This case has already been identified as a violation case and therefore it should be included in the list of violation cases sent to MoEF&CC in furtherance of the notification dated 14.03.2017. Therefore, this case is hereby closed and now no further action is required to be taken. PP should be informed accordingly to apply online afresh in the MoEF&CC as per notification dated 14.03.2017.



" Committee after perusal of the submissions made by the PP and ESZ Notification of Ranipur Wild life Sanctuary published by MoEF & CC, Gol on dtd. 09.11.2017 vide SO No. 3573 (E) in which the ESZ in case of Ranipur Wild life Sanctuary has been fixed with an extent of 01 km. from the boundary of the Ranipur Wild life Sanctuary (UP) recommends that withdrawal the EC condition of NBWL clearance of Ranipur Wild life Sanctuary may be considered by SEIAA based on above submissions made by PP and ESZ Notification of Ranipur Wild life Sanctuary published by MoEF & CC, Gol on dtd. 09.11.2017 vide SO No. 3573 (E)"

As per above observation, it has been decided to accept the recommendation of SEAC to withdraw EC condition of NBWL clearance of Ranipur Wildlife Sanctuary. Copy to PP and all concerned.

*After detailed discussions and perusal of the recommendations of 148<sup>nd</sup> SEAC meeting dtd. 25.08.2014, it was found from the record that mining plan submitted by PP is very old (MP/JBL/Lime/MPLN/97-98 dated 20.01.1998) and the mining lease submitted is also old one (March 1982).*

*In view of above it was decided that PP should be asked to submit the latest mining plan/mining scheme. It was also decided that Mining Officer should be asked to provide the latest status of the lease renewal. The information should be made available by 15.12.2014, so that further decision could be taken. The letter should be endorsed to the PP also.*

Further, the case was discussed in 204<sup>th</sup> SEIAA meeting dtd. 30.05.2015 & 250<sup>th</sup> SEIAA meeting dtd. 14.10.2015 it was recorded that :-

*..... After detailed discussion and perusal of the minutes of the 167<sup>th</sup> SEIAA meeting dtd. 16.10.2014, PP has not submitted the desired information sought vide L.No. 2766 dated 23.12.2014. A reminder should be sent to PP for submitting the copy of the mining plan in lease status.*

*The case is hereby delisted and shall be liable for relisting once the complete information is submitted*

Again, the case was discussed in 455<sup>th</sup> SEIAA meeting dtd. 08.11.2017 it was recorded that :-

*.....PP has submitted the required information vide letter no. nil dtd. 19.06.2017 received in SEIAA Office 20.06.2017. Therefore it has been decided to relist the case and send the technical file to SEAC for appraisal. Copy to PP and all concerned.*

## Minutes of the 467<sup>th</sup> Meeting of SEIAA dated. 02.02.2018

..... ON perusal of the case file committee found that earlier this case was recommended for 6200 TPA for production of lime stone and dolomite in 148th meeting of SEAC dated 25th August 2014. As per latest mine plan the production of both mineral is in line with the earlier recommendation and at lower side with maximum production of 5526 TPA as per recently approved mine plan. PP has also submitted the valid lease document with validity upto 26/03/32 desired by SEIAA. After deliberations, committee further observed that since this case was been appraised by the previous SEAC decided to standby with the recommendations made in its 148th meeting dated 25th August 2014 with maximum production capacity of 5526 TPA considering that PP has submitted duly approved mine plan and lease validity till 26/03/2032 as desired by the SEIAA.

As per above observation, PP may be called for presentation.

This case was discussed in 305<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting dated 16.01.18 and it was recorded that :-

" This is case of Limestone Mine and was presented by the PP and their consultant in the 301<sup>st</sup> SEAC meeting dated 21/12/2017 and was recommended for grant of EC by SEAC. PP vide letter dated 05/01/2018 has submitted a representation that in the minutes the land use plan mentioned at condition no.15 is of 8.094 ha while their area is of 1.121 ha and thus need correction and the same was placed before the committee.

Committee on perusal of the PP's representation observed that due to typographical error the land use of **Case no. 1698/2013 - Shri Ajay Kumar Pathak, Semariya Chowk, Chanakyapuri, P.O. & Distt - Satna (M.P.)**, Pin Code-485001 for Environment Clearance of 8.094 Ha Limestone Mine for Limestone 50,000 TPA and Reject Stone 25,000 TPA at Village - Rampurchourasi, Tehsil - Raghuraj Nagar, District - Satna, (MP) was mentioned in this case.

