
This case was recommended in 76th SEAC-II meeting dated 23-05-17 and it was recorded that :-


.....The case was presented by the PP and their consultant wherein as per the Google image it was observed that site is on the hillock with very high gradient. The mining is proposed from east to north and evacuation road is proposed from the southern end of the lease. The committee after discussion suggested that considering the high gradient, bench width should be minimum 06 meters. A tar village road is also passing from the south eastern side of the lease which is approx 40 meters away from the lease area thus PP was asked to leave setback of 10 meters on the south eastern side of the lease excluding 7.5 meters mandatory buffer zone. The EMS and other submissions submitted by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable, hence committee decided to recommend the case for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions in addition to the standard conditions at annexure 'A':

Based on the above recommendation, it was decided to grant Prior Environmental Clearance subject to the following specific conditions in addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC-II :-

- (i) PP shall not start mining activity before execution of lease agreement.
- (ii) The depth of the pit shall be as per the Approved Mining Plan.
- (iii) Before commencing the mining activity, site demarcation should be done leaving 100 m. from the pakka road as a "no mining zone". The demarcation should be done by the Revenue Officials in the presence of Works Department and Mining Officer, Chhatarpur.
- (iv) The entire area shall be fenced and three rows of plantation should be done on the periphery of the boundary.
- (v) Proper sign boards highlighting the dangers of trespassing by the villagers should be installed at four corners of the lease area.

- (vi) PP will construct a steel curtain wall minimum 6 m. high towards the road side periphery to avoid untoward incident.




This case was recommended in 76th SEAC-II meeting dated 23-05-17 and it was recorded that :-


.....The case was presented by the PP and their consultant and during presentation it was observed that a canal is passing approx 200 meters away from the northern side of the lease and since the distance is 200 meters no deduction in minable area is required. However, on the southern side of the lease, a stop dam is in existence which is only 05 meters away and thus 100 meters area should be left from the dam in the lease as non mining area. As per the Google image of Dec-2016 based on the co-ordinates provided by PP that most part of the lease is submerged in water and thus demanded volume of sand cannot be evacuated considering the deduction due to dam and submergence. PP submitted that considering above submergence, a revised production plan has been prepared and as per the revised production plan 1.20 ha area is available for mining and as per the approved depth of 1.5 meter in mine plan 18,000 cum/year of sand can be evacuated. Committee after deliberation decided that since as per the revised production plan 1.20 ha area is available for mining, evacuation of 18,000 cum/year sand can be considered. The other submissions made by PP were found satisfactory and acceptable and thus the committee decided to recommend the case for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions in addition to the standard conditions at annexure 'B':

Based on the above recommendation, it was decided to grant Prior Environmental Clearance subject to the following specific conditions in addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC-II :-

- (i). The production capacity shall be limited to the quantity approved by SEAC.
- (ii). No in-stream mining shall be allowed.
- (iii). Mining should be carried out leaving 100 m. from the existing stop dam as a no mining zone. The river banks should be conserved and plantation be done in three rows. Banks should remain undisturbed.

This case was recommended in 76th SEAC-II meeting dated 23-05-17 and it was recorded that :-

..... The case was presented by the PP and their consultant and during presentation it was observed that a road bridge only 180 meters away is in existence in the southern side of the lease thus 20 meters area should be left from the road bridge in the lease as non mining area. As per the Google image of Dec-2016 based on the co-ordinates provided by PP that parts of the lease at many places is submerged in water and thus demanded volume of sand cannot be evacuated considering the deduction due to Road Bridge and submergence. PP submitted that considering above submergence and Road Bridge, a revised production plan has been prepared and as per the revised production plan 1.80 ha area is available for mining and as per the approved depth of 1.5 meter in mine plan 27,000 cum/year of sand can be evacuated. Committee after deliberation decided that since as per the revised production plan 1.80 ha area is available for mining, evacuation of 27,000 cum/year sand can be considered. The other submissions made by PP were found satisfactory and acceptable and thus the committee decided to recommend the case for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions in addition to the standard conditions at annexure 'B':

Based on the above recommendation, it was decided to grant Prior Environmental Clearance subject to the following specific conditions in addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC-II :-


This case was recommended in 76th SEAC-II meeting dated 23-05-17 and it was recorded that :-

..... Case was presented by PP and their consultant. During presentation, it was observed that a representation vide letter dated 06/09/2016 is submitted which was forwarded by SEIAA vide letter no. 3843/SEIAA/16 dated 3/10/2016 along with Replenishment Plan. As per the representation, revised certificate is issued by the Conservator Forest, Hoshangabad, M.P., stating that Ratapani Abhayaran is at a distance of 9.20 kms (a Notified PA) from Khasra No. 126. Earlier TOR was issued to for this case on the basis of certificate issued by DFO, Hoshangabad, issued vide letter no. 3881 dated 15/04/2015 stating that no notified PA within 10 kms radius. Committee after deliberations decided that since revised certificate is issued by Conservator Forest, Hoshangabad, clearance from NBWL is therefore needed and thus PP was asked to apply online for NBWL clearance and a copy of the application may be submitted to SEAC for further appraisal of the project. During presentation PP has informed that they have applied online for NBWL clearance and submitted a copy of the same. On perusal of the document submitted by PP during presentation, it was observed by the committee that PP has submitted online application for wild life clearance with proposal no. FP/MP/MIN/1056/2016 and date of submission is 09/10/2016 and thus the case was considered for presentation. PP has also submitted the replenishment plan duly approved by the competent authority which was forwarded by SEIAA vide letter no. 3843/SEIAA/16 dated 03/10/2016. After presentation it was observed that the other submissions made by PP were found satisfactory and acceptable and thus the committee decided to recommend the case for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions in addition to the standard conditions at annexure 'B':



lots of green area were observed. PP submitted that these agricultural activities are of seasonal crops such as water melons carried out by local residents of the nearby areas. Committee asked PP to submit revised production plan considering above issues of environmental concerns. PP submitted that along with the presentation they have prepared revised production plan which was placed before the committee for consideration. Committee observed that as per the revised production plan submitted by PP 3.522 ha area is available for mining leaving area submerged under water and safe zone. The approved depth as per the mine plan is 3.0 meters. Thus committee after deliberations decided that considering 3.522 ha area with 3.00 meters depth only 1,05,660 cum/year sand evacuation is possible. The other submissions made by PP were found satisfactory and acceptable and thus the committee decided to recommend the case for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions in addition to the standard conditions at annexure 'B':

As per the above observation of SEAC it is decided to close the case and advise PP to apply afresh. Copy to PP and all concerned.


