Case No. – 5429/2016** Prior Environment Clearance for **Kailwas Laterite Mine** (Opencast Mechanized Method) in an area of 13.57 Ha., for production capacity of 3,39,168 TPA, at Khasra no. 01, Vill.-Kailwas, Teh.-Majholi, District-Jabalpur (M.P.) by Shri Rituraj Verma R/o Adhartal, Jabalpur (M.P.)

The case was discussed in 427th SEIAA meeting dated 08-05-2017 and it was recorded that :-


The case was discussed in 404th SEIAA meeting dated 24-01-2017 and it was recorded that :-

".....After deliberation the case was discussed in depth and PP was asked to submit the following information :-

- i. MPPCB consent of 2008 with its compliance on notice issued.*
- ii. NOC from Gram Sabha Village Tapa and Khadauli through Collector Jabalpur.*
- iii. Details with specification of steel/Iron teen curtain towards nearest human settlement.*
- iv. Revised CSR & EMP with Budget breakup.*
- v. Ground water table details from the Central Ground Water Board pertaining to the mine site..*

PP has not submitted the desired information, therefore it has been decided to delist the case which shall be liable for relisting once the information is received. Copy to PP and all concerned.

PP has submitted a point wise clarification of the observations listed above. The case was in delisted stage and now since the PP has submitted the desired information, the case is now relisted. On perusal of the information, PP has not submitted the copy of the MPPCB consent 2008 nor clarified whether PCB has issued any notices to the PP. On sr.No. 3 PP has submitted a photo of curtain fencing, but has not included the estimates of constructing the curtain fencing in the EMP. PP may be asked to submit the desired information latest by 10.06.2017.

2. **Case No 4152/2015:** Prior EC for proposed plotted development and construction of group housing project Shivalaya at Khasra No. 1022, 1025, 1026, 1027, 1018/1 1018/210 Village Bijalpur, Tehsil & District Indore, (M.P) by total project area 118320.0 sqm. (net land area for the project 116478.0 sqm.) by M/s Shiv Real Mart Pvt. Ltd. through Director Mr. Kamal Kumar Makhija, 25, Trieveni Colony, Indore – 452001, E-mail srm.kmakhija@gmail.com, phone No. +91-9826069729

The case was discussed in 374th SEIAA meeting dtd 03.10.2016 and it was recorded that :-

It is decided to accept the recommendation of 281st SEAC meeting dtd 01.09.16 and delist the case.

- (i). *If any construction / activity has started by PP without obtaining prior EC under EIA Notification 2006, the PP shall be solely responsible for it and liable for legal action.*
- (ii). *A copy of letter should be sent to Project Proponent, MoEF & CC Gol, New Delhi & Regional Office Bhopal, Member Secretary MPPCB, Secretary SEAC, District Collector, Commissioner Nagar Nigam/CEO Zila Panchayat and all concerned.*
- (iii). *Commissioner Nagar Nigam may be directed to examine whether the building permission has been issued or not. If Building permission has been issued and work has started on the site, PP may be accordingly advised to get EC. If building permission has not been granted, PP may be asked the copy of the EC before proceeding for statutory permission.*


The case is reviewed in the light of the MoEF&CC notification dated 14.03.2017 regarding violation cases and its disposal thereof. From the google map it was observed that the PP has started partial construction on the site and therefore it has been decided to have a site verification from RO, MPPCB Indore to the extent of the work done. Looking to the urgency RO, MPPCB Indore should submit the report latest by 10.06.2017.


3. **Case No. 3298/2015,** Prior Environmental Clearance for **Dolomite Mine** (Opencast Mechanized method) in an area of 13.25 ha for production capacity of 4,59,705 TPA (As per SEAC Recommendation) Khasra Nos. BlockHK1-1399, 1406, 1440, 1441, 1442, 1443, 1444/1-6, 1445, 1446, 1447, 1448, 1489/1-3, 1491, 1492, 1493, 1494, 1495, 1496, 1497 Block HK3- 1425, 1427, 1449/1, 1430, 1431, 1442, 1455/1-2, 1456, 1457, 1458 at Village- Kakiya, Tehsil - Bichiya, Dist. - Mandla (MP) by M/s. Heera Power & Steel Ltd. Shri O.G. Goyal (Executive Director) Plot no. 557, 563 & 564 Ultra Industrial Complex Raipur (CG) – 492003


