- (2) This is a project pertaining to mining of Laterite Mine in MLA of 13.57 ha The activity is mentioned at S.No. 1 (a) of the Schedule of EIA Notification 2006 as amended from time to time. The project is reported to be at a distance of more than 10 km from National park and sanctuary and interstate boundary etc. thus it is not attracted by the general conditions and falls under category 'B-2" (Minor Mineral) by virtue of its location and mining lease area. The case was forwarded by SEAC to SEIAA for appraisal of EIA for environment clearance for the project. It was submitted that this is a proposed mine having valid lease of 20 years with production of 3,39,168 TPA.
- (3) It was reported by the PP that the lease area was granted to Shri Rituraj Verma for 20 years. This is a case of existing mining lease. The Mining Plan with progressive mine closure plan has been approved by DG&M (vide letter No. 11593/u-Ø-@,e-ih@th&2@2016 dated 12.07.2016).
- (4) The case was recommended for prior EC in 60th SEAC-II meeting dtd 24.11.2016 with 14 special conditions.
- (5) The case was then discussed in 455th SEIAA meeting dtd 08.11.2017 and PP/Consultant was invited for presentation. Thereafter, PP/Consultant made a presentation on all aspects of the project and all concerned issues were discussed in detail.
- (6) The proposed plantation programme was examined and it was found that 10000 sapling of tree species covering an area of 13.57 ha shall be planted during the lease period. There are few trees within the mining site which should be conserved as far as possible.
- (7) PP has committed during presentation to construct 100 m. pakka road from the mining site to the nearest highway.
- (8) PP has proposed to construct garland drain all around the mining site (size 2x1.5 m.), length 650 m. with 6 settling tanks (size 5x3x3.5 m.).
- (9) It was noted that the water requirement is 24 KLD (Dust suppression- 18.0 KLD, Green Belt 4.0 KLD & Domestic use 2.0 KLD), which shall be met by water tankers.
- (10) After deliberation the case was discussed in depth and PP was asked to submit the following information:
 - i. MPPCB consent of 2008 with its compliance on notice issued.
 - ii. NOC from Gram Sabha Village Tapa and Khadauli through Collector Jabalpur.
 - iii. Details with specification of steel/Iron teen curtain towards nearest human settlement.
 - iv. Revised CSR & EMP with Budget breakup.
 - V. Ground water table details from the Central Ground Water Board pertaining to the mine site.

As per the above, PP has submitted NOC from Gram sabha village Tapa and Khadauli but that is not duly verified by Collector Jabalpur, therefore it has been decided that PP should submit accordingly.

PP has submitted information vide letter dated 05.01.2018 received in SEIAA Office 10.01.2018 which found satisfactory and it was decided to accept the recommendation of SEAC for grant of prior EC to the project subject to the following specific conditions:

 Before commencing any mining activity fencing shall be carried out all around the lease area. Proper watch and ward arrangements should be made with installation of signage at 4 corners of lease area to avoid any untoward incident involving public and animals by the PP.

- II. Plantation programme me as mentioned in EIA/EMP and presented during presentation in SEIAA & SEAC shall be followed in content and spirit.
- III. PP shall demarcate a barrier zone of 7.5 m as no mining zone in the periphery of mining lease area and develop a green belt. Three row plantation shall be carried out in the greenbelt area in current year with proper watering arrangement.
- IV. The mining operation shall be restricted to above ground water table and in no case it should intersect the ground water table. In case of working below the ground water table approval of the Central Ground Water Board shall be obtained.
- V. Before commencing the mining activity, site demarcation should be done leaving 100 m. from the habitation and 50 m. from the village road as a "no mining zone" and it will be maintained as buffer zone. The demarcation should be done by the Revenue Officials in the presence of Mining Officer, Jabalpur
- VI. PP will plan 3 years old 2000 trees samplings of suitable indigenous fast grow tree species and develop 25m. vide plantation zone towards the south western boundary near habitation site and in barrier zone/no mining zone during first year.
- VII. PP shall ensure to construct and maintained 70 m. Cement Concrete approach road and also maintain 5.5 km. pakka road upto junction of NH from the mine site. Plantation will be carried out on both side of the approach road. PP shall also ensure maintenance of PMGSY road and PWD road in consultation with competent authority.
- VIII. PP has committed installation of 01 bore well within the mine site for irrigation of plantation, control on dust pollution and drinking purposes, and additional water requirement shall be fulfilled by water tanker with written consent of Gram Panchayat/Local villagers.
 - IX. The over burden and waste will be stacked for five years and then simultaneously backfilled in the mined out area where plantation will be raised on it.
 - X. No overburden will be dumped outside the mine lease area.
- XI. Regular air & water quality monitoring shall be carried out by PP before discharging it into the nearby agriculture fields from authorized laboratory in consultation with Regional Officer, MPPCB.
- XII. PP shall ensure generation of employment opportunities nearby Village on priority bases.
- XIII. Payments of wages to the workers shall be done in consonance with the provisions in the labours laws.
- XIV. Proper infrastructure with shelter, drinking water, toilet and first-aid facilities shall be provided for the laborers. A provision should be made to construct a pakka rest shelter along with toilet and drinking water facility.

In view of above PP has requested that as per direction of Real State Regulatory Authority(RERA) the Plots have to be allotted to owner with all facilities, however vide letter dtd 15.11.17 Chief Engineer, Nagar Nigam Bhopal has informed that the water facility of the said project will be fulfilled from water over head tank constructing on Manubhawan tekri under Amrit Yojana but it will take at least 2 years for completion. Therefore PP needs to permission for withdrawal of ground water so that plots should be given to plots owner timely with water supply facilities also.

The matter was discussed and it is decided that PP should submit the consent from Central Ground Water Authority regarding withdrawal of ground water since the requirement of fresh water is in huge quantity for the said project.
