was also absent in the 68th SEAC II meeting dated 06/03/2017. Committee decided that since sufficient opportunities have been given to the PP for appraisal and consideration of the project wherein PP remain absent, the case shall be returned to SEIAA assuming that PP is not interested to continue with the project..

As per the above observation, it has been decided to delist the case on the condition that if PP intends to present the case in SEIAA, it will then be relisted for appraisal. Copy to PP and all concerned.

7. **Case No. – 2839/2015** Prior Environmental Clearance for Sand Quarry (open cast manual method) in an area of 5.850 ha. for production capacity of 73215 cum/year, at Khasra No. – 665, Village-Karoula, Tehsil-Palera, District-Tikamgarh (MP) by Shri Nagendra Singh, OIC, M.P. State Mining Corporation Ltd., Civil Line, Tikamgarh (MP)-472001.


The case was recommended in 71st SEAC-II meeting dated 10-04-17 and it was recorded that :-

".....The site inspection report was discussed in the committee meeting and committee after deliberation decided that the quantity may be revised as per the recommendations of the committee and case may be recommended for grant of EC as the other submissions made by PP were found satisfactory and acceptable subject to the following special conditions in addition to the standard conditions at annexure 'B':

Based on the above recommendation, it was decided to grant Prior Environmental Clearance subject to the following specific conditions in addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC-II :-

- (i). This EC will be subject to the Hon'ble NGT, Principal Bench, New Delhi final orders in OA No. 404/2016.
- (ii). The production capacity shall be limited to the quantity (73215 cum/year).
- (iii). No in-stream mining shall be allowed.

Hence, Prior Environmental Clearance is granted for Sand Quarry (open cast manual method) in an area of 5.850 ha. for production capacity of 73215 cum/year, at Khasra No. – 665, Village-Karoula, Tehsil-Palera, District-Tikamgarh (MP) **for the lease period to Shri Nagendra Singh, OIC, M.P. State Mining Corporation Ltd., Civil Line, Tikamgarh (MP)-472001.**

8. **Case No.4341/15** - Prior Environmental Clearance for Sand Quarry (opencast manual method) in an area of ~~3.699 ha~~ for production capacity of 59,490 cum/year at Khasra no.- 01, Village-Sunari Majrappali, Tehsil-Indargarh, District-Datia (MP) by M/s Esteem Infrabuild Pvt.Ltd., Shri Kailash Chandra Gupta, P-4, Lal Bahadur Nagar, Durgapura, Distt-Jaipur (RJ)-477001.


The case was recommended in 71st SEAC-II meeting dated 10-04-17 and it was recorded that :-


".....SEIAA vide letter no. 5486/SEIAA/2017 dated 07/03/2017 has sent back the file to SEAC for clarification as in the mine plan proposed mining lease area is shown as 5.35 ha whereas in the presentation (production plan) the area suitable for mining is shown as 3.699 ha which was placed before the committee. Committee on perusal of case file observed that the during presentation PP submitted that some part of the mining lease was submerged in water and out of 19.830 ha area, only 3.699 ha area is available for mining which is also evident from the Google image of February, 2016 attached with the same presentation and the same was considered for recommendation during presentation. Since the approved quantity of sand as per the mine plan was 59,490 cum/year with 02 meters depth which can be evacuated from the 3.699 ha thus no reduction in sand volume was considered by the committee. Committee after deliberations decided that above clarification may be sent to SEIAA and committee stands by its recommendation made in the 53rd SEAC II meeting dated 13/10/2016.

Based on the above recommendation, it was decided to grant Prior Environmental Clearance subject to the following specific conditions in addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC-II :-

- (i). This EC will be subject to the Hon'ble NGT, Principal Bench, New Delhi final orders in OA No. 404/2016.
- (ii). The production capacity shall be limited to the quantity (59490 cum/year) from 3.699 ha. which is considered suitable for mining by SEAC.
- (iii). No in-stream mining shall be allowed.