Thus committee after deliberations recommends that above land use shall be replaced as follows in the minutes of 301<sup>st</sup> SEAC meeting dated 21/12/2017 for **Case no. 5238/16 M/s ACC Ltd, Kymore Cement Works, Kymore, Dist. Katni – 483880** for Prior Environment Clearance for Limestone Mine in an area of 1.121 ha. (50,000 MTPA ha.) at Khasra no.-81/2, 85, Village-Badari, Tehsil - Vijayraghavgarh, Dist. Katni (MP) at Sl. *" Earlier this case was presented by the PP and their consultant in 28<sup>th</sup> SEAC-II meeting dated 02/06/2016, wherein it was observed from the Google image based on the co-ordinates provided by the PP that approx. 30% area of the lease is submerged in water thus committee after deliberations decided that since only 70% of the area is available for evacuation of sand the volume of sand excavation should be reduced to 84,000 cum/year*

*The case was placed before the meeting wherein it was observed by the committee on perusal of case file that in the minutes reason for the reduction in sand quantity was justified hence no further action is required in this case. The committee after deliberations decided that above clarification may be sent to SEIAA for onward necessary action."*

After review the case, it is decided to accept the recommendation of SEAC and no further action required in this case. Copy to PP.

*" Earlier this case was presented by the PP and their consultant in the 242<sup>nd</sup> SEAC meeting dtd 07/11/2015 wherein it was recorded that: - "As per the co-ordinates submitted by the PP, the Google image indicates that 40% of ML area falls under water. The demanded quantity is 5,70,000 cum/year and mining of which is not possible with submergence of approx. 40% area in water as mid stream mining is not permitted, thus committee decided to reduce the quantity by 40% and recommends for the 3,42,000 cum/year.*

*The case was placed before the meeting wherein it was observed by the committee on perusal of case file that in the minutes reason for the reduction in sand quantity was justified hence no further action is required in this case. The committee after deliberations decided that above clarification may be sent to SEIAA for onward necessary action.."*

After review the case, it is decided to accept the recommendation of SEAC and no further action required in this case. Copy to PP.


The case was discussed in 456<sup>th</sup> SEIAA meeting dated 16.11.2017 and it was recored that :

1. This is a project pertaining to mining of Manganese Mine in MLA of 3.38 ha The activity is mentioned at S.No. 1 (a) of the Schedule of EIA Notification 2006 as amended from time to time. The project is reported to be at a distance of more than 10 km from National Park /Sanctuary etc. and forest boundary is more than 250 m distance from the ML area, thus it is not attracted by the general conditions and falls under category 'B-1' by virtue of its location and mining lease area. The case was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal of EIA for environment clearance for the project. It was submitted that this is a proposed mine having valid lease of 50 years upto 29.10.2049 with production of 3000 TPA.
2. It was reported by the PP that the Mining lease granted for period of 20 years from 30.10.1999 and extended to 29.10.2049 and the lease area comes under govt. waste and private land. The scheme of mining with progressive mine closure plan has been approved by IBM, Nagpur. via Letter No. - BGT/ MN/MPLN- 659/NGP dtd 22.01.2015.
3. SEAC in its 79th SEAC-II meeting dtd. 13.06.2017 has recommended the case with 18 special conditions for issuance of EC.
4. It was noted that as per DFO, letter no. 12455 dtd. 18.12.2015, the National Park/Sanctuary are not located within 10 Km., radius from the mining site. Hence, the General Conditions are not attracted.
5. It was noted that the water requirement is 22 KLD (16 KLD for Dust Suppression+ 5 KLD for Green Belt + 1.50 KLD for Domestic), which shall be met from Mine sump and Dug well.
6. The proposed plantation programme was examined and it was found that 2705 sapling of tree species covering an area of 1.50 ha shall be planted during the lease period.
7. It was noted that the Public Hearing was carried out on 16.02.2017 at Mine Parisar Village Katangjhari, under the Chairmanship of ADM, Balaghat. The major comments of applicants during public hearing are employment of local people, construction & maintenance of existing / approach road connecting the mine & main road, Plantation on road side , regular health check-up of mine workers & water sprinkling to suppress the dust emission.
8. It was also noted that as per Google image the proposed mine site is located at a distance of 100m. (approx.) from nearby Dam.

From the record it was revealed that DEIAA Panna has not followed this procedure and acted unilaterally in reaching a conclusion.






