- Case No. 5106/2016, Prior Environmental Clearance for Manganese Ore Mine (Underground Fully Mechanized) in an area of 33.00 ha. for expansion in production capacity from 50000 TPA to 80000 TPA at Khasra No. Part 467, 468, 464 & 466 at Village - G.F. Sonewani forest range, Tehsil - Waraseoni, Distt. -Balaghat (MP) by M/s J.K Minerals (Partner), Main Road, Balaghat (MP) - 492001.
  - (1) This is a project pertaining to mining of Manganese Ore Mine in MLA of 33.00 ha. The activity is mentioned at S.N. 1 (a) of the Schedule of EIA Notification 2006 as amended from time to time. The project is reported to be at a distance of more than 10 km from National park and sanctuary etc. and mining activity is proposed on forest land. Department of Forest, Govt. of M.P. (vide their letter no. F-05/36/99/10/3 dtd 28.02.2000) grant NOC to the project on the basis of NOC given by Ministry of Environment , Forests & Climate Change, Government of India (vide lette rno. 8-12/2000 FC dtd 15.02.2000). The interstate boundary of Maharashtra is at 37 km, thus it is not attracted by the general conditions and falls under category 'B-1" by virtue of its location and mining lease area. The case was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal of EIA for environment clearance for the project
  - (2) It was reported by the PP that the lease was sanctioned to J.A. Trivedi Brothers, Balaghat for 10 years from 01.07.1982 to 30.06.1992 and the lease has been renewed for further 07 years from 30.06.1992 to 29.06.1999. The lease was then transferred to M/s J.K. Minerals (vide Mineral Resource Department order no. 3-156/91/12/2 dtd 30.12.1993). Thereafter the lease was further renewed for 20 years from 30.06.1999 in 2001. As per amendment MMRD act 2015 under section 8 A (6) the mining period is now 50 years from sanction of lease date i.e. 01.07.1982 to 29.06.2032 (vide Collector, Balaghat order no. 1040/Khanij/Bala./15 dtd 21.08.2015). The scheme of mining with progressive mine closure plan has been approved by IBM, Office of Regional

Controller of Mines, Nagpur (vide Letter No. IBM letter No. BGT/MN/MPLN - 82/NGP dtd.14.01.2015).

- (3) The case was recommended for prior EC in 78<sup>th</sup> SEAC -II meeting dtd 25.05.2017 with 31 special conditions.
- (4) The case was then discussed in 440<sup>th</sup> SEIAA meeting dtd 08.06.2017 and PP/Consultant was invited for presentation. PP/Consultant made a presentation on all aspects of the project and all concerned issues were discussed in detail.
- (5) After excavation of Manganese ore, sizing will be carried out by crusher. At the mine head, the mineral beneficiation consist of breaking and sizing of ROM, separation in various sizes by screening etc. No chemical process is involved.
- (6) The proposed plantation program was examined and it was found that 15573 trees shall be planted covering an area of 17.455 ha under plantation.
- (7) It was noted that the water requirement is 161 KLD (86 KLD Dust suppression, 30 KLD Green Belt, 18 KLD beneficiation Plant & 27 KLD Domestic Drinking & Washing) which shall be met by mine pit & borewell.
- (8) It was noted that the Public Hearing was held on 16.02.2017 at mine site, at Village – Katangjhari (G.F. Sonewani Forest Range), Tehsil – Waraseoni, Distt. – Balaghat (MP) under Chairmanship of ADM, Balaghat. The major issues raised during public hearing are local employment, social development, plantations, water storage and skill development which were addressed by PP during public hearing.
- (9) After detailed discussions and perusal of recommendations of 78<sup>th</sup> SEAC -II meeting dtd 25.05.2017, presentation made by PP in SEIAA & SEAC, it was decided that to accept the recommendation of SEAC for grant of prior EC to the project subject to the following specific conditions:-
  - I. Before commencing any mining activity fencing shall be carried out all around the lease area. Proper watch and ward arrangements should be made with installation of signage at 4 corners of lease area to avoid any untoward incident involving public and animals by the PP.
  - II. PP shall demarcate a barrier zone of 7.5 m as no mining zone in the periphery of mining lease area and develop a green belt. The two row plantation shall be carried out in the greenbelt area in current year.
  - III. No mining shall be carried out within 50 m from the existing water body on western side.
  - IV. Plantation on 17.455 ha areas with 15573 numbers of trees and additional plantation should be done on both side of the road shall be carried out within the lease area, to lessen the air pollution and enhance aesthetic beauty of the area. Plantation programme as mentioned in EIA/EMP and presented during presentation in SEIAA & SEAC shall be followed in content and spirit.

V. Regular air & water quality monitoring shall be carried out in consultation with RO, MPPCB before pumping out of pull water prior permission should be taken from MPPCB.

- VI. Mining should be done in such a way that the surface shall not be disturbed and no tree cutting will be allowed.
- VII. PP will make pakka/black topped approach road only after getting permission from Forest Department/concerned authority to suppress dust emission.
- VIII. Crusher shall be installed in 25 sq. m area at mining site.
- IX. PP will enhance the power generation capacity through solar power sources. Electrical appliances shall be full proof of fire control.
- X. Plantation shall be carried out as proposed in EMP and the pit of 2x2x2 foot shall be dig and filled by black cotton soil before plantation. The Black cotton soil shall be purchased from outside.
- XI. Fencing and plantation around the mining lease area shall be carried out in the first year.
- XII. List of plants as shown during presentation shall be planted.
- XIII. PP shall ensure the proper water supply arrangements for plantation especially in summer season.
- XIV. PP will make proper garland drain with setting tanks of appropriate size all around the lease area and OB dumps for strom water management. Proper stone pitching shall be carried out in Garland drain and settling tanks. PP shall also ensure the proper slope gradient with cleaning and maintenance of garland drain and settling tank.
- XV. PP shall ensure to construct the shelter for the labours, proper health check-up of workers and payment wages to the workers as per labour laws.
- XVI. Proper infrastructure with toilet facility shall be developed for the labourers.
- XVII. Provision of a vehicle shall be kept at mining site for transportation of workers.
- XVIII. Under CSR activity in addition to the proposed activities following activities should be added:
  - a) Promotion of quality education
  - b) Providing solar street lights to nearby villages viz., Katangjhari, Tola, Pipariya, Sirra tola.
  - c) Free medical camp for nearby villagers
  - d) Establishment of skill development centre at Katangjahri for vocational training to youth and women of nearby viallges.
  - XIX. The CSR activities shall be carried out in consultation with Gram Panchyat and Collector, Balaghat.

XX. The appropriate budget provision shall be made for the CSR activities.

- It was noted that the water requirement is 9 KLD (05 KLD for Dust Suppression+ 2.5 KLD for Green Belt + 1.5 KLD for Drinking), which shall be met from tanker and mine sump.

- II. Plantation programme as mentioned in EIA/EMP and presented during presentation in SEIAA & SEAC shall be followed in content and spirit.
- III. PP shall demarcate a barrier zone of 7.5 m as no mining zone in the periphery of mining lease area and develop a green belt. Three row plantation shall be carried out in the greenbelt area in current year with proper watering arrangement.
- IV. Garland drain shall be constructed in the periphery of the entire mining area and around overburden dump. Three settling tanks shall also be constructed in the ML area.