Capacity - 2,25,000 cum/year, at Khasra No.-1/1, Vill.-Cheepaner, Teh.-Timarni, District-Harda (M.P.) by Shri Raj Kumar Nema, OIC, Sub Off., M.P. State Mining Corporation Ltd., H.No. 12, Ward No. 17, Sainath Colony, Meenakshi, Hoshangabad (M.P.)-461001. ,


The case was recommended in 71st SEAC-II meeting dated 10-04-17 and it was recorded that :-

".....SEIAA vide letter no. 5696/SEIAA/17 dated 27/03/2017 has forwarded the representation which was placed before the committee. Committee on perusal of the case file and representation submitted by the Executive Director, SMC regarding the production capacity which has been reduced from 4.50 lacks cum/year to 2.5 lacks cum/year observed that the above decision was taken in the 229th SEAC meeting dated 01/10/2015 wherein the committee has justified the reason for deduction in sand volume. Still with the given coordinates as per the mine plan based on the Google image of May, 2016 the situation remains same as observed by the committee in the 229th SEAC meeting dated 01/10/2015 and as per mine plan entire area of 15.00 ha was considered for sand mining with 03 meters depth without deducting any area of bank stabilization and benches for digging within the lease area. Thus committee after deliberations decided that since the mid stream mining is not allowed, the committee stands by the recommendations made in the 229th SEAC meeting dated 01/10/2015..

As per the above observation of SEAC, no change/modification in the production capacity is now required, since EC in this particular case has already been issued for 2,25,000 cum/year. Copy to PP.

".....SEIAA vide letter no. 5672/SEIAA/17 dated 25/03/2017 has forwarded the representation submitted by PP which was placed before the committee. Committee on perusal of the case file and representation submitted by the PP observed that the production capacity has been reduced from 1.00 lacks cum/year to 40,000 cum/year and observed that the above decision was taken in the 16th SEAC II meeting dated 03/04/2016 wherein the committee has justified the reason for deduction in sand volume. Thus committee after deliberations decided that since the mid stream mining is not allowed, the committee stands by the recommendations made in the 16th SEAC II meeting dated 03/04/2016.



The case was recommended in 71st SEAC-II meeting dated 10-04-17 and it was recorded that :-

".....SEIAA vide letter no. 4487/SEIAA/16 dated 26/11/2016 has sent back the file for reappraisal stating that DFO, Sehore has indicted Ratapani Sanctuary to be 8.15 kms from the mining site and the same was placed before the committee. The committee on perusal of case file and minutes of of the 51st SEAC II meeting dated 11/10/2016 observed that it was clearly mentioned in the minutes of this meeting that "Conservation of forest department vide letter no.2459 dated-03/09/2016 has issued revised DFO certificate and as per the revised certificate the lease area is only 8.150 km away from the RATAPANI Abhayaran (a Notified PA). PP has submitted the copy of online application made for wild life clearance and has applied online for wild life clearance with proposal no. FP/MP/MIN/1056/2015 and date of submission is 09/10/2016". Thus committee after deliberations decided that case may be recommended for grant of EC as per the recommendations of 51st SEAC II meeting dated 11/10/2016 with one additional condition that "EC would be subject to necessary Wild Life Clearance from NBWL to be obtained by PP".

As per the above observation of SEAC, Based on the above recommendation, it was decided to grant Prior Environmental Clearance subject to the following specific conditions in addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC-II :-

- (i). This EC will be subject to the Hon'ble NGT, Principal Bench, New Delhi final orders in OA No. 404/2016.
- (ii). The production capacity shall be limited to the quantity (2,00,000 cum/year) as per mining plan.
- (iii). SEAC has put a condition for obtaining Wild Life Clearance from NWLB and PP has submitted on-line application also. No mining activity shall commence till the Wild Life Clearance is given by the National Board for Wild Life. The OM dated 02.12.2009 shall be applicable in this particular case. Mining Officer, Indore shall be responsible for compliance.
- (iv). Grant of environmental clearance does not necessarily implies that forestry and wildlife clearance shall be granted to the project and that their proposals for forestry and wildlife clearance will be considered by the respective authorities on their merits and decision taken.
- (v). No in-stream mining shall be allowed.
- (vi). The depth of the pit shall be as per Approved Mining Plan.
- (vii). The final decision of Hon'ble NGT (CZ) Bhopal and Hon'ble NGT Principal Bench, New Delhi in OA No. 49/2015 (Amarkant Mishra Vs State of MP & others), shall be obligatory on the part of PP.
- (viii). No transportation shall be permitted within the Hoshangabad Town.
- (ix). Alternate transportation route should be decided in consultation with the local Gram Panchayat.
- (x). The entire lease area should be properly fenced and boundary stones marked at the site.
- (xi). PP will ensure three row plantation towards the village settlement side in the entire length of suitable species three year old to conserve and retain the banks.
