





Thus committee after deliberations decided to forward this case to SEIAA as the applied area is 2060 meters away from the Son Ghariyal Abhayaran for onward necessary action as per MoEF & CC Notification dated 25/06/2014."

..... The case was presented by the PP and their consultant wherein it was observed that according to the Google image of Dec., 2015 that there is a stop dam at a distance of 500 mts from the lease boundary and entire lease area is submerged in water. PP has submitted that a letter is issued by the Mining Officer, Ratlam vide letter No. 238 dated 13/06/2017 stating that the


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lease area remains submerged in water till December of every year after rains and from December upto June it becomes dry and thus evacuation of sand is possible from January to June and at present lease area is dry. MO has submitted the recent photographs of the dry area showing availability of the sand in the QL area. Considering the above statement of the Concerned Mining Officer and photographs, committee after deliberations decided that since the evacuation volume is only 5,000 cum/year and mining officer has verified in writing and through photographs regarding availability of sand, case can be considered for grant of EC. discuss the case and after discussion it was observed that: The EMS and other submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable, hence committee decided to recommend the case for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions in addition to the standard conditions at annexure 'B':.

Based on the above recommendation, it was decided to grant Prior Environmental Clearance subject to the following specific conditions in addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC-II :-


- (i). The production capacity shall be limited to the quantity approved by SEAC.
- (ii). No in-stream mining shall be allowed. No ramp will be allowed within the river basin to transport sand to the other bank. Transportation will be allowed on the bank side where the mineral is being excavated.
- (iii). The depth of the pit shall be as per Approved Mining Plan.
- (iv). The final decision of Hon'ble NGT (CZ) Bhopal and Hon'ble NGT Principal Bench, New Delhi in OA No. 49/2015 (Amarkant Mishra Vs State of MP & others), shall be obligatory on the part of PP.
- (v). The entire lease area should be properly fenced and boundary stones marked at the site.
- (i). Under CSR activity PP has committed following addition activities should be implemented.
 - a) PP shall ensure social welfare and skill development activities i.e. distribution of study material (Books, Copies etc) at village School.
 - b) Promotion of sanitation program in nearby villages.


All the above activities shall be carried out in consultation with Gram Panchayat and District Collector.


- (ii). PP shall ensure appropriate budget provision Rs. 0.40 lakh per annum (as proposed) for the CSR activities.

Thus committee after deliberations decided to stand by the recommendations made in the 23rd SEAC II meeting dated 06/05/2016.

As per the above observation of SEAC, no change/modification in the production capacity is now required, since EC in this particular case has already been issued for 80,000 cum/year. Copy to PP.




This case was recommended in 80th SEAC-II meeting dated 14-06-17 and it was recorded that :-


..... On perusal of the case file it was observed by the committee that during appraisal of the case it was observed by the committee as per the Google image of December, 2015 that > 90% of the lease area was submerged in water and the available dry area is only 2.50 ha thus 2.50 ha area was considered for sand evacuation. As far as depth is concerned committee observed that PP has submitted revised mine plan with replenishment plan on dated 13/10/2016 which was forwarded by the SEIAA vide letter no. 4314/SEIAA/16 dated 04/11/2016 wherein sanctioned depth of mine is 03 meters. and sanctioned depth as per the mine plan 3.00 m. Thus considering 2.5 meter area with 03 meter depth only 75,000 cum/year of sand can be evacuated. Thus committee after deliberations decided to stand by the recommendations made in the 59th SEACII meeting dated-11/11/2016..

Based on the above recommendation, it was decided to grant Prior Environmental Clearance for production capacity 75000 cum/year subject to the following specific conditions in addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC-II :-

- (i). This EC will be subject to the Hon'ble NGT, Principal Bench, New Delhi final orders in OA No. 404/2016.
- (ii). The production capacity shall be limited to the quantity approved by SEAC.
- (iii). No in-stream mining shall be allowed. No ramp will be allowed within the river basin to transport sand to the other bank. Transportation will be allowed on the bank side where the mineral is being excavated.
- (iv). The depth of the pit shall be as per Approved Mining Plan.
- (v). The final decision of Hon'ble NGT (CZ) Bhopal and Hon'ble NGT Principal Bench, New Delhi in OA No. 49/2015 (Amkant Mishra Vs State of MP & others), shall be obligatory on the part of PP.
- (vi). The entire lease area should be properly fenced and boundary stones marked at the site.


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- (iii). Under CSR activity PP has committed following addition activities should be implemented.
- a) PP shall ensure social welfare, skill development activities and sanitation program at nearby village.
 - b) PP shall ensure education of villagers children, like books, stationary and tuition's etc.
 - c) PP shall organize health chekup camp for villagers.
 - d) PP shall construct 3 toilet in panchayat for villagers.

All the above activities shall be carried out in consultation with Gram Panchayat and District Collector.