The case was discussed in 417th SEIAA meeting dtd. 20.03.2017 and it was recorded that :-

After deliberation the case was discussed in depth and PP was asked to submit the following information :-

- i. *A complaint was received in SEIAA from local farmers regarding their objection for permitting access on their land holdings for mining purposes. Letter be written to Collector, Mandla as to what redressal action has been taken on their complaint.*
- ii. *Complete latest Khasra Panchsala details of lease area and consents of the land owners.*
- iii. *Report of the Central Ground Water Board regarding the prevailing ground water table in the mining area.*
- iv. *Detailed overburden dump plan including quantification of top soil.*

- v. Details of Garland drain & settling tanks.
- vi. There are large number of operative mines in the vicinity of said mine. PP should submit the latest report of Air and Water quality monitored by MPPCB.
- vii. Revised budget of EMP incorporating construction and maintenance of road, plantation and fencing.


Collector, Mandla has submitted a letter dated 22.05.2017 mentioning about the latest position regarding the objections raised by the land owners of the area earmarked for mining purposes. However comments have been received from the PP regarding complete latest Khasra Panchsala details of lease area and consents of the land owners. From perusal it appears that all the consents from the land owners have not been obtained. PP may be asked to submit all the consents latest by 15.06.2017.

4. **Case No.-5475/2016** Prior Environmental Clearance for **Sand Auction Quarry** (Open cast manual method) in an area of 6.0 ha. for production capacity of 85,500 cum/ year at Khasra no. 55 (Part) at Village- Mohana, Tehsil - Ajaygarh, Dist. Panna (MP). by M/s Shakti Traders ,Shri Rajendra Kumar Agrawal, Near Jalpa Devi Temple, Jalpa Ward, Katni, MP – 483501.

The Prior EC in this case was issued on 23.01.2017 with specific and general conditions of SEIAA/SEAC for a lease area of 6.00 ha. for a production capacity of 85500 cum/year on the mining plan duly approved by the competent authority. Thereafter a letter has been received from the Collector, Panna on 08.05.2017 that by demarcating the site, it was revealed that there is mismatch in the GPS reading and the lease area. PP has separately submitted a letter 19.05.2017 enclosing a new revised mining plan on the new coordinates. The case was again reexamined today on the basis of a site plan prepared by the Mining Officer, Panna. On further scrutiny of the site plan, it was found that the area mentioned in Form-1 with relative coordinates were allotted to some other company and the area marked to the PP for an area of 6.00 ha. with changed coordinates, the site has deviated from the original site plan. Therefore it has been decided to cancel the EC L.No. 5070/SEIAA/17 dated 23.01.2017 on the grounds mentioned in the Collector, Panna letter and direct the PP to make online submission with the new mining plan afresh in SEIAA. Copy to PP and all concerned.

5. **Case No. 1704/2013** Prior Environmental Clearance for proposed Residential & Commercial Development Project at Plot No. 27, Yashwant Niwas Road, Tehsil & District Indore MP. Total Plot area 12626 sq.m. built up area 63,802.97 sq.m. by M/s Saicharan Properties Ltd., Mr. Sanjay Daga Authorized Signatory, 101, Kalpataru Synergy, Opp. Grand Hyatt, Santacruz, East Mumbai 400055

- (1) EC has been issued to PP Vide letter no. 3615 dtd. 19.02.15.
- (2) An amendment letter regarding minor deviation in built-up area was issued vide letter no. 7770 dtd. 18.11.2015.
- (3) PP has submitted a letter dtd. 20.05.17 that some change in configuration of buildings by reducing floors without changing the total built-up area proposed by PP in prior EC(63,802.97 sq.m.).
- (4) The letter submitted by PP with supporting documents (building permission) and the original application was examined. PP has already started

construction on the site and also submitted the compliance reports till 31.03.2017. Since the changes in the configuration doesn't impact the water supply, sewerage, traffic, solid waste etc. and there is no change in the total builtup area as provided in the EC, therefore no amendment is needed at the stage. PP is advised to get the revised building permission and consent of the MPPCB and submit the same in SEIAA. Any deviation/expansion in the total builtup area permitted in the Prior EC, PP has to obtain fresh EC.
